



It's late afternoon on a Friday, the sun is out and it is early enough in the year that it hasn't become sticky with humidity.

A warm breeze is blowing - it is that breeze that is just enough to keep the farmer selling his produce streetside from breaking sweat.

That is good, because if there's one thing Joe Woodell does a lot of — it's sweat.

"I am a farmer," Joe says, with obvious pride.

Joe was born and reared on a tobacco farm just south of town. Though he left town for awhile like many youngsters are apt to do, Joe found his fortune in the very earth his grandfather had toiled over for years.

"There's nothing more satisfying than seeing a crop from seed to harvest and when you can eat what you produce," Joe says.

His main crop is tomatoes. Joe grows them in two greenhouses he built on the land belonging to his grandmother behind his home on Tingen Road.

He also has a greenhouse for cucumbers and grows corn, snap beans, squash, peas, okra, watermelons and other produce.

The tomatoes are a relatively new venture for Joe. This is his fifth crop since he first planted - and Joe says he's learned a lot since he began.

"I had a friend who grew up two blocks away who began his commercial greenhouse tomato operation in 1976, "Joe says. "I helped him build his first commercial greenhouse."

That friend was David Denson, who has been a mentor to Joe over the years.

Joe's greatest help has come in the form of his "partner in life," Marilyn Langdon.

"I couldn't do it without her," he says. "On days when I'm running behind and I'm totally confused, Marilyn is always there to smooth things out," he reflects.

Help also comes in the form of his nephew, Jason.

Though Jason works hard in the garden and doing other chores, he says he enjoys the work.

"It's fun," Jason says, "I like selling tomatoes at the market — I can sell tomatoes for a living."

"He is my best salesman," Joe admits, "He is very conscientious, very polite with all the customers and a quick learner — he's even taught me a few things about the art of selling produce."

Since he began growing tomatoes, Joe says "I have experienced bacterial problems and nematoad problems."

He describes nematoads as ground dwelling organisms that attack the roots of the tomato plants.

Instead of mounting a chemical search and destroy mission to rid himself of the nematoads, Joe found a natural way to rid himself of the pests.

Instead, he saturated the soil with crabmeal (crushed and dehydrated crab waste from crab meat processing plants). The chitins that exist naturally in the soil consume the crabmeat, causing their population to thrive. After a while, the nematoad young get eaten up by the massive amounts of chitins in the soil.

Joe attributes his use of nature as a combatant to his grandfather.

"Grandad was definitely a conservationist," he says. "He was very aware of how nature interacts both positively and negatively in regards to crop production."

"He was a good steward of his land in that he used the least amount of chemicals and fertilizers as possible long before it was a popular idea," Joe says.

The first crop Joe attempted was mostly a bust due to his building the greenhouses on top of a field suffering from Granville (bacterial) wilt — which had taken out his grandfather's tobacco long ago.

"It was a costly loss of memory," he says.

After superheating the soil through solarization, though, Joe replanted in the same spot.

Now, that same land is producing healthy fruit.

"I enjoy farming because you get to see the fruits of your labor, "Joe says, adding "And your vacation time and weekends are humped together in 2 1/2 months."

For Joe, tomato production season lasts from October until July—and during that time he works like a dog.

"I start work before the sun comes up and I quit work when it becomes too dark to see," he says.

"When you're a farmer you make every use of the sunlight and you always wish you had more," he says.

During tomato season, Joe doesn't take any days off and rarely takes a break — even for interviews.

Though Joe doesn't sell his crops from his farm, Joe does take the time to set up shop on Salem Street, and at the Fuquay-Varina and Cary farmer's markets though.

"To sell my first year's product I had to find a location with ample foot traffic and I chose the Cary area because of the size of the parking lot of Ashworth Village," he says.

So he drummed up support from the town and area producers and got a farmer's market going.

Joe is also the current market manager in Fuquay-Varina and the president of the North Carolina Growers Association.

He doesn't participate in the Apex farmer's market because of the time conflict with Cary, where he has a strong customer base.

He does sell tomatoes on Fridays at a stand in front of the Medical Center Pharmacy from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. at Salem and East Moore.

The pharmacy is a special place for Joe, because his mother, Judy, has worked there for 28 years.

Joe remembers visiting his

mother and owner Lelon Dollar in his youth.

school every day when they had the soda fountain in the back and keep the candy counter straight," Joe says.

"He helps our business," says Lelon Dollar.

"They see all the cars stopping and they see our drugstore," he adds, "It's really good advertising for us."

Judy Woodell says that all her children are industrious from the work they did on the farm.

"[The farm life] provided a good foundation, honesty, integrity and hard work." she says.

"I learned that there's nothing wrong with hard work," Joe says, "It keeps you healthy both in mind and body and helps you appreciate a lot of what others take for granted."

"If I have my way I'll be able to maintain my grandfather's land as a farm for as long as I live if the family wishes to do so," Joe says between picking tomatoes off the plants in the greenhouse.

"The family consensus is we have no desire to sell the farm," he says, knowing full well the value of the land with its proximity to Research Triangle Park.

"The heritage that goes along with [the farm] is more valuable than any amount of money a developer could offer," he adds.

"I hate seeing Apex become another suburb of the capital and Research Triangle and I hope everyone soon realizes there is a finite amount of space on this earth and that open space and greenway is essential to human health."

"Many people forget that in past years everyone farmed to some extent for survival," he says. "I'd personally rather depend on myself for life's nourishment."

"I'm sure that any of my beliefs stem from the lessons I learned working on the farm from the summers of my youth," Joe says. "I'd fike to think I'm a good steward of the land myself."




