Outline of Stephen Upchurch, Subclan of the John Upchurch III Clan (Clan No. 14)


While flipping through Dr. Phil's issues of the Bulletin, I came across this picture of a handsome gentleman and wondered who he was. I

learned he was William W. Upchurch, Grandson of Stephen Upchurch, and Great Grandson of John Upchurch III, Head of Clan No. 14. I was delighted he was *my* line and able to share him with my many cousins. Dr. Phil writes:

William W. "Billy" Upchurch was born in 1837 (Wilson Co., TN), 13550 died 1 Dec 1908 in Lascassas, TN and is buried near Las-

cassas in Rutherford Co., TN. He is the son of Samuel Abner Upchurch I. On 27 Sep 1871 in Murfreesboro, TN,



volunteered to serve in the Confederate Armed Services in 1861 and both were injured in the battle of Shiloh in 1862.


Outline of Stephen Upchurch Subclan of the John Upchurch III Clan (Clan 14)

In August 1862 William was discharged and sent home. After he died in 1908 his widow received a pension from the State of Tennessee based on his Civil War service.

William W. Upchurch owned a farm located on the Holly Grove, Lascassas Road in Rutherford Co., TN. He died on this farm and is probably buried in a family plot near Lascassas where one presumes his parents are buried also, along with several other family members. The farm is still in the family. At the time William's widow, Lucy, transferred title of the farm to her daughter, Ella, she reserved a one acre cemetery plot for herself and her eight children and other family relatives. This has become known as the Upchurch-Tune Cemetery.

The children of William W. Upchurch lived in and around Walter Hill in Rutherford Co., TN. One son, James William Upchurch did live elsewhere for a time. Two sons farmed and one was an undertaker. We are grateful to Billye Marie Continued from Page 1
