The couple met in early 1997, after he had given a talk to the Raleigh Amateur Radio Society, where she was in the audience. She thought she saw something familiar in the speaker, asked around, and finally concluded, after several weeks, that he might be the same fellow she had dated at Columbia University over 50 years ago.

The bride had a long career as soprano soloist and piano instructor. For the wedding, one of her oldest friends, composer Dr. Rose Marie Cooper, played a movement of her piano sonata and the world premier of "Ritornello," a three-part impromptu she had written for the occasion that describes the bride, the bridegroom and their reunion.

The bride was led into the room by flower girl Jessica Kilkelly, her granddaughter, and presented for marriage by her son, Gary Kilkelly, and his sister, Sharon Kilkelly Rogers. The bridesmaid was the bridegroom's daughter, Janet Hutchins of Burlington, Mass. Best man was the bride's son-in-law, Terrence Rogers of Durham.

Floral arrangements for the room and wedding participants were arranged and contributed by longtime friend Gwen Baskett. A reception dinner was held in the adjacent historic 1833 plantation house of Gary Kilkelly, prepared by daughter-in-law Joanie. The three-tiered wedding cake was a gift of the bride's daughter.

The couple will divide their time between Chapel Hill and the farm on Old Bunn Road, just outside Zebulon.
