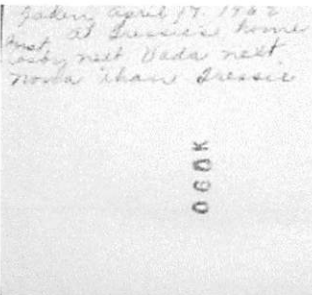

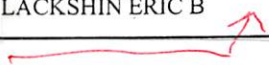

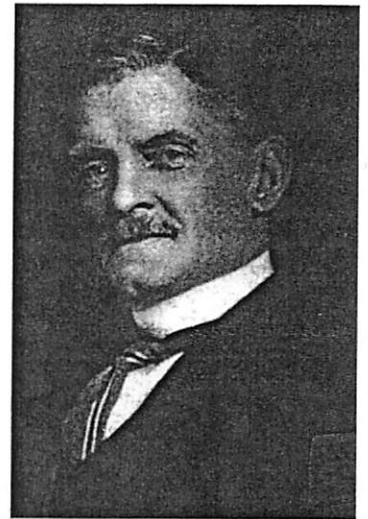

SAVINGS BANKS

△△△ The North Carolina General Assembly passed a law in 1887 to encourage the creation of savings banks, mainly for the thrifty factory worker who might make weekly deposits after paying living expenses. While not as profitable as national banks, they were allowed to open with much less capital stock. The same year the law was passed, Capt. J. J. Thomas, John T. Pullen, W. C. Stronach, J. Stanhope Wynne, and other Raleigh men chartered Raleigh Savings Bank, the state's first such institution. Pullen was made cashier from the bank's inception and later served as president for the rest of his life. A bachelor and devout Christian, he was known for keeping his pockets filled with candy and religious tracts which he distributed to anyone he met, both inside and outside the bank. He endeared himself to many of the city's poorest citizens by visiting them in their homes to offer counseling or give them money for basic necessities. "He never thought that his religion was helping the bank," Josephus Daniels later wrote, "but people had such confidence in him that widows and many others who had a few pennies they wished to save, would deposit their money in 'John Pullen's bank.'" Practically everyone in town owned small shares of stock at first, according to Daniels, but in the early 1900s a contest for controlling interest ensued between Pullen and cashier James O. Litchford. When Mrs. Daniels learned that

her two shares would give either of the men majority ownership, she declined to sell but gave Pullen her voting power. By the time of Pullen's death in 1913, Raleigh Savings and Citizens National had identical ownership and management personnel, although the two institutions did not officially merge until 1927.²⁷

Other savings banks included Mechanics Dime (started 1896, with "Dime" dropped from the name in 1907) and Wake County Savings Bank (1905). Wake County Savings, initially located in the former elevator shaft of the Commercial and Farmers Bank, achieved notoriety as the smallest bank in the United States, or maybe even in the world, as one source speculated.²⁸

Fannie Belle Pollard Bowers House, 92, of Bethel, died Monday, Nov. 6, at Pitt Memorial Hospital. Funeral was Thursday, Nov. 9, at Bethel Baptist Church. Burial was at Bethel Cemetery.

Mrs. House was a native of Penny Hill and lived most of her life in

Bethel. She was one of the first female tobacco farmers in Pitt County. She farmed for more than 20 years, retired, and began a second career with 20-plus years at the Bethel Pharmacy. She was a member of the Bethel Baptist Church and was chosen the Bethel "Citizen of the Week" in 1984.

Sarah Ladd battles leukemia in an effort for a normal life

Sarah Ladd runs through the house laughing and playing with her sister and a friend as any normal 3½-year-old would. But only six months ago she was in the hospital to start the beginning phases of chemotherapy to battle acute lymphocytic leukemia.

Acute lymphocytic leukemia is cancer of the bone marrow, explains Robert Ladd, her father.

In March, Sarah complained of knee pain that did not seem to go away and her lymph nodes were swollen, her

mother, Debbie Ladd, said. As the symptoms progressed during the week, Sarah was taken to see her pediatrician, who immediately sent the family to Duke Medical Center where she underwent a series of tests.

"They were 98 percent sure that (leukemia) was what she had," Debbie said.

The disease had progressed so far that Sarah was unable to walk for three weeks. The leukemia has multiplied so fast and pushed out the good white blood cells which placed pressure on the joints, she said.

The next two weeks Sarah stayed in the hospital to begin

her chemotherapy.

"That two weeks in the hospital was probably the most difficult time we ever had," Debbie said.

Even when Sarah could leave her hospital room, she had to wear a surgical mask because she was susceptible to germs.

