Delighted to have your message about the house and over time hope we can explore a range of possible interests. On a 1977 visit to Western Wake my Guide pointed out to me the house where Eva lived. Later in 1988 I learned that She was living with her son Dewey in the same Community. For Pascal I have settled on the spelling Paschal. The name was used often among the descendants of Moses U[brother of my GGGGF Nathan] both of whom moved their young families from Franklin Co, N. C. to the Wake/Chatham border about 1802. Moses had a GS Paschal B. U 1830-1863 who died in the Civil War. Respect for his service probably accounts for the frequent use of his name. In 1977 our small group had our picture taken in front of what I recall as the Paschal B. U home. I hope we can exchange much more. Can you indicate on a map the exact location of your house, provide a picture, tell me a little about the Builder, etc.

Eva was the dau of Isham Paschal U and the GD of Isham Sims U who had a brother the aforementioned P. B. U. Do you have ancestors who lived in Central N. C. ?

Durham, Jan. 3. - On the border line of Wake, Durham and Chatham counties the family of Mr. I.S. Upchurch lives and it has a remarkable record. the last birthday of the year is Mr. Upchurch's birthday. It is always celebrated by a family reunion, and the encroachment of years seldom finds one missing. Mr. Upchurch married Miss Dillie Beavers December 23d, 1851. To them were born thirteen children, and eleven survive. Ten of the eleven were present at the recent reunion and forty- nine grandchildren attended. Fourteen of the twenty-one great grandchildren came, and with the ten children, their wives and husbands: the forty grandchildren, their wives and husbands, and the great grandchildren, there were 106 relatives, 84 of who were present.

ALREADY ON HAND

The spread dinner was a feature of the old gentleman's natal day. It was made up of a basket from every family. The table which carried it was sawed fifty years ago and is made of planks seventeen inches wide. They are in a perfect state of preservation.

Mr. Upchurch lived forty-three years with his first wife, who died fifteen years ago. In 1902 he married Mrs. Watson and they enjoyed almost perfect health. In the fifty-seven years of married life, there have been but seven deaths in all of the families, a remarkable record.

Isham Sims Upchurch was born 31 Dec 1824 and died 3 April 1916.

Re the 1977 photo of the house I can tell you about how that will unfold. We are just beginning a project to digitize all of my photos. The one you desire will be in one of the early batches to be processed and I will keep in mind that you want a copy which I will be happy to provide in due course. I have hired an Archivist to advise on procedures and the photo project is one of her first duties. I do not know of any other photos of your house but I'll bet there are some somewhere,

Re Kent Paschal U I have just reviewed my Biofile on him. When I was in touch with him he was only 4-5 years away from death and it was his wife who took the lead in interacting about family, probably to give him an added outlet and to some extent it worked. But I never got to delve into past family history with them. It became clear in our exchanges that his father and mother had divorced and that his mother turned Kent against his father and no doubt other Upchurches. I got no sense that Kent ever had any awareness of your house but then our exchanges were cut short by his untimely death in 1997. At this remove it would take a special project to locate members of the family in order to learn if they ever had any awareness of your house. I always live in hopes that something will fall in our laps to ignite such a project.

We are making huge strides in upgrading my website <www.upchurchstory.com> so you might want to have a look. 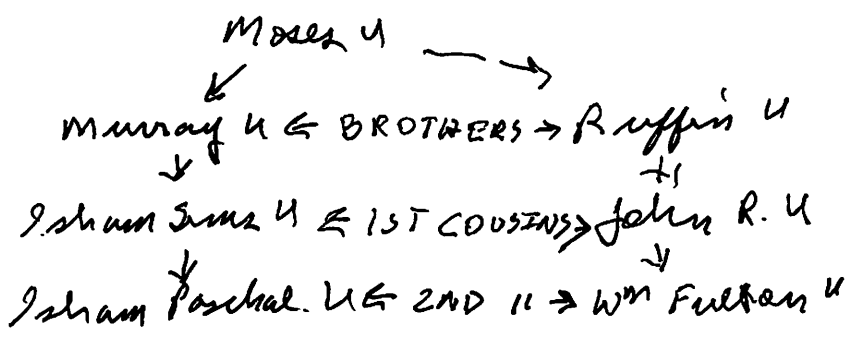

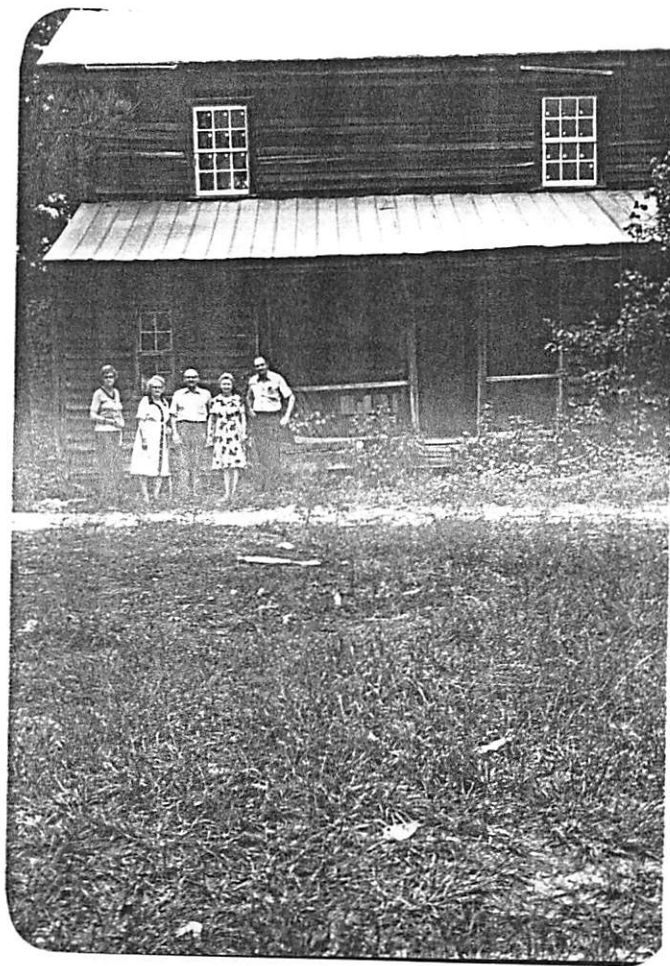
