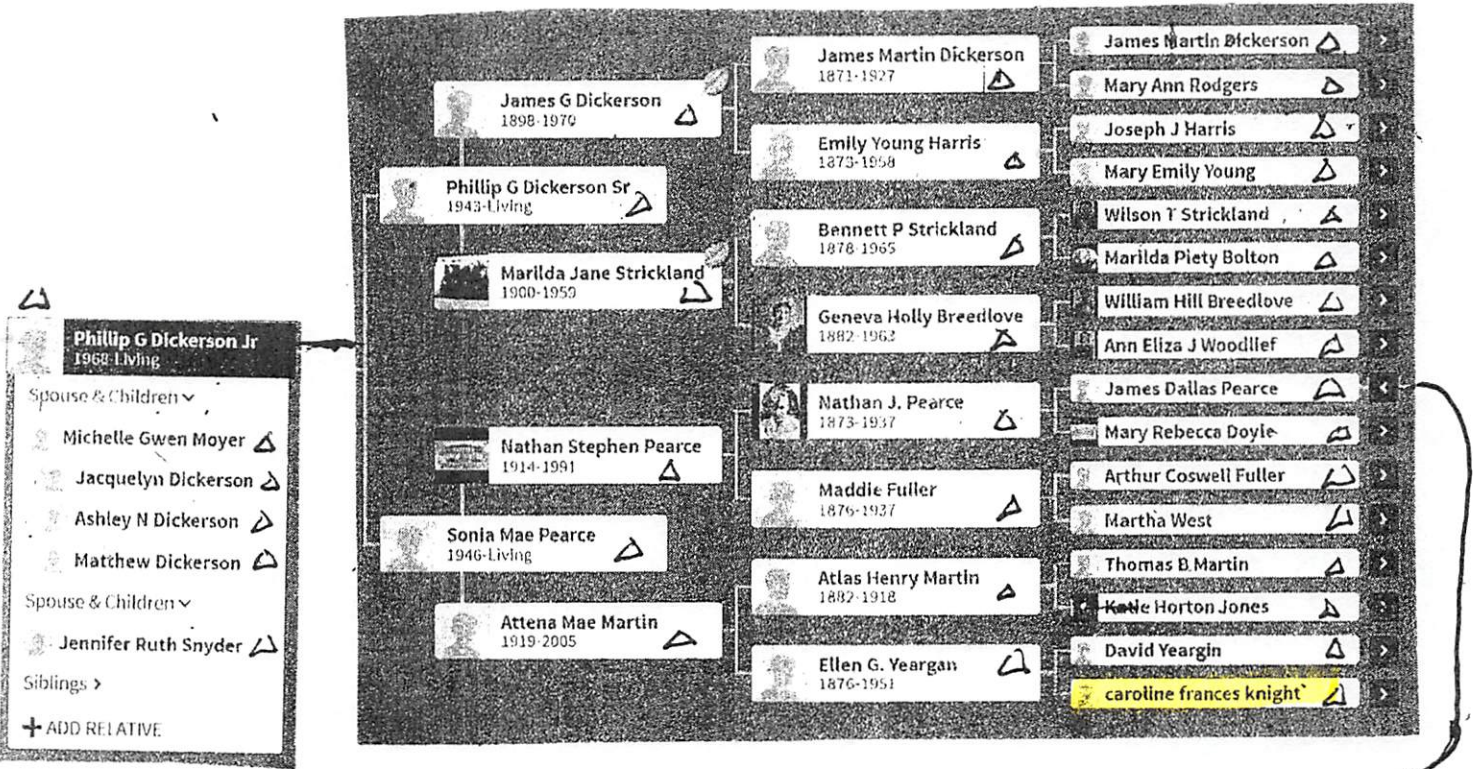

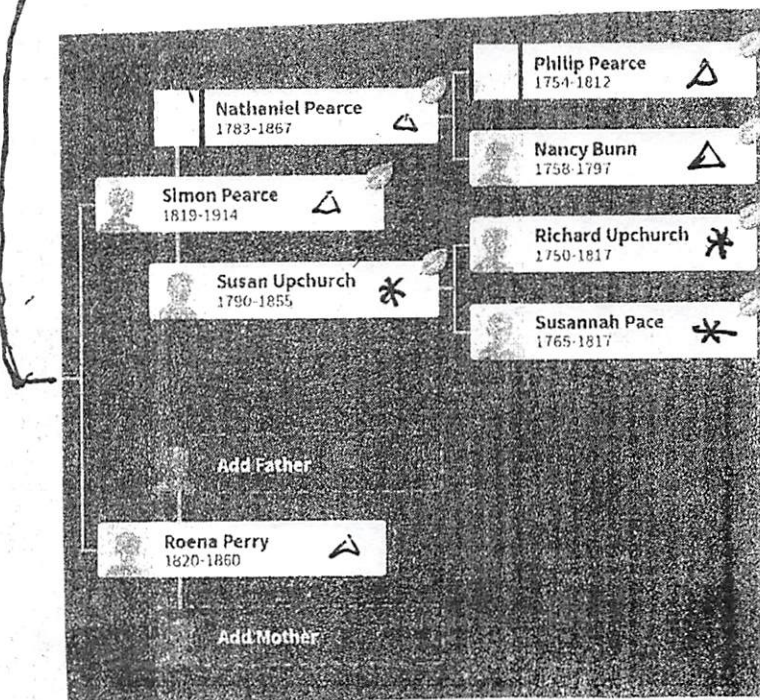

Eastern Wake County is an area that people have called home for more than 300 years.

Historians believe the Tuscarora Indians lived in the Marks Creek area, east of Knightdale, at the dawn of the 18th century. Food and wildlife were plentiful here. In fact, legend has it that panthers lived along the Neuse River at that time.

One of the first white men to pass through this area was English explorer John Lawson, who followed the river into the present-day Wake County. English settlers followed in his wake; homesteads began popping up in this area around 1740.

EDGAR BARDEE

The heritage of eastern Wake County has been, and continues to be, tied closely to tobacco, but today the area hosts several industries that employ more people than the gold leaf. We still enjoy a slow pace of life here.

Work began on the city of Raleigh and the state capital in the late part of the 1700s. By that time, several small communities had sprung up in eastern Wake County. Three — Knightdale, Wendell and Zebulon — eventually became towns, while others — Eagle Rock and Shotwell — remain small communities. Why some grew and some did not can be attributed to some degree to the Raleigh-Pamlico railroad, which was built around 1905. The railway primarily carried lumber and cotton products, but it also attracted new businesses and citizens to the area.

Who we are

The eastern Wake route of the railroad tracks resulted from the work of several people, including Henry Haywood Knight, commonly regarded as the father of Knightdale.

Knight, whose family owned much of the land in what is now Knightdale, was a community leader at the turn of the century. He and others arranged for the construction of the first Knightdale school, a one-room building on First Avenue, around 1900.

He is thought to have been instrumental in getting the railroad to put its tracks through Knightdale. The depot was built on land donated by Knight.

The land around the depot grew into a business district, which formed the basis of the town, chartered by the state of North Carolina March 9, 1927.

The town of Wendell grew out of the seed that was the one-room Rhodes School House, which was built in the days before the American Civil War, or the "War Between the States" as many in this area still call the conflict. Named for landowner Ambrose Rhodes, the school was

renamed Wendell Preparatory School around 1890 in honor of the poet Oliver Wendell Holmes, a favorite of then-Schoolmaster M.A. Griffin.

Shortly afterward, a Wendell post office opened in a store belonging to J.R. Nowell. Restored by the Wendell Historical Society, the original post office is currently located on Fourth Street.

