Zebulon camp leads fight for Confederate cemetery funds

Summer 1863. The army of the Confederate States of America followed the Shenandoah Valley through Virginia, pushing up into Pennsylvania. There, they were met by Union troops near the town of Gettysburg.

Among their number was Henry King Burgwyn Jr., the "Boy Colonel." Two years earlier, Burgwyn had been ranked first in his class at Virginia Military Institute and headed to a promising military career. Those plans changed when the Southern states formed the CSA. He entered the Confederate army as a captain and, within months, had been named a lieutenant colonel and placed in command of the 26th North Carolina Regiment.

Now a full colonel, Burgwyn led his troops in an assault on Gen. Solomon Meredith's "Iron Brigade" during the first day of the Battle of Gettysburg. In less than an hour of fighting, 584 of the 800 North Carolinians were killed or wounded. Burgwyn was trying to advance the battle flag when he was struck in the side, the shot passing through both lungs. As ambulance corps workers tended him, Burgwyn report-

edly told them, "I know my gallant regiment will do their duty — where is my sword?" He then died. He was 21 years old.

Pvt. Miles Mason was 33. Second Lt. William W. Boggan was 21. Sgt. Charles A. Watkins was 19. North Carolinians all, they died at Gettysburg, as did 20,000 Confederate troops. Some men had enlisted, some had been drafted. Some had come from families that owned slaves, but most had not.

Summer 1995. A group of eastern Wake residents has taken the role of flag bearer in a struggle to protect the memory of those North Carolinian casualties.

The Wendell-Zebulon Sons of Confederate Veterans, Col. Henry King Burgwyn Jr. Camp No. 1485, is lobbying the N.C. General Assembly to put money in the state budget to keep up the cemetery where these troops are buried.

Located in, but separate from, Oakwood Cemetery in Raleigh, the Confederate Cemetery is the resting place for around 1,400 men. Troops from every county in North Carolina are there. Some died at Gettysburg; others fell try-

ing to repel Sherman's troops at Bentonville; still others survived the war and into the 1920s.

The General Assembly helped found the cemetery in 1867 and, beginning in 1919, gave \$250 a year — later increased to \$350 a year — for upkeep. Three years ago, though, the state eliminated funding. Officials justified the action by saying it cost the state more to write the check than the check was worth.

"It had the flavor of spite," said Dennis Kidwell of Knightdale, an officer in the Burgwyn camp. "They seemed to be saying 'We're going to stamp out Southern history every chance we get.'"

"I can write a check for about 25 cents," added Tom Smith, the camp's commander.

Smith and Kidwell spoke with me last Friday during a break in the lobbying effort to get funding restored to the cemetery. The Sons of Confederate Veterans are seeking to get \$5,000 set aside each year for the cemetery's upkeep.

The local camp has been

involved with the cemetery since 1989. At that time, the cemetery had been neglected for several years, Smith said. Overgrown trees had cut off light to much of the cemetery. Fallen leaves and limbs had been allowed to lay. As a result, much of the grass had died out and erosion had left some graves, which had been dug shallowly anyway, about a foot or so below the surface.

The cemetery was also a haven for drug addicts, Smith said.

Although there had been the annual allotment for upkeep, the United Daughters of the Confederacy, the cemetery's owners, had traditionally saved the money for a few years and taken care of bigger projects, such as cleaning the House of Memories, a structure bearing plaques honoring the dead of all major U.S. wars, Smith said. It wasn't enough money to effectively tend the cemetery on a regular basis.

Over the past six years, the 80 members of the Burgwyn camp have spearheaded an effort by the five camps in Wake County to fix up the cemetery. They have expended thousands of hours, mostly on physical labor but also time spent doing research, connecting names to grave markers, Smith said. They've petitioned the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs for tombstones for the graveyard, then placed the 235-pound stones as they arrived.