She is currently in Phase II of her treatment, which involves a whole new regiment of drugs from the first phase and a spinal tap every six weeks. As part of her treatment, some of the spinal fluid is drawn out and replaced with the chemotherapy because leukemia is more apt to return in the spinal area if it is not treated, Robert said.

Sarah also receives the chemotherapy through shots in her leg every other week and intravenously the other weeks.

"She knows she's got leukemia, but she doesn't know what it is," he said. Doctors encouraged the Ladds to be up-front with Sarah from the very beginning.

If you ask Sarah why her hair has fallen out, she blames it on "that bad ol' leukemia."

"They told us almost to the day when it (her hair) would fall out," Robert added.

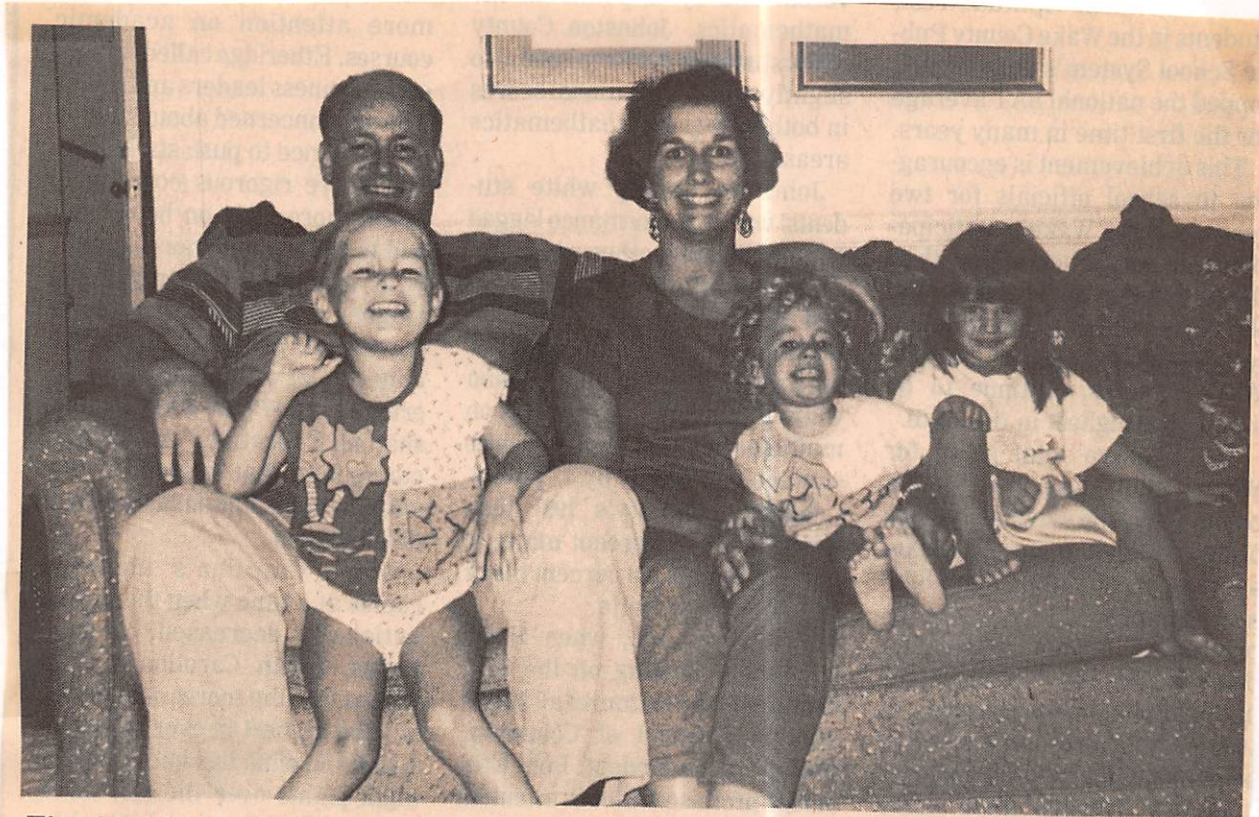
Sarah also adds that, "we have to spray that stuff on me and Daddy's hair so we don't get sunburned."

But, Sarah has accepted everything that has happened to her in stride.

"That's what they say about kids, after a point in time, they accept it," Robert said. "It's not something easy to detect unless symptoms start popping up."

She was in remission after 30 days of treatment, which can be done in about 98 percent of the children with leukemia, her father said.

Just about the only disease that could be detrimental to her health at this point is the regular childhood diseases because of her tolerance, and chemotherapy would have to be stopped, Robert said.

"If she gets a fever now over 101 degrees, she has to go straight to the hospital," he stated.

The Ladds have relied on a lot of support from family and friends. They thank the Zebulon Jaycees for starting the Sarah Ladd Leukemia Fund and for the many clubs and individuals who have made contributions.