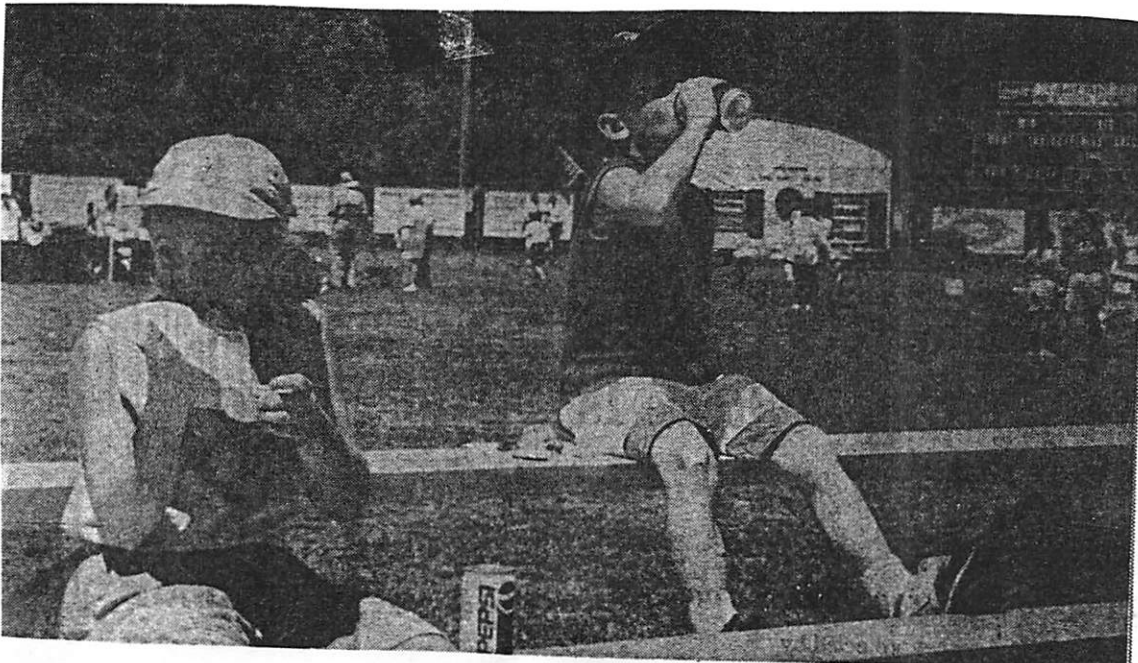
The town of Wendell was incorporated March 6, 1903.

One of the town's first major establishments came from the efforts of R.B. Whitley, C.Z. Todd, Amos Dean and others, who formed the Bank of Wendell in 1907. Whitley served as the bank's president until his death in 1944. He also was a town official and a state legislator at different times.

The town of Zebulon also resulted from businessmen working together. Falconer Arendell of Wakefield and Edgar Barbee of Barclaysville founded the Zebulon Co. in 1906 and purchased 90 acres that served as the heart of the new town.

With development in full swing, the N.C. General Assembly passed an act the following year — Feb. 16, 1907 — which incorporated the town. The original boundaries consisted of 297 acres. The town has grown to cover more than 3,600 acres.

Taylor's historical hobby is a family thing

Eddie Taylor had the type of parents who always wanted to do something educational while they were on vacation. So, as a kid, he was dragged through dusty ghost towns, battered old forts and museums.

Somewhere along the way, he picked up a lifelong passion.

"Their interest in history sparked mine," Taylor said. "What I enjoyed most was reading stories not necessarily of the great men, but of the day-to-day routine of ordinary people."

In particular, he recalls a trip the Raleigh family made to Gettysburg, Pa., where Union soldiers turned back Confederate troops in 1863 in the pivotal confrontation of the Civil War. "Seeing the same ground that they fought on and died on, it made a strong impression on me," he said.

After his expeditions, Taylor would return home and "read everything I could on the sites," he said.