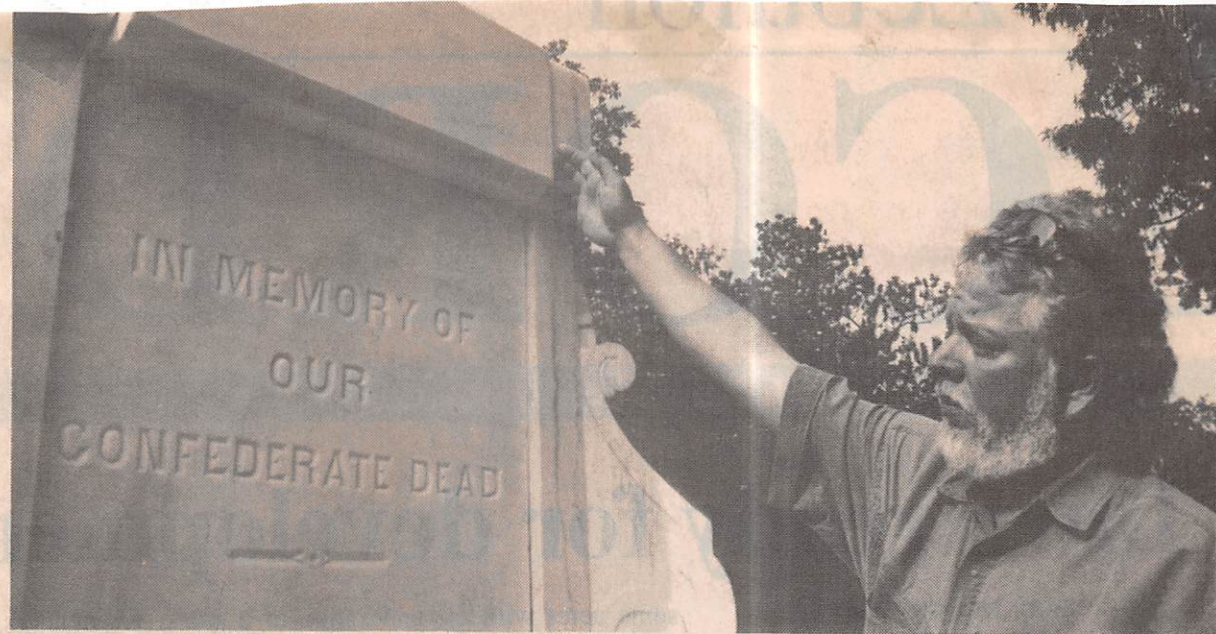
"The Sons of Confederate Veterans has worked our butts off," Smith said.

Still, their efforts have gotten the cemetery only so far, and everything that has been accomplished could be lost to neglect, he added.

"We're not concerned about getting the grass mowed next week," he said. "We're concerned

about getting the grass cut after we're gone."

The \$5,000 amount would be "a token amount" in the state Department of Cultural Resources' \$43 million annual budget, Smith explained, but it would be a start.

The main obstacle to the budget amendment has been N.C. Rep. Sam Ellis of Garner, who repre-

sents Knightdale and part of Wendell. Ellis has described the cemetery as "a pork project."

"I agree with Sam in his efforts to curb pork spending," Smith said. However, the Confederate Cemetery is not an example of frivolous spending, he argued; it is a fulfillment of the state's obligation to its veterans, many of whom were pressed into service.

"Is veterans affairs pork? Is Arlington National Cemetery pork?" Smith said. "This is definitely not a pork project."

Ellis' strong stand on the issue, though, has made other legislators unwilling to sponsor a bill to reinstate the spending, Smith said. He will keep trying, though.

"I'm going to keep knocking on doors," Smith said.

Bert said he would, and that "you can tell the guy that lives in that big house he has a week to get out." The big house was the home of the General Manager.

Bertram worked his way up to General Manager, until a debilitating stroke sent him on home.

Expansion threatens farm; family pleads for help

To the Editor:

Can the town take our farm, after 200 years?

I was so pleased a few weeks ago when Wake County named the Bennett Bunn Plantation a historic landmark. Our Kilkelly Farm is a portion of the original plantation, but it holds the original 1785 buildings and the 1833 plantation house. It has been in the same family and continuously farmed for over 213 years! This represents thrifty management and even sacrifice, through wars, depressions and family catastrophes.

Now, suddenly, we learn that the town of Zebulon is planning to take it away from us by extending its extraterritorial jurisdiction yet again to include an additional 3,800 acres.

