- △ HENDON, G. A., Private  
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 26, July 15, 1862, for the war. Left sick at Frederick, Maryland, September 10, 1862, and reported as absent without leave after December 21, 1862. Reported on November-December, 1863, muster roll with the remark: "Deserted December 21, 1862, supposed dead."
- △ HIGH, CHRISTOPHER C., Private  
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 26, July 15, 1862, for the war. Detailed as a shoemaker at Richmond, Virginia, November 22, 1862, and reported as absent on detail through December, 1864. Paroled at Winchester, Virginia, April 21, 1865.
- △ HIGH, JAMES, Private  
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 27, July 15, 1862, for the war. Captured at Frederick, Maryland, September 12, 1862, and paroled and exchanged at Aiken's Landing, James River, Virginia, November 9, 1862. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, May 30, 1863, with "irratatis spinalis" and transferred to Raleigh on July 28, 1863. Reported as absent sick until detailed as a shoemaker at Raleigh on July 28, 1864. Absent on detail through December, 1864.
- △ HOLLOMAN, ELIJAH, Private  
 Enlisted in Wake County on October 27, 1863, for the war. Deserted on March 12, 1864.
- △ HOLLOMAN, JOHN, Private  
 Enlisted in Wake County on October 27, 1863, for the war. Wounded at Wilderness, Virginia, May 5, 1864, and reported as absent wounded through December, 1864.
- △ HUTSPETH, ROBERT H., Private  
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 24, July 15, 1862, for the war. Captured at Frederick, Maryland, September 12, 1862, and paroled and exchanged at City Point, Virginia, December 18, 1862. Wounded at Payne's Farm, Virginia, November 27, 1863, and at Cedar Creek, Virginia, October 19, 1864. Captured at Burkeville, Virginia, April 6, 1865, and confined at Newport News, Virginia. Released at Newport News after taking the Oath of Allegiance.
- △ JACKSON, MATTHEW W., Private  
 Born in Wake County where he resided and enlisted at age 33, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died in hospital at Gordonsville, Virginia, September 2, 1862, of "typhoid fever."

- △★ JOAB, W. A., Private  
 Enlisted in Wake County on August 21, 1864, for the war. Captured at Winchester, Virginia, September 19, 1864, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland. Paroled at Point Lookout on March 15, 1865, and exchanged at Boulware's Wharf, James River, Virginia, March 18, 1865. Paroled on May 4, 1865.
- △ JONES, MAC M., Private  
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 32, July 15, 1862, for the war. Captured in Maryland in September, 1862, and paroled on September 27, 1862. Died in Wake County on March 15, 1864, of disease.
- △ JONES, NORFLEET B., Private  
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 24, July 15, 1862, for the war. Captured at Williamsport, Maryland, September 15, 1862, and paroled and exchanged at Aiken's Landing, James River, Virginia, November 10, 1862. The purpose of this booklet is to record and present the history of the Ray family of Wake County, North Carolina. The story begins with Alfonso Columbus Ray (known as A.C. and Von) who was born in Wake County in 1855 and died at age 84 in 1939 in Raleigh.

All of us know something about our living relatives. We enjoy telling stories about their achievements and exploits. Yet our knowledge of our family often does not go beyond those family members we actually know. Few of us have been fortunate to have known our great grandparents. In this booklet the Ray family is traced as far as the records available to the author permit. Details are included on the life and times of many ancestors to describe events which influenced their lives and to document the family heritage.

The Ray family of Wake County has been traced with certainty to Nathan Ray who was born circa 1765 and drowned in the Neuse River on or about the first of January in 1822. The earliest record found of a Ray in the area of the Neuse River Valley which became Wake County is a 1759 deed involving Francis Ray and his wife Rachel. On July 21, 1759, they acquired 100 acres on the south side of the Neuse River in what was then Johnston County, North Carolina. It is believed, but not proven, that Francis and Rachel Ray are the parents or grandparents of Nathan Ray.