That drive has now led him to want to write about history, in particular, that of Knightdale and the surrounding communities. In recent years, Taylor has published articles about a fire that nearly destroyed the old downtown area in 1940; Hinton Lane, a one-time plank road that can be seen as a trail near Planter's Walk; and Henry Haywood Knight, the town's name-

sake, and his involvement as a Confederate soldier at Gettysburg, among others.

He has also scoured woods near the town to find old slave graveyards that, once sighted, can be

protected from logging operations. As a member of the Knightdale Heritage Commission, since disbanded, he helped get the Knight family home place on the National Register of Historic Places.

The past is alive in eastern Wake County, he said. "If you listen closely to the people, it's still here."

What Taylor hopes to do is add to the public record of this area's history so that future generations will know more about the forces and people that shaped eastern Wake County. He has always found the people of Knightdale, Wendell and Zebulon to be "keenly interested"

in their heritage, he said. What he does is feed that interest.

"I try not to focus on names and dates; I'd rather tell the story behind the story," he said.

For every Lee or Grant, there were "thousands and thousands" of people who helped shape how this country developed, he said. Taylor is concerned about how they lived.

People 50, 100, even 200 years ago are much like people today, he said. If you read their diaries, letters and papers, you will find their motivations, desires and beliefs are not at all foreign or unusual. "To be honest, we have not changed much at all," Taylor said. Only the pace of life has accelerated, he added.

"History is more than just the names and dates we learned in school," he explained. "When you strip it down to its bare bones, history is the story of people."

Exploring the story of Knightdale's people is rewarding, he said.

After moving to town 15 years ago, "I was amazed to find so much history in this area," he said. "We have a heritage here in Knightdale that we can be very proud of."

Since Knightdale was only incorporated in 1927, at least a handful of people are still around that can give firsthand accounts of the town's early days, Taylor said. In fact, the community traces its origin back to the turn of the century and the construction of the railroad tracks through town.

The Knight family was instrumental in luring the railroad here, along with the donation of land for a school and a church. Had the rail-

road gone instead to Shotwell, a community of equal or greater size at the time, Knightdale probably wouldn't exist today as more than a crossroads, Taylor said.

Now, with the town's rapid growth, many of the still existing landmarks are threatened by development. Taylor terms himself "middle-of-the-road" on what should be kept. "You can't preserve everything," he said. If every property with any historic qualities was off-limits, construction in Wake County would probably come to a halt.

It's necessary to "pick and choose" what is important enough to be protected, he said. He aids in this job through his company, The Taylor Group. Acting as a consultant, Taylor researches the history of properties throughout North Carolina. Some of the research is required by local or state regulations before development can begin. "I might need to find out if an open field wasn't once a landfill" or atop the remnants of a historic site, he said.

He also researches the lineage of groups or organizations.

If this house could talk, what stories it could tell

Along U.S. 64 East, opposite the Knightdale Crossing shopping center and about 100 yards west of Smithfield Road, stands a large white house that played a key role in the creation of the town of Knightdale.

Chances are that you have passed it many times either going shopping or to work. If houses could talk, this one would tell an interesting story of how Knightdale came to be.

•••

In the mid-1800s, this area was much different than it is today. The low, rolling waves of land were covered with stands of many species of trees and thick underbrush. The air was clean and pure. It was a very quiet area, teeming with

wildlife and not yet disturbed by man.

Occasionally you would find a clear spot where some ambitious farmer had tried to clear just enough land for a small field. It was a rich land and with its gentle hills, it seemed ideally suited for farming. All it needed was a farmer willing to work.

That farmer was born in Wake County in 1842. Henry Haywood Knight was born on a farm and seemed to be destined to farm for the rest of his life, as most young lads did in those days. As he grew up, he learned to farm by working along with his father on the family land.

