KENYON JONES DEAD

His Body Found in the Courthouse Yesterday

DIFD OF GAS ASPHYXIA

The Dead Man Found While Searching for a Leak in Gas Fixtures—Has Been Gourt Cryer for Six Years—Had a Room in Courthourse in Which He Slept—Evidently He Left Gas on by Accident

The dead body of Mr. Kenyon Jones, the well known Wake county court cryer was found in a room on the first floor of the county court house in this city yesterday afternoon.

A fume of gas which accumulated rapidly in the halls and offices of the court house caused the investigation which led to the ghastly find and leaves no room for doubt that accidental asphyxiation by gas caused the death.

The body was found by Deputy Sheriff N. E. Reddick in a small room just across the hall from the sheriff's office. It is a room to which Mr. Jones always carried a key, keeping, as he did, a cot in the room on which he always slept when he spent the night in the cny, the during and between the sessions of art. His home was near Cary.

The smell of gas had gotten so strong the rear of the court house that close arch was being made for a leakage in he gas pipes or gets, and after a vain ten in nearly every other piace from which it could come, Mr. Addick bethought himself of the fact that the aged crier, Mr. Jones, was in the city the night before and had gone to this room about 10:30 o'clock, when he and Deputy Parham left the sheriff's office for the night. He told "Lish" itoy, the cook at the jail, to look into Mr. Jones' room, He found the door locked and peeping through the keyhole, saw him on the cot. Mr. Riddick procured necessary implements and broke open the door, finding the old man on the cot cold in death. The body was in a position which the man would most naturally take in his sleep and there was no mark on the body which would indacate a violent death.

One jet of the gas burner was "turned on" and the room was dense with the eadly vapor. The doors and windows here thrown open and the place ventilated before any examination could be made or attention given the body at all.

Mr. M. G. Jones, a son of the dead man, was notified at once and later in the evening had the body removed to his residence, 232 Sanders street.

The most plausible theory as to the way in which the gas jet was left open is that Mr. Jones, who was decrepid and feeble, in reaching up to turn the light out, without realizing it turned the thumb screw back again allowing the gas to escape into the room.

The deceased has been serving as court cryer for Sheriff Page for eight years, that is, during both of Mr. t'age's terms of office. He also served as jailor under Sheriff Nowell more than ten years ago. He was twice married, the second wife surviving him; also one child by the second marriage and five by the first. Of these G. M. Jones is in the employ of the Southern cailroad Co., W. F. Jones is township constable at Cary and Mr. M. G. Jones is engineer at the Blind Institution. A daughter, Mrs. Hellen King, resides here and a son, Clayton Jones, lives in Norfolk.

The deceased is well known throughout the county, especially for the efficient service as court sryer and the news of his death will be received with sincere regret by hundreds of friends.