According to family tradition, the Ray family lived in Virginia before settling along the Neuse River. Francis Ray and his wife, Rachel, lived in Prince George County, Virginia until 1728, in Brunswick County, Virginia from 1728 to 1746 and Lunenburg County, Virginia from 1746 to 1759. Francis Ray (born circa 1700) was a prominent farmer, blacksmith and he kept an ordinary (tavern) in his home in Lunenburg County. He was also active in purchasing and selling property in Virginia and North Carolina.

Trips to Raleigh in 1997 researching Wake County deeds, wills, estate, marriage, military, birth, death, census, tax, court orders, and other records began to provide details on early generations. Traces of our ancestors were also found in history books, published genealogies, church records, tombstone inscriptions, land grants, and other sources. The Daughters of the American Revolution Library in Washington, D.C. is a premier genealogical research center and contains over 135,000 volumes. The National Genealogical Society Library in Arlington, Virginia was also a valuable source of information and provided access to the Jesus Christ Church of Latter Day Saints ancestral computer files. Correspondence with the North Carolina State Archives in Raleigh and the Register of Deeds for numerous counties in North Carolina were sources for copies of historical documents to prove or disprove tentative conclusions. Published and unpublished sources were consulted to include research and conclusions of previous authors. Many relatives provided details that are included in this booklet. Bradley Ray, Ola Keith Ray, David Carter, Rachel Goldston and Dr. Wilmer Conrad Betts were especially helpful. I am grateful to all who assisted.

A professional genealogist, Tim Kearney, was retained to answer the more difficult questions. Tim lives north of Raleigh in a home built in 1759 by his forefather near the area inhabited by the Ray ancestors and descendants. After completing the second assignment, Tim wrote to "Cousin Bill Ray" stating that he had performed sufficient research to confirm that we share two common ancestors, Buckner Pace and Joseph Davis. Tim provided details on our common ancestors that he obtained during years of researching his own family. Tim was also able to identify the maiden names of many wives which enhances this family history by making it possible to include related families and earlier generations.

A genealogy is never finished. There is always the desire to trace the family to earlier generations and to obtain details on the life of a relative from times long past.

Notwithstanding best efforts for accuracy, there are undoubtedly errors and omissions in this family history. Readers are encouraged to contact the author to correct errors and to add new information.