When he was 20, the Civil War began and he found that the call to excitement was more than he could resist. He joined the 47th Regiment of the North Carolina Troops and a year later, he found himself fighting in the bloody battle of Gettysburg. He was wounded and taken a prisoner of war. At that time,

many of the POWs were taken to Fort Delaware and held until they were paroled at the end of the war. After his release, young Knight returned to his father's farm and resumed helping his father.

This ambitious young man began to acquire land of his own, much of it along both sides of Tarboro Road (we know that as U.S. 64 East today). He courted a young lady named Bettie Smith and in 1894 they were married.

The young couple built a house on a parcel of land that Knight had acquired at an auction. It is interesting that he bought it in 1887, exactly 100 years ago. That house stands for us to see today, a monument to their love, toil and dreams.

In the first nine years of their marriage, the Knights had four daughters and one son. The house witnessed the birth of all of their children, and as they grew up, they spent many warm summer days playing in the clearing behind it.

Oil lamps lit the house during the dark winter months, and Knight spent many cold evenings in front of the fireplace planning and dreaming. He made plans for the things that he hoped to accomplish during the warmer spring and summer days. Next to the house he built a small store to provide supplies for the area farmers.

At that time, most of the farms were growing money crops such as tobacco, corn or cotton. Few were producing the essentials that they needed, and Knight's store provided them with many of the items that they couldn't or wouldn't grow on the farms. The store proved to be a wise decision, and the business grew and was very profitable. With it close to the house, Knight could fill the customers' orders at almost any time.

The house stood silently as its owner built a sawmill and a cotton gin across the street. Processions of wagons passed by loaded with raw materials and then passed again on the return trip, filled with the finished product. Slowly, Knight became a businessman and farmer, and his holdings grew.

He spent many late evenings keeping the books and sharing his plans and dreams with his wife. In one of his more ambitious plans, he visualized a small town in the middle of this farmland. He met with other farmers to discuss his ideas and try to find solutions to problems such as the lack of a school for their children.

He built a small building near his house that served as the first Knightdale school. On weekdays the building was the school and on Sundays it was the local church. They called this first church Knight's Chapel.

A small Baptist congregation worshiped at this meeting place. The teachers at the school boarded with the Knight family in their house. The house served as a hub from which all of the other services radiated.

If the house could talk, it would tell us of the winters with their cold rain, ice and snow. It was small enough to be warm and cozy in the winter, yet large enough to allow the cooling summer breezes to blow through its many windows. It could also tell us about the many children who grew up there and had families of their own. Generations have passed through its doors.

Henry Knight's prosperity caused the area to prosper. Others were attracted to the area because of the many services that were available. His keen business sense earned the respect of the farmers in the area. He became a county magistrate. His final accomplishment was his election to the post of Wake County treasurer, a post in which he served two terms.

In 1902, the house saw the birth of Knight's youngest child, who would never get to know its father. One cool May evening two years later, Knight died. The house sheltered its master and builder one last time as he lay in state in his home, as was the custom in that day. He joined the generations of the past.

Bettie, his wife, was left with a farm and five children. In order to support them, she petitioned the courts for permission to sell some of the land for money to raise her children, all under age 10. She also tried her best to carry out her deceased husband's wishes and plans.

Mrs. Knight was a woman of vision. She saw to it that the Raleigh and Pamlico Sound Railroad Co. received land on which to build its tracks. Additional land was provided for a depot, and provisions

were made for the beginning of a town.

This land was laid out in streets and then in individual parcels for homes. The present Oakwood, Maple, Pine and Main streets were among those laid out. The beginnings of the town were located southeast of the Knight house and east of Smithfield Road.

In 1911 the widow donated even more land to extend the town limit to Tarboro Road. The house saw the farmland around it change into a small village.

Railroad officials had laid their tract and built a depot, opening the door for even more rapid growth and change. The widow charged a minimal fee for much of the land so that her children would be provided for and at the same time her husband's wishes would be carried out. Land was provided for the Knight's Chapel Baptist Church, and today the Knightdale Baptist Church stands on that location. She also sold land to the Wake County Board of Education for a school in the early 1900s.