The family received numerous calls from people telling them that they were in their prayers. Sarah received gifts continuously for a month to help her through this ordeal. The family even donated some of the gifts to Duke Medical Center in an effort to help other children like Sarah.

But, Sarah has not finished fighting her battle. In October, she will be re-evaluated to see if she has stayed in remission and to start the maintenance phase, or Phase III, of her treatment. She will take a pill a day, receive a shot every week and a spinal tap every 12 weeks.

"I don't know what she'll remember (about this)," Debbie said.

In the meantime, Sarah leads a normal life playing with her sister Rebecca, going to the Carolina Mudcats games and singing one of her favorite songs, "Take Me Out To The Ballgame."

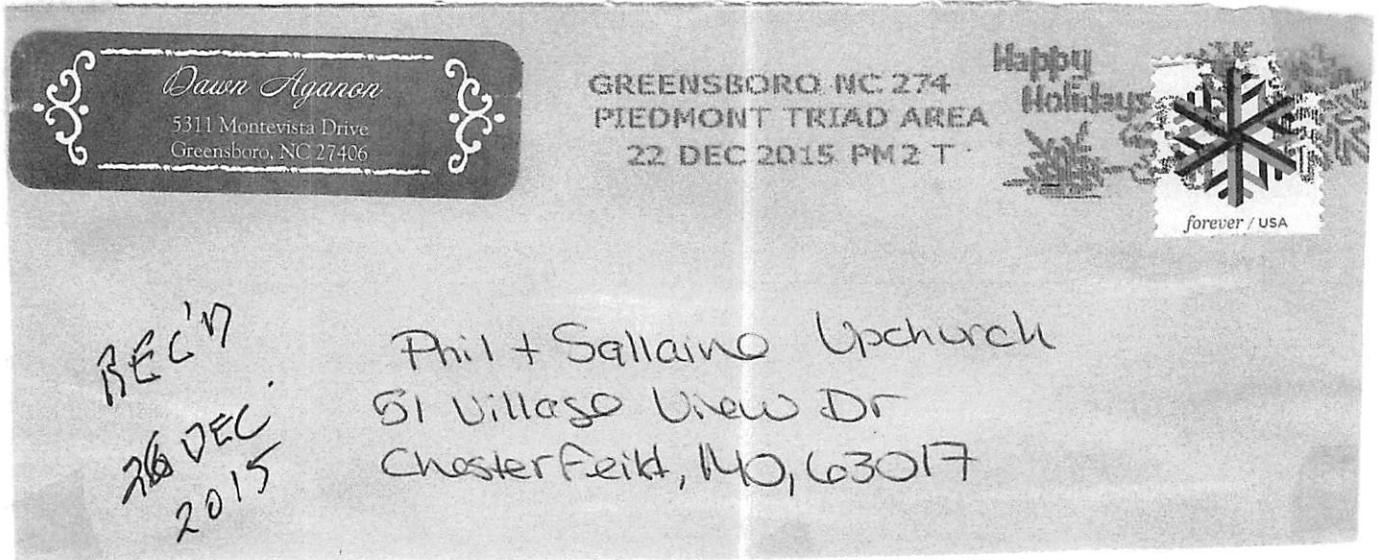
On October 22 I returned home after 16 great family history days in Raleigh. I met about 50 people and am now doing follow up.

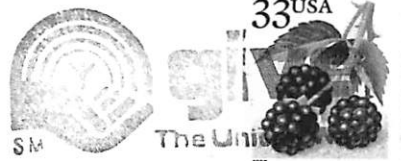

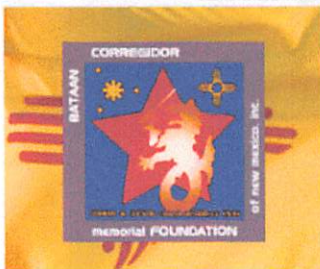

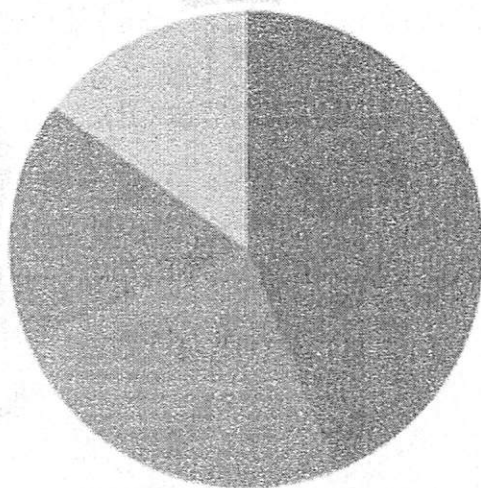