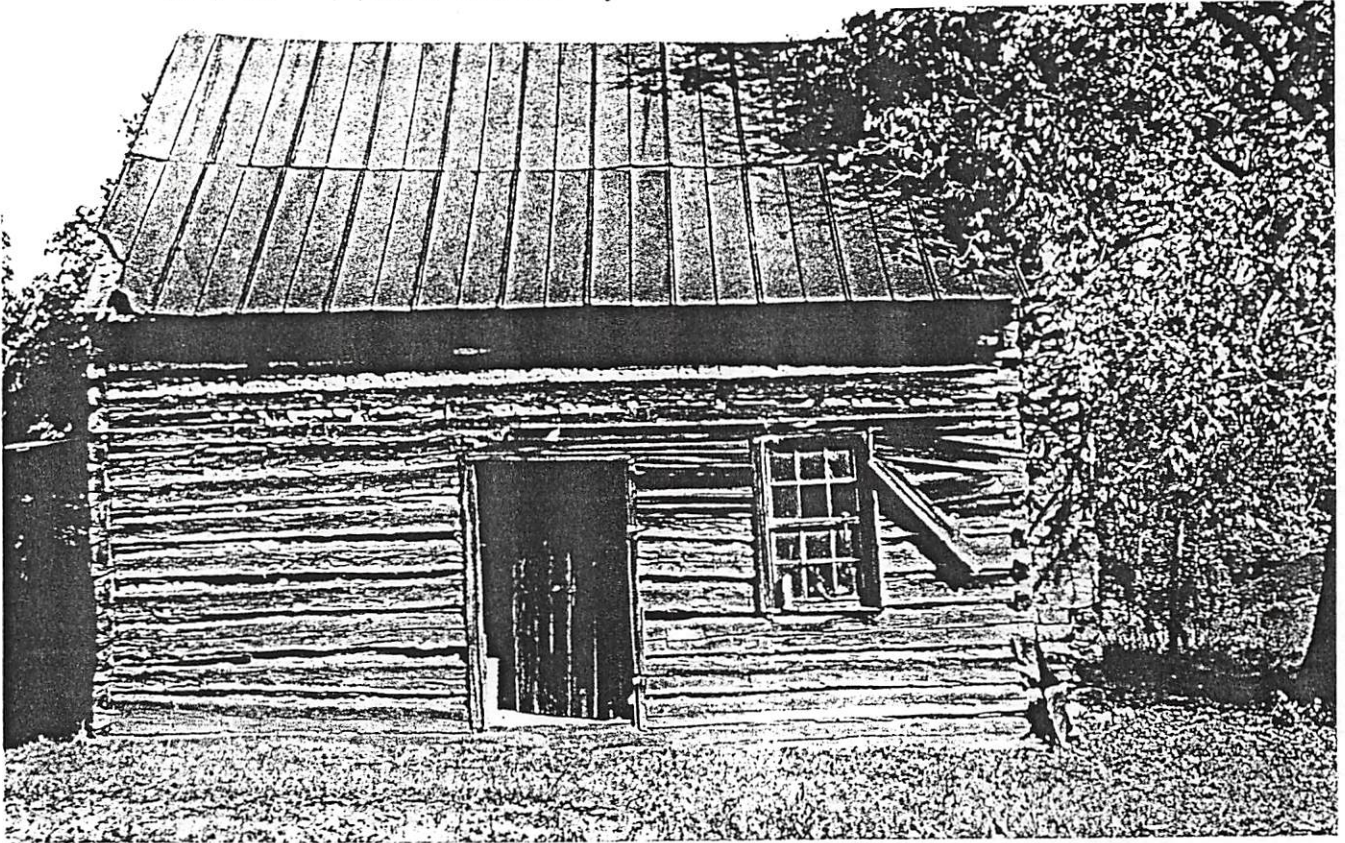

Pictured above is the 22 foot by 20 foot (exterior dimensions) log cabin where Von Ray and his first wife, Florence, lived and raised their family. Acie Ray, his brothers, and sisters were born in this home.

This structure is one of the oldest homes still standing in Wake County. Originally constructed with hewn logs, the dwelling was later enclosed with wood planks and covered with a tin roof. Most of the wood planks have fallen off. The stone fireplace and stone hearth were the original source of heat. The home consists of one room on the first floor with no partitions. The first floor served as kitchen, living room and bedroom for Von and Florence. The ceiling height is six foot ten inches to the six inch exposed beams. To the left of the entrance are winding corner stairs to the attic loft where the children slept.

Von Ray eventually built a farmhouse on the same property closer to the road. The new farmhouse is where Von and his second wife, Alma Harrison Ray, raised their seven children. Even after the farmhouse was occupied, Von's sons continued sleeping in the log cabin. The farmhouse burned to the ground in 1952 as a result of an electrical fire. Only the chimney was left standing and all of the family heirlooms and photographs were destroyed. No photographs of this farmhouse have been found. Von's son, Junius, owned the farmhouse and he built a new home on the foundation. Junius, his wife Ola, and their three children lived in the log cabin while their new home was under construction. The log cabin was last inhabited in 1954 and is beginning to show its age.

Junius' wife, Ola Keith Ray, still resides in the new home and owns the property containing the log cabin shown above. The log cabin is approximately seventy five yards behind her home. The property is on the west side of Creedmoor Road just north of the intersection with Old Creedmoor Road and south of the Neuse River. When Von was alive, his home was the first dwelling on the west side of Creedmoor Road south of the Neuse River. Relatives still hunt trophy bucks on this property.

