George Washington Crouch (1833-1915) married three times. He married (1) Lucinda Jennings (1834-cal864) had three sons and one daughter. (2) Millie Dishman (1833-1900) had three sons and one daughter. (3) Cordelia Upchurch (1863-1952) had one son

and one daughter. James A. (1852-1890), John (1853-1935), Timothy (1855-1932) and Margaret (Mag) (1858-1923) were his first family. (Big) Thomas E. (1869-1948), Lucinda J. (Babe) (1870-1959), Archibald Hamilton (1872-1941), Joseph Daily (Dobbin) (1874-1953), and Mary (1875) died young. His third family; Linda Ellen (1902-1967) and Gideon (1905-1970).

James Allen married Polly Dishman (1848). Their children were Laurie; Marcus, married Leona Buck; Generie (Tint), married Johnnie Woods; Florida, married Porter Crockett; Maudie married John Albertson; Millie and Sophia are covered in another story in this book.

John Crouch and his family are found in another story in this book.

Timothy married October 17, 1871, to Mary Jane Evans (1855-1925). He and his father had a misunderstanding and he ran away. He and Mary Jane were only 16 years of age when they married. They migrated to Little Kansas, Arkansas and operated an inn for several years. Later they moved to Salina, Arkansas. There he was Justice of the Peace and then Mayor of Salina for several years.

Margaret (Mag) married three times. (1) John T. Upchurch (1852) had one child, Leo. (2) Oat Grover, adopted Cassie, who died about four years old. (3) J.K. Box of Hanford, California. Leo also married in California and never returned to Tennessee.

Thomas E. (Big Tom) (1869-1948) in 1895 married Lou Ann West (1876-1960). Their four children are: Mae (1895) who married Bradley Moody, son of Marion and Isobell Moody. Their daughter Gladys Moody married Jesse Pence, and their son, Thomas Marion (Bud) Moody (WWII injuries near Japan left both legs paralyzed), is married to Malinda, a registered nurse; Preston (1895-1950) married Lila Evans. Their only child Justine married Cohen Reed and their daughter Connie Reed married Mike Storie; Edison (1903-1970) married Centralia Cummings (1910). Their son Jack (1931) married Bessie Patton. Their daughter is Peggy Sue (1959). Edd's daughter Bobby Jo Crouch

(1934) married Beecher Huff, they have three daughters; Kay (1952) Earlene (1953), Pamela Jo (1954) and two sons, Gary Joe (1956) and Larry Marvin (1959); Ralph Crouch (1912) married (1) Gladys (Greer) Upchurch. After her death he married Irene (Peercy) Davis. Thomas E. Crouch taught school, studied law, and was Justice of the Peace for the Travisville area of Pickett County for many years. He had excellent "photographic" recollection.

Archibald H. Crouch and Lucinda J. Crouch are covered in other stories.

Joe Daily (Dobbin) (1874-1953) married in 1901 to Mertie Upchurch (1884-1919). Their six sons and one daughter are: Shelly (1903) joined the Navy in 1925, had 16 years when the Japanese bombing of Pearl Harbor plunged the USA into all-out war. Shelly stayed on until after the war, more than twenty-two years. After returning home he married in 1957, Othniel (Davidson) Evans; Spencer (1905-1968) went north and became a machinist with Warner Gear in Muncie, Indiana. After 30 years there he took retirement and returned home to Forbus. He was married in 1938 to Dora Dishman (1904). They have two daughters: Janice married to Joe Billingsly, Rickman, Tenn. with three girls and one boy; Janie married to Eddie Brown of Albany, Ky; John (1908-1936) was working in Akron, Ohio, took ill and died within hours. His brother, Spencer, went over and made arrangements to bring the body back home for burial; Martin (1910) became a teacher. During WWII he left teaching for factory war production at Warner Gear, Muncie, Indiana. He married Leona (Owens) Evans of Kingston, Tenn. They make their home in Muncie; Millie (1914) married in 1950 to Reed Lawson of Albany, KY. He died in 1958. Their son Ray (1953) and Millie make their home in Cookeville, TN. He is married to Terry Smith; James (1916) married Ramona Weakley. They have Kathy, Joe, Annie Marie and Johnnie. They met, married and have brought up their family in Indiana; Morrison (1918) joined his big brother Shelly in the Navy and considered it "lucky" to be assigned to the same ship. Near New Guinea their ship received torpedo damages, but was still able to pull into an Australian port and get repairs. On the way

to rejoin their fleet, an Australian tanker rammed their ship breaking it in half, ten men were lost at sea. Later the brothers were assigned to an aircraft carrier. Morrison was in on the biggest navy battle in history — Douglas McArthur in the Leyte Gulf when the Japanese put all their power and men in a fight to the finish. McArthur and the American forces we know won that victory — leading to the total defeat and surrender of Japan. Shelly was on shore duty! Morrison in 1957 married Ada Taylor.

Linda Ellen Crouch (1902-1967) married Minnis Huff. Their two sons are Enos (1924) who is married to Allene Beaty and they have a daughter and two sons: Willie Amos (1929) married Hazel Moody. Their daughter Sharon Beatty (1947) is a teacher. Their son is Garry Lynn (1949).

Gideon Crouch (1905-1970) married Arza Abbott (1920-1960). They had two daughters — and a son: Eva Sue (1944) is married to Bruce Barton. Their only child is Jeanetta Sue (1977); Colean (1946) is married to Orbin Logan of Byrdstown, Tenn. They have twin boys, Michael and Richard (1967). Their

daughter is Margaret (1968) Logan; Jeff Crouch (1958) signed up for the Army before graduation from Pickett County High School. He was stationed two years in Germany. In 1985 he and Linda Fletcher were married. She is an RN. Jeff has continued his education by enrolling at Tennessee Tech University and will graduate this fall with a degree in engineering.

Last Saturday night while Sam Abbott and his brother, Otto, were eating supper at the home of George Jennings in Helm's Hollow, three miles below Sunnybrook, Obie Upchurch and Spencer Jennings came up and a battle ensued in which Sam Abbott was killed on the spot and Obie Upchurch went a short ways from the house and lay down with his overall jumper under his head and died some time during the night. Spencer Jennings was also shot up but left and has not been located, and it is thought he also is dead or mortally wounded. Abbott was a son of Dock Abbott, of Tennessee. He was accused of ambushing and killing Roscoe Williams near the Jennings home a few years ago, and had never been arrested for the crime. Obie Upchurch was a son of Floyd Upchurch and Spencer Jennings a son of Frank Jennings, all living in Tennessee.

Parties who are familiar with conditions down there say that the killing of about a dozen more of the bad actors in that neighborhood would help conditions.