The new town grew slowly, and in 1927 it was incorporated. In 1930

the population was 243; in 1940 it was 352. As Knightdale grew slowly, a small business district evolved.

On one cold January day in 1940, the residents noticed flames and smoke rising from the town. A fire destroyed the business district. The many wooden buildings fed the flames, which turned the area into an inferno. In spite of its severity, the fire did not stop the small town's growth, and by 1980 the population reached 985.

Because of the railroad and its proximity to Raleigh, the state capital, Knightdale continued to grow, and present-day forecasts anticipate a growth rate far in excess of what its founder could have ever imagined.

The house remains in the family to this day. It stands as a silent witness to the many events that led to the formation of the town of Knightdale as we know it.

Bettie Knight remarried to the Rev. J.M. Hilliard, the Baptist minister, and they had a daughter named Ruth. Mrs. Hilliard decided to divide the land among her children. Her third daughter, Rachel, received the tract of land with the

home on it along with some other land.

Rachel Knight married Dav Loomis Horton, who lives in the house today. Mrs. Horton died in 1953. The couple had one daughter, Nancy. Today, Nancy and her husband, Norwood Hargrove, live next door to the Knight house in a brick ranch-style house. Their home just east of the house were Nancy's grandparents and parents live.

Houses can't talk, but events can. The many things that happened around the Knight house can tell about Henry Knight, the founder of Knightdale. He was a man with visions who was able to bring those visions to reality. He took gr

pains to build the small group of farmers into a community. He and his wife had the town in their mind long before it became a reality. He was a farmer, a businessman, then a Wake County official who had an idea of a well-balanced society. He valued education and helped create a school for all of the children in the area. He must have been a spiritually-oriented man who placed great value on the church and its role in society. He was a

who valued the family life and the home.

Bettie Knight must have been a woman of vision also, to have seen the same town that her husband did. The task of taking care of the children, not to mention managing a

farm at the same time, must have been a great responsibility.

The generations of men are as the leaves of the trees; they spring forth, stay for a season, and then pass from being forever. Henry Knight is gone now, but he left us

a town and the house that was so important to him and his family. It still serves his descendants to this day. When you pass by and see that house on U.S. 64 East, remember Henry Knight and his visions. What a story that big white house could tell!