Von Ray and his second wife, Alma Harrison Ray, had seven children during their 24 year marriage (five sons and one daughter--one unnamed child was still born) as listed below:

1. Mack Eunice Ray was born on May 23, 1915. Mack (age 18) married Euva Frances Cotton (also age 18) on November 27, 1933. They had one daughter (Joann). Mack was a Sergeant First Class in the Army in World War II. Mack died at the age of only 33 on February 9, 1949 while on active duty stationed at Ft. Myer in Arlington, Virginia. He is buried at Arlington National Cemetery (Section 12, Gravesite 1247).
2. Junius Hub Ray born in April 1916. Junius (age 22) married Ola Keith (age 18) on June 25, 1938. Junius and Ola had three children (Alma Lee, Nancy Ann, and Gene). Junius rented out his farm (property formerly owned by his father) and worked at textile mills in Butner and Durham, North Carolina. Junius died at age 69 in 1985 at Rex Hospital in Raleigh, N.C. (The same hospital where his father, Von Ray, died 46 years earlier.) He was over six feet tall and had blue eyes and black hair.
3. Alfonzo Columbus Ray, Jr. was born in April 1917 and was known as Von. Von (age 23) married Elenor Marshall in January of 1941 and they had six children (James, Joyce, Judy, Janice, Jerry and Johnny). Von worked at a lumber yard and also at Leggett & Myers Tobacco Company. Von died of a heart attack at age 49 in 1966.
4. Woodrow Wilson Ray was born on May 22, 1918. Woodrow was named after the 28<sup>th</sup> President of the United States (1913-1921). Apparently Von Ray was a Democrat. From the age of about 16 until almost 21, Woodrow worked on his father's farm "in the production of crops." Woodrow enlisted in the Army on April 7, 1939 six weeks before his twenty-first birthday. While stationed at nearby Fort Butner in Granville County, North Carolina, Woodrow met his future wife, Coma Watson, at a post dance. Due to World War II, Woodrow's tour of duty was extended and he served six and one half years on active duty. Woodrow attained the rank of Staff Sergeant and spent his last year in the Army in Germany in Battery A of the 903<sup>rd</sup> Field Artillery Battalion. Woodrow was awarded three decorations and service medals: (1) European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal with three bronze stars signifying participation in three combat campaigns (Rhineland, Ardennes, and Central Europe), (2) Good Conduct Medal and (3) American Defense Service Medal. Woodrow married Coma Watson and they had seven children (Ronald Wilson, Linda Carol, Robert Lee, Ann Sherrill, Bradley Wayne, Susan Gayle, and Teresa Lynn). Woodrow was a policeman in Durham from 1945 until his death at age 52 on July 15, 1970. Woodrow was five feet eleven inches tall and had brown eyes and dark brown hair.
5. Frances Caroline Ray born on August 23, 1919. Caroline was a beautiful woman. She married Coy J. Forsythe and they had seven children (J.C., Crystal, Jean, Peggy, Eddie, Ray and David). Caroline died at age 62 on July 1, 1982.
6. Joseph Ray was born on August 29, 1923 and he was 16 years old when his father died in 1939. At age 21, Joe married Nina Dillard on October 28, 1944 and they had one child, Betty Ray. Joe worked as a machine adjuster at Leggett & Myers Tobacco Company. Joe died at age 57 on November 13, 1980. Joe was approximately five feet seven inches tall and had blue eyes and black hair.

Ola Keith married Junius Ray in 1938 and she lived with her husband in the home of Von Ray, her father-in-law, for the last eighteen months of his life. Ola recalls Von stating that Joe was his seventeenth son. Joe is still referred to as Joe #17. Von Ray had twenty children — 17 sons and 3 daughters, but only 11 lived to be adults. Two of Von's sons, Percie and Mack, and one of his grandsons, Albert Ray, are honored by burial at Arlington National Cemetery. They rest on Virginia land across the Potomac River from the Lincoln Memorial on property once owned by Confederate General Robert E. Lee. Best known of more than one hundred national cemeteries in the United States, Arlington's green slopes shelter veterans from every war that has involved this nation. Percie (1893-1948) was a Corporal in the Army during World War I. Mack (1915-1949) was a Sergeant in the Army during World War II. Albert Ray (1923-1992), son of Percie and Elsie, served in the Navy for twenty years during World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War. Albert retired as a Petty Officer First Class.



