Our trip to Meridian was as unproductive as I had expected it to be...but I had to try. The only information we obtained is that Almetria James Upchurch's name is not spelled correctly in the present records. Her name was Almedia. She was the wife of Benjamin Newton and was Uppie's grandmother. We learned this at the Oak Grove Cemetery at Bonita (Meridian). We found the plot where she is buried and that is the name on the stone. I am sure it is correct because her daughter, Martha Wheeler Johnson, her husband, and others are buried on the same plot and I am sure that Martha had the correct spelling of the name on her mother's stone. We also feel sure that the plot just behind the Wheeler plot is where William Edward, Sr., Carrie James Upchurch and Zella Upchurch are buried. It is the only vacant looking lot in the entire cemetery and since no stones were erected, we cannot be sure until we get back down and try to find out where we can find the map of the cemetery and the names of those who owned the plots. If we can find this information and the name in which the deed is recorded is Bates, then we know for sure and if we can somehow locate the exact spots of burial, I will have stones put up. Uppie is not feeling very well these days so I don't know exactly when I can get away to drive down again. All the people with whom we came in contact at Meridian (Lauderdale County) and also at Decatur (Newton County) were as helpful as could be.

Burrell Miles Upchurch and one male slave rode horse-back to Texas from Choctaw Co., Alabama searching for a good location for a new home for his growing family. They chose north Grimes County land, returned to Alabama and made the necessary preparations to move the family. He sold the Alabama farm, packed Margaret and three children into a Covered Wagon pulled by one ox and one milk-cow. The cow provided milk and butter on their way to their new home. They brought everything that they could get in the wagon, including the cow's calf.

The new home turned out to be near Pankey, Texas. In 1866 + Burrell purchased six hundred eleven acres in the Samuel Bowman League situated on Bedias Creek for nine hundred dollars.

The Family built a new house in 1860. It was two large rooms on each side of a center hall with bedrooms upstairs and a porch across the front. The kitchen was built separate in back of the house. Burrell went Bryan once a month to buy the supplies for the family in a wagon. Margaret was mother and caretaker of the family, but still made time to be the mid-wife in the community and to help the sick regardless of color or creed.

+ Burrell and Margaret were loving and supportive parents. They helped their children if and when they needed help. They were also fair and equal with their help; in Burrell's will he divided both his real and personal property equally between their children. But he deducted whatever he had advanced to each child that had not been repaid. Burrell Miles died in 1884, Margaret survived him by seven years. They are buried in the Bedias Baptist Cemetery along with many of their descendants.



E., Bertie E. Sylvanus Z. and Alie A. are each entitled to 1/5 of the value of the land subject to the life estate of their mother. Walter C. and James E. are over 21 years of age and the other 3 children are minors, Bertie E. being 20 years old, Sylvanus Z. being 18 years old, and Alie A. being 15 years old, all of them living with their mother the petitioner Virginia N. Gill. The land was the property of Mrs. Clara A. Strickland and is described as "All that tract of land lying in Little River Township in the County of Wake and in Dunn Township in the County of Franklin on the waters of Mocasin (sic) Creek, bounded on the North by the lands of Ambrose Upchurch and Benjamin Pearce; on the East by the lands of Joseph Glover and Henry Haywood's heirs; on the South by the lands of Noah Strickland, G.M. Bell and J.R. Edwards and on the West by the lands of Nannie A. Hunter, Lemon Chamblee, Thomas Wiggs and W.H. Chamblee, Jr."

A large portion of the land is uncleared and yields a very small income, and it is greatly to the interest of all parties concerned that the land shall be divided before the life estate of the petitioner Virginia N. Gill shall terminate, so that the petitioners who are remaindermen may each own his land in severalty, with the right to improve the same and to render it more productive.
