A. Samuel Upchurch

1. John Upchurch born 18 Oct 1798 (NC) died 2 Feb 1844 (Saline Co, IL) married 16 Aug 1821 (Wilson Co, TN) Catharine Johnson "Caty" born 7 May 1803 (Nash Co, NC)

"The Read family has a notation that "Grandmother Milly Johnson born 1778 died 1853. I wonder if Milly could be the mother of Catherine (Johnson) Upchurch. Milly died 1853 10th month 4th day aged 75 years 4 months 28 days.

He must have returned to Wilson Co, TN to marry "the girl he left behind" in 1821 according to the marriage records of Wilson Co. Some of their children were born in TN. John returned to IL with his family by the early part of 1826 as they became members of the Bethel Creek Church by



experience in Feb 1826. They were active members of the church during their lifetimes. Buried at the church cemetery. The couple had ten known children. (29, Page 162)

Children #1, 2, 12 not mentioned – hence presumed deceased with no heirs.

For John Upchurch #4, his wife is listed (twice) as Katharine Upchurch, hence nee **Katharine Johnson***

For William L Upchurch (#5) – no wife is listed so he may have been between wives

For Nancy Upchurch (#8) she appears as Nancy Cantrell but no husband is listed; presume he is deceased (He is.)

For Thomas L Upchurch - no wife listed - presumably because he is buying the property

For Elizabeth Upchurch (#11) – her husband is shown clearly as Charles Thompson (not Joseph Thompson)



What are your thoughts on this ---

Evidence shows John Upchurch (born 1798) married <u>Catherine Johnson</u> in Aug 1821. Evidence also shows <u>their</u> first-born child Caswell Bluford was <u>born one year before</u> this. In those day, the <u>woman</u> would have been disgraced if <u>she</u> didn't marry immediately upon finding <u>herself</u> with child. I see no reference that he could have been adopted. The surname "Bluford" was rare in Ill, although more common in England.