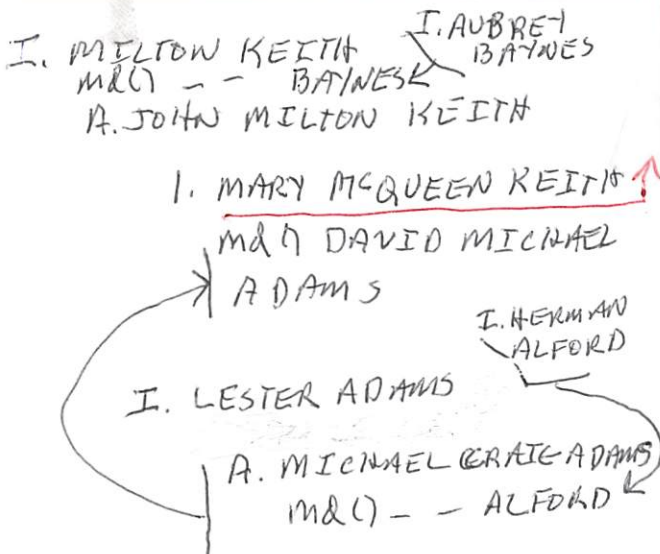

He Kendrick came from Catham County, North Carolina to Wake County, North Carolina and settled on a plantation known as the "old farm" development in 1983 located on Buck Jones Road "adjoining the belt line just north of the South Hills Shopping Center (Source: Families of Wake County [North Carolina] published in 1983). He was considered the champion boxer or fighter of Chatham County according to his great-grandchild. When he moved to Wake County, he was challenged by the champion of Wake County. "Not wanting to engage in a fight great-grandfather suggested that there be no fight and that the Wake County champion retain his title." However, the Wake County champ insisted on a fight to settle the issue. The Wake County champ was invited to dinner by Goodwin and after dinner the furniture was pulled back in the room and the two men pulled off their coats. The Wake County champ was offered the first blow. Then Goodwin took his turn and knocked the Wake County champ through the side of the house. From outside the house the Wake County champ yelled for his hat and coat and reportedly said: "Mr. Goodwin, you are the champion of Wake County." (Source: Families of Wake County [North Carolina] published in 1983). In 1840 Kendrick is shown on the Swift Creek Township tax list as owning no land, however he owned two slaves and did pay the poll tax. His total taxes were \$1.95. [Wake County, North Carolina Census and Tax List Abstracts 1830 and 1840 compiled by Frances Holloway Wynne 1985 available in the Olivia Raney Library, 4016 Cara Drive, Raleigh, NC 27610]. The 1850 US Census lists Kendrick, 37, as living in the Western Division of Wake County with his wife Nancy, 39, and four children: Moriah, 10; Sarah, 9; William, 7; Virginia, 5, and Henry, 2. Kendrick is listed a carpenter and could not read or write. nancy can read and write.

Navy Petty Officer 2nd Class Sterling P. Keith, a 1985 graduate of Bunn High School, recently returned from a six-month Mediterranean Sea deployment aboard the amphibious assault ship USS Saipan, homeported in Norfolk, Va., as lead ship in its Mediterranean Amphibious Ready Group.

During its time in the Mediterranean, the MARG steamed nearly 20,000 miles and participated in four bilateral amphibious training exercises, a press release stated. Additionally, the MARG operated in the Adriatic in support of operations Deny Flight, which enforces the U.N. sanctioned "no-fly zone" over Bosnia-Herzegovina; Provide Promise, a relief effort for

war-torn former Yugoslavia; and Sharp Guard, NATO's enforcement of U.N.-imposed economic sanctions in the region.

The MARG also took part in major bilateral exercises with Spain, Tunisia and Greece. Keith visited Palma de Mallorca and Rota, Spain; Haifa, Israel; Naples, Italy; and Rhodes, Greece.

In Naples, sailors and Marines visited an orphanage where they cleared a large section of the yard which was covered with weeds and vines. In Sicily, they repaired and painted another orphanage.

The MARG consisted of the USS Saipan, USS Ponce and USS Pensacola, as well as more than 2,000 Marines from the 26th Marine Expeditionary Unit. The Navy and Marine Corps are capable of a full range of action — from humanitarian relief to major offensive actions, from the sea, a press release stated.
