
The Architecture of Henry John Klutho:

reputable architects in offering their services to the population.<sup>13</sup> By October 1901 over a thousand building permits had been issued. Under the city's new regulations, the fire chief was named building inspector, and all builders were required to file detailed construction plans and to use fire-resistant slate, tile, or four-ply gravel-covered roofs.<sup>14</sup> Klutho assessed the welter of activity and, confident of his own ability, determined to stay in Jacksonville and to become a leader in the rebuilding. He had youth and enthusiasm balanced by business and graphics training, seven years of practical office experience, and a two-year tenure as a New York architect. His training and qualifications exceeded those of most architects in the city, but he was also aware that, as a young newcomer,

he needed to establish his credentials. He became acquainted with local business leaders and accepted a short-lived junior partnership with J. W. Golucke of Atlanta.

The arrangement was probably convenient for both: Golucke was an older, established architect in the region, who probably wanted an agent and a percentage of the commissions to be had in Jacksonville. Klutho needed a "name" until he had made one for himself. Even this early in his career, his confidence in his own talents and his preference for working alone were evident. "In the land of the blind, a one-eyed man is king," he told a gathering of local architects.<sup>15</sup> Henry John Klutho intended to be king. The July 12, 1901, *Florida Times-Union and Citizen* carried an article on the new firm: "These two well-known architects, associated in Jacksonville, make a firm with whom prospective builders need not be afraid to trust their work." The firm of Golucke and Klutho worked out of a boardinghouse at 222 West Adams Street, which was also Klutho's residential address until 1904.<sup>16</sup> In housing-short Jacksonville, Klutho's room had to contain everything necessary for living and working. He

design was new to the people of Jacksonville, but newspapers, builders, and architects all spoke of the Renaissance style as that favored by the most eminent New York architects. That style, the *Times-Union* and *Citizen* told its readers, "will set the tone for the architectural future of the city."<sup>21</sup>

Although it went unnoticed by the citizens of Jacksonville, Klutho's work differed from the prevailing style. He consciously used the adjective "modern" to qualify the traditional labels attached to his designs. The cleaner lines and more precise ornamentation gave evidence that he was already beginning to move toward a style of his own (and of his own era). A good example is another 1901 commission, the St. Clair Abrams Mausoleum in the Catholic section of Evergreen Cemetery. This small but elegant tomb was constructed at a cost of \$3,000. It was built of white Georgia marble, with a copper cornice and cross,



St. Clair Abrams tomb as it appears today (J.H.L.C.).


received the first of his many commissions almost immediately, from Frank Upchurch, newly arrived leader in the lumber and turpentine business.

The Dyal-Upchurch Company, previously of Moniac, Georgia, purchased a site located on the southeast corner of Bay and Main streets in July 1901. The August 4 *Times-Union and Citizen* announced that "the design and plans for the handsome five-story business block to be erected by the Dyal-Upchurch Company, at a cost of \$75,000.00, have been completed by architect H. J. Klutho, of New York City and the firm of Golucke and Klutho." Preparation of the site at the edge of the St. Johns River had begun, according to the newspaper, but a building permit was not issued until January 17, 1902.<sup>17</sup>

The Dyal-Upchurch building had a U-shaped plan that fronted on Bay Street. Midway through the work, the plans were altered to include a sixth floor, since 60 percent of the space had already been rented and the demand for offices made the change a sound investment.<sup>18</sup> The building was constructed on wooden pilings driven into the riverbed. The exterior walls were brick load-bearing, interior columns were 6-inch cast-iron with I-beam girders 20 inches deep. However, wood joists 3 by 14 inches spanning the girders and partitions of wood lath and plaster finish were evidence that the lessons of the great fire had not been applied to interior construction. On January 3, 1915, faulty wiring started a fire that heavily damaged the building, considered fireproof when it was constructed.<sup>19</sup>

The Dyal-Upchurch Building was the first and last Golucke-Klutho commission. It was completed and occupied in May 1902 after a rapid construction that employed as many as 102 men at a time. It contained the Atlantic National Bank and various stores on the first floor and ninety-five offices on the upper floors. A newspaper described the style as French Renaissance, leaning toward the Italian, with striking ornamentation. Klutho himself described it in 1905 as "Modern Renaissance . . . with rather severe lines and void of ornamentation."<sup>20</sup>

The striking difference between the newspaper's description and Klutho's indicates the lack of understanding of architecture in Jacksonville at the time. As the entire downtown was being rebuilt, the design of buildings continued to hold civic interest. For each competitive contract, public or private, drawings were displayed in store windows so that citizens could react and give their views in newspaper interviews. Virtually the whole concept of architectural


tils occurred above cast-iron ventilators placed in pairs above each of the three large windows, separated from corbeled brick by two additional projecting bands of brick. The construction was of brick bearing walls and heavy timber beams and roof joists, supported on cast-iron columns.<sup>21</sup> The addition, as finally completed and as it appears today, was built according to Klutho's design.

However, something happened to alter the initial decision to complete the addition by October 1, 1909. There are no accounts of the progress made between August 1909 and November 7, 1910, when the Drew Building collapsed, reportedly killing two workmen and injuring five. Newspaper accounts list W. B. Camp as the architect, and the Hadlow Company of Daytona Beach had

reversion to more traditional ornament are shown. These drawings were made from original drawings, photographs, and observation of works still standing at the time this book was in preparation. Architect Robert Ben Porter, Jr., did most of the pencil drawings, which were then rendered in pen and ink by the author.

Preparation of all the drawings in one medium and with the scale noted allows a comparative analysis of Klutho's development as a designer of uniquely personal architectural ornament. Some works were large: the pilaster capitals of the St. James Building tower (not shown) are over seven feet high, and each of the terra-cotta ornaments on the front facade of the Morocco Temple is eleven feet in height.

As delightful as Klutho's ornament is to see, it does not fit easily into any established academic or historical classification. Perhaps we can say that, like many of the gifted architects of the emerging post-modern school of design, Klutho was a truly creative, eclectic designer. What made him different was that his strongest beliefs were centered in the "New American" architecture of the Prairie School, which celebrated the search for new expressive forms rather than copying those of the past.