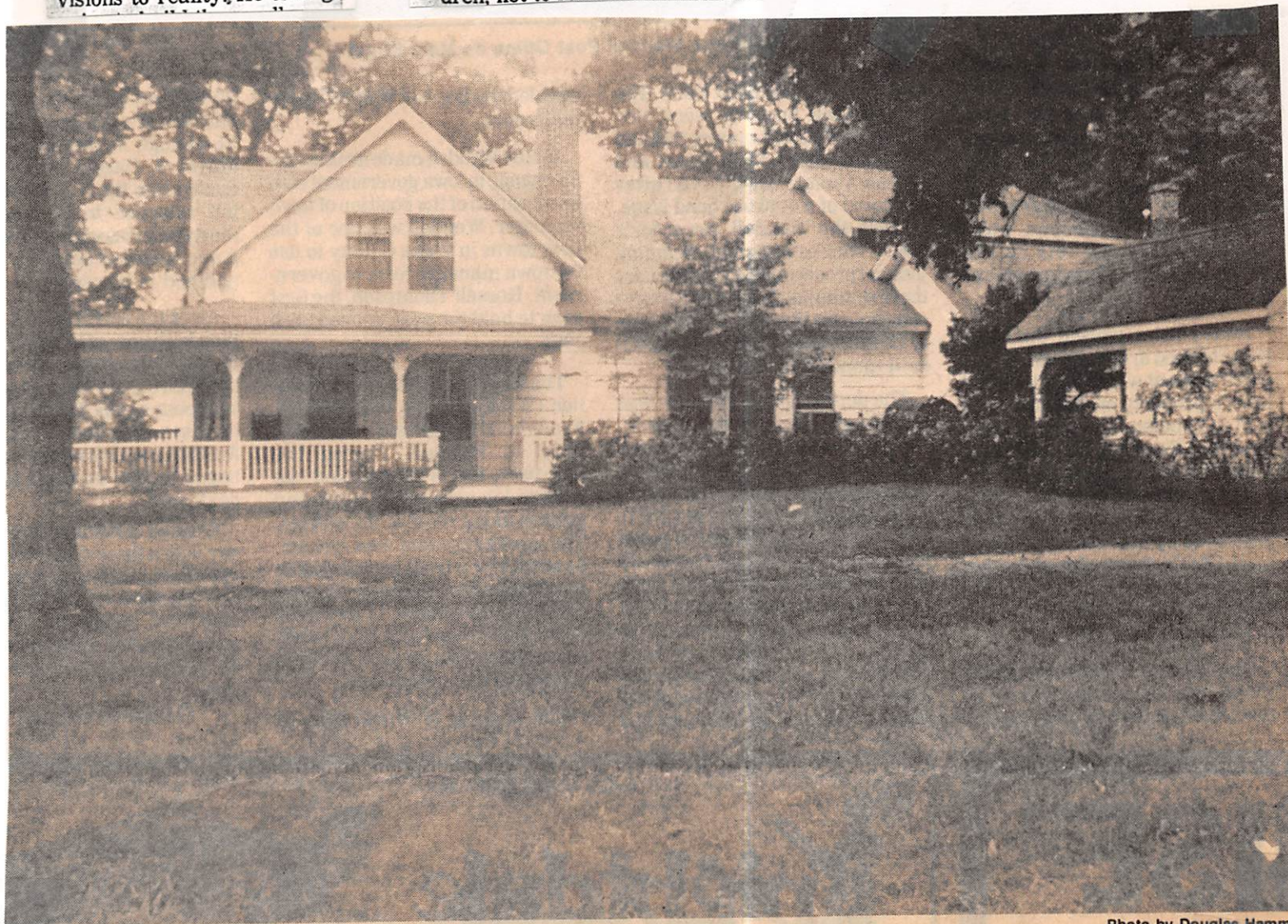
