One wedding seems to have been recorded twice with name of bride spelled differently.

Grunetta Upchurch married J B Lasater 12 Jan 1852

Quinetta Upchurch married J B Lasater 12 Jan 1852

Quinetta Upchurch, daughter of Sims Upchurch of Moses/Sims Upchurch Clan, had a negro baby. She married Joseph Lasater.

(3) Joseph Lasater and Queenetta Upchurch had a son John Sims Lasater born 17 Mar 1856 died 7 Aug 1918 who married Theodocia Council born 11 Oct 1858 died 7 Nov 1905. Queenetta Upchurch was daughter of Sims Upchurch of the Moses Upchurch/Sims Upchurch Sub-clan (35, Page 24)

Joseph Bell Lasater born 1830 died 30 Aug 1861 married 12 Jan 1852 (Chatham Co, NC). He died of fever at Camp Jones, VA. He enlisted in Wake Co, NC 28 May 1861.

He married Quinetta Upchurch according to the Book of Marriages, Register of Deeds Office – Chatham Co, NC Pittsboro, NC

“J B Lasater married 12 Jan 1852 Quinetta Upchurch by PW Dowd – (witness W P Taylor)

(no number) Civil War 1861 – 1865 – Company I, 6th Regiment – NC State Troops
