**Commentary:** Mary Hudspeth was born in 1770, possibly in Granville County, NC. She died in 1835 in Franklin or Johnson County in Illinois. We are reasonable certain that the Upchurch she married in 1790 in Granville County, was David Upchurch. David was the son of William Upchurch IV – head of Upchurch clan # 9. The entries in her biofile provide valuable insight into the family of William Upchurch IV especially as it relates to how long the William Upchurch IV family lingered in Granville, NC, having come from Brunswick County in Virginia and before moving on to Wilkes County, NC.

Will made 4 SEP 1795 – Proven FEB Court 1796

Carter Hudspeth wills to his daughter Mary (Hudspeth) Upchurch a bed and furniture. Lists several other children but not his wife. There is no indication as to which Upchurch Mary Hudspeth married.

There is an account of the sale of the estate of Carter Hudspeth in Granville Co., NC at which Mary Upchurch purchased a table – indicating she lived close enough to come and not too far away to transport the table. There were no male Upchurch purchasers.

#### (3) "2. William U\* (3) son of Michael 3

William U\*, the third of the name recorded here, seems to be the second son of Michael 3. He may have stayed in the Granville district for a short time before going on to Wilkes after leaving Brunswick Co. It seems that a son of William's married, in Granville, **MARY HUDSPETH**, daughter of Carter Hudspeth. Carter made his will and named his daughter, Mary U. (Granville Wills 1796- Vol 3 page 242)"

I still believe that <u>MARY HUDSPETH</u> married X and became the father of David Phillip Upchurch born 1811. [Note: X would be David Upchurch, son of William Upchurch, IV –Head of clan – RPU]
