Dear Mrs. Upchurch:

I want to thank you for your letter, particularly for sending me the memorial to my great aunt Harriett. Unless you particularly want this newspaper clipping I will place it in the Upchurch file in the Archive and History Department at the State Capitol.

It may interest you to know there is quite a file on the Upchurch family at the Capitol including the write up of your husband Will. Incidentally, the write up states that he was survived by two daughters and one brother in addition to you. I presume that the brother was Earl of Clanton, Alabama, who has since died and of whom I have or can obtain a complete record. I do not have a record, however, of your children, their birth dates or marriages. I would like very much to have this.

I found in the file at the Capitol a copy of a census of Greene County, Alabama in 1870, listing a John Upchurch born in 1814 whose wife was named Armenia. This couple had nine children at that time. Their children were '(1) Robert B., (2) Siliman P., (3) Martha E., (4) A. J., (5) Sarah J., (6) Virginia D., (7) Alice B., (8) Mary C., and (9) William H. The file lists John Upchurch as having been born in North Carolina in 1814.

Since my previous letter to you I have obtained from some of the North Carolina Upchurch family a history of their lineage going back to Michael Upchurch in West Moreland County, Virginia, who was born in 1616 and who bought land in West Moreland County in 1650.

I would greatly appreciate it if you can give me the information on your children and also if you can give me some information concerning John and Armenia Upchurch and their children. I hope to bring my family over to see the cemetery this summer and to see you again. My camellia did beautifully this year and I know that your's must have been beautiful since they did so well last year, since it was not a good year for camellia.

Dear Mrs. Upchurch:

You may recall that I stopped by your house last year and persuaded you to go over to the Upchurch cemetery with me.

Most of the pictures that I got were very good. I understood you to tell me that my great grandfather was Bartley and his wife Penelope and that he had six children, (1) Alvin, (2) Cal, (3) Jack, (4) Barton, my grandfather, (5) Hattie and (6) Fannie. I have a letter from my father's sister Hattie who advises that she had always understood that her grandfather's name was Samuel Nathaniel. Can you shed any light on this?

Did you ever hear Cousin Will say whether or not great grandfather Upchurch's father was named Nathaniel?

I received in yesterday's mail a fairly complete chart of the Upchurch family in North Carolina going back to the original Michael Upchurch, Sr. in West Merland County, Virginia in 1616. I would like to get as complete a chart of the Alabama Upchurchs as possible, in order to co-ordinate them with the chart which I received from Donah Carlton Upchurch of Durham, North Carolina. Any help you can give as regard each of the children of Uncle Jack as well as any other records that you have will be appreciated.

Dear Mrs. Upchurch:

While in the State Department of Archives & History I found records in the Greene County History of an Abel Upchurch who apparently died in the latter part of 1846. He left three sons, Bartlett, Benjamin and Laton and two daughters, Dolly and Mary Martin. As soon as I have time I will go back to the Capitol and see if I can find any further records as to whether Abel was our great grandfather Bartley's father. Do the above names mean anything to you?

I received a long letter yesterday from Dr. Calvin Edgar Upchurch who lives in Union City, Tennessee. He is 80 years old and the only son of Uncle Cal. He gave me the name of a few of Uncle Al's children but had very little information concerning them. As soon as I can complete the record of Uncle Al's children I will have all of the Upchurches from Bartley and his wife down to the present time. As soon as I can establish the father of Bartley I think I will have the entire line back to Jamestown, Virginia in 1616, when Michael Upchurch apparently first settled in Virginia.

I will appreciate any information you can give me on Uncle Al.