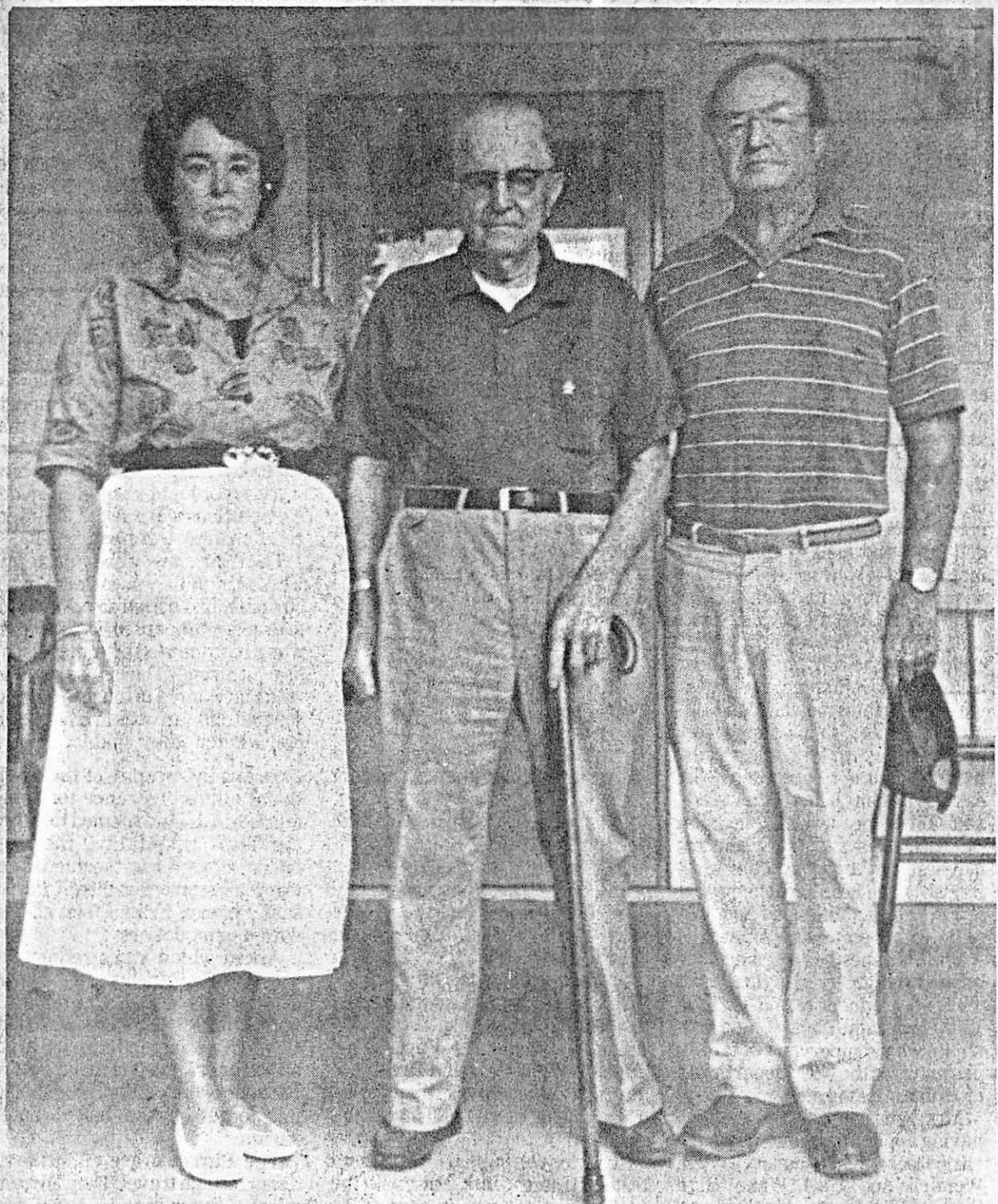

