 12 MAR 1866. The PO of the two witnesses
 was New Hill, NC (in Wake Co) and one
 witness (presumably Margaret Goodwin) lived
 in Chatham Co, NC & one lived in Wake Co, NC
 (presumably M. Laurence).

COMPANY B - organized JUL & AUG 1863 for local defense and special service. Composed of noncommissioned and men unfit for field duty. The Battalion was composed of workers of the Fayetteville Arsenal and Army - F members had a Chatham Co, NC reference as follows:

△ HATCH, ORREN, Private
 Born in Chatham County and was by occupation a farmer prior to enlisting in Cumberland County at age 17, June 23, 1863, for the war. Present or accounted for through December, 1864, when he was reported as "absent sick in Smithville hospital."

△ HILLIARD, DANIEL C., Private
 Born in Chatham County and was by occupation a farmer prior to enlisting in Cumberland County at age 17, June 23, 1863, for the war. Present or accounted for through December, 1864.

△ LAURENCE, SION H., Private
 Born in Chatham County and was by occupation a farmer prior to enlisting in Cumberland County at age 17, August 5, 1863, for the war. Present or accounted for until transferred to Company F of this battalion on January 1, 1864.

△ MORLY, CHARLES M., Private
 Born in Chatham County and was by occupation a farmer prior to enlisting in Cumberland County at age 17, June 26, 1863, for the war. Present or accounted for through December, 1864.