We understand that the "town fathers" want to zone all this beautiful land for

industry, despite their inability for at least 15 years to sell miles along the highways which are already zoned industrial and have water, sewer, service road and even rail access.

We understand that the scheme is to use these farms to pay for the water and sewer lines to feed the hoped-for industry to the east. The costs of such lines are not paid for by the town and its taxpayers but by the landowners past which they run.

Farms with long frontages, such as ours on Old Bunn Road and many others, pay by the foot, which we figure might cost us hundreds of thousands of dollars. Farms do not make enough to afford such charges, resulting in forced sale to pay for water lines which they may not even use. Help us!

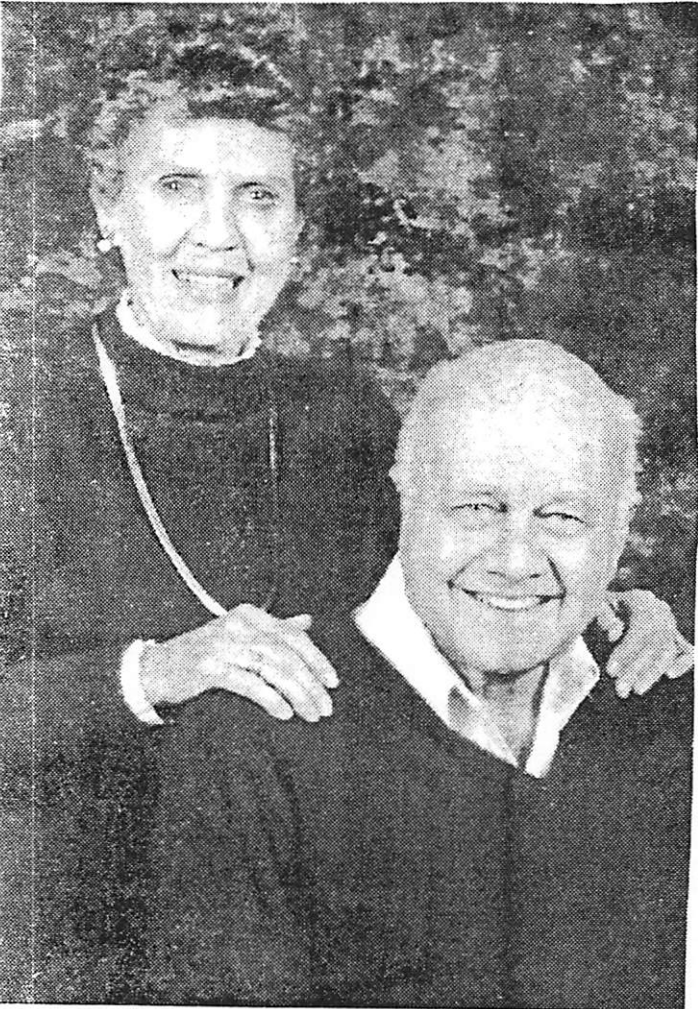

The couple met in early 1997, after he had given a talk to the Raleigh Amateur Radio Society, where she was in the audience. She is a graduate of Greensboro College and The Julliard School. After graduating from Julliard, she joined Phil Spitalney's All-Girl Orchestra, heard weekly for years on the NBC network. She then spent two seasons with the chorus of the San Francisco Opera. In her 24 years in Greensboro, she was active as soloist in West Market Methodist Church, and in local operettas, oratorios and concerts. She was president of the Zebulon Woman's Club during 1983 and '84, and a member of the Zebulon Board of Commissioners from 1985-89.

The groom, a native of New York City, is the son of Leroy William Hutchins and Mabel M. Reagh of Michigan. His three children by the late Dorothea M. Hutchins of Lexington, Mass., are James, now residing in San Francisco, Calif.; Robert, in Patagonia, Ariz., and Janet.

With electrical engineering degrees from Columbia University, he is president and owner of Future Concepts Inc., a technical consulting firm. His career began in the laboratory of radio inventor Edwin H. Armstrong, including development of a FM radar during World War II, as well as some of the pioneering projects relating to FM broadcasting and the first military FM radio.