In the 1800-1900⁺ era prostitution was rampant on the American frontier and Texas was a prime example. Accounts in several Texas cities illustrate this but until this book appeared none had been written about flagrant prostitution in Waco in the so called "Reservation" area.

This book is important to UPCHURCH HISTORY because our relative Rev JAMES TONY UPCHURCH beginning in the 1890's became a peace fighter against prostitution in Waco. His work has been previously reported in the Upchurch Bulletin

In early 2011 author Sherri Knight contacted me and her Biofile reveals that I supplied her considerable information (but got no credit in the book). She was so impressed with Rev J.T.U. that she devoted an entire chapter to him in the book. This chapter has been copied for the Biofile of J.T.U. to 29 OCT 1870 s/o James Courtney U, Head of a line in the Moses U/Courtney U Subclass

This book accurately portrays what we know of J.T.U. and adds more detail.

It treats only lightly his work later in Dallas and Arlington, TX

Page 84 reports that E.P. UPCHURCH was a neighbor of a keeper of one of the "houses" and in 1911 defended the keeper in court. We know this person ENNIS PERRY U formerly of Gumer Co, TX. J.T.U. probably did not respect his distant cousin.

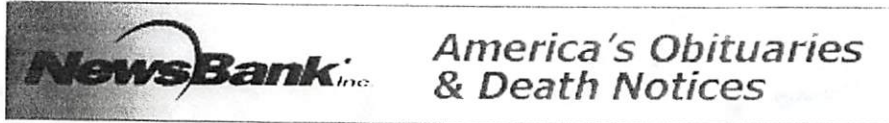
