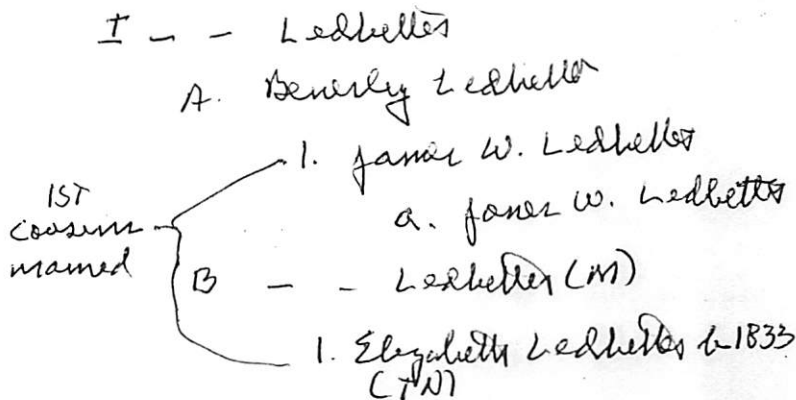

3 From wills and deeds, I know that Michael Upchurch lived on the south side of Eaton's Road in 1784, near Middle Run. His neighbors were Valentine White, Thomas Parham, Lewis Dupree, Thomas, Isaac, and Benjamin Mosely. MICHAEL U, III XID-159 HIS LOCATION & NEIGHBORS 1784

6 By 1777, Michael/Myal Upchurch's neighbors were BARTHOLOMEW UPCHURCH, Matthew Rainey, Thomas Bracy, and Allen Love. This deed is from "Daniel Burnet and his wife Elizabeth of CHATHAM Co. NORTH CAROLINA to Thomas Smith of Chatham County, N.C.," and it was land already lived on by Joyce Burnet, at the head of Poplar Creek. MICHAEL U, III XID-159 BARTHOLOMEW U IS NEW !! NEED DEED TO VERIFY THIS NEW UPCHURCH FAMILY MEMBER - LOCATION 1777

7 Another 1777 deed of gift from William Brewer and his wife Mary to John Brewer is for "518 acres which was William Brewer's dec'd plantation, on the south side of Rattle Snake Creek joining William Jones, Henry Ledbetter, UPCHURCH'S BRANCH, and James UPCHURCH. JAMES U IS PROBABLY JAMES U, III AS HIS BIRTH HAS OTHER REFERENCES TO RATTLE SNAKE CREEK & RATTLE SNAKE CHURCH; HOWEVER CANNOT YET RULE OUT HIS 1ST COUSIN JAMES U, II WHO LIVED IN THE SAME ERA & AREA

9 There was also a THOMAS UPCHURCH in Brunswick in 1776, as he is a witness to the will of Thomas Lambert. THIS THOMAS U IS NEW COPY OF WILL TO VERIFY DETAILS. TO RPU RECORDS, NEED WITNESS A WILL IN 1776 HE COULD HAVE BEEN THE FATHER OF JOSEPH U b 1775 !! THOMAS PROBABLY AT LEAST 21 IN 1776 HENCE BORN 1754 OR BEFORE

10 Everybody over 16 had to do road work in the 1700s in VA, or have a slave do it. Some of these records have survived, and on September 7, 1738, JAMES UPCHURCH and WILLIAM UPCHURCH were removed from Francis Wray's road crew and placed on William Mosely's road crew. So, WOW, these Upchurches were there early enough to be Joseph's father, that is for sure! In Brunswick County Court records, William was added to a list of tithables in 1736, SO THIS IS WHEN HE BECAME 21. THIS INFO IS NEW TO RPU, BASED ON AGES THIS JAMES U IS ALMOST CERTAINLY JAMES U, I XID-151

ALTHOUGH THERE IS SOME CHANCE IT COULD BE HIS SON JAMES U, II XID-154. THIS WILLIAM U IS A GOOD FIT TO BE WILLIAM U, I XID-3343, A BROTHER OF JAMES U, I - XID-151

12 In a November pre-election (of burgesses) in Brunswick, the only Upchurches on the list were JAMES UPCHURCH Sr. and MICHAEL UPCHURCH. THIS REFERENCE IS NOT DATED BUT ANOTHER CITATION IN RPU SHOWS JAMES U REGISTERED TO VOTE FOR BURGESSES IN 1748 - PROBABLY ALL THE SAME HENCE JAMES U, SR = JAMES U, I (SR) XID-151 & MICHAEL U = MICHAEL U, III XID-159

NOTE: NANCY WRITES IT WOULD BE HELPFUL TO FIND JOSEPH U b 1775 LISTED IN SOME OF THESE VA RECORDS - THIS IS POSSIBLE BUT NOT LIKELY AS HE LEFT VA AS A TEENAGER OR YOUNG MAN - RPU

- △ "Francis Johnson is Appointed Overseer of the Road from a Certain White Oak to the County Line in the room of Julius Alford"²⁰.

- △ "Ordered that **John Rose** be Overseer of the road from Davis's Meadow to a Certain white oak Perrys bounds and that the hands of **Francis Johnson**, Richard Smith, Richard Upchurch, Samuel Wright & Floyd Williams assist him in Clearing the same in repair"²¹.
- △ Note: In Julius Alford's Will, he left "the plantation John Rose lives on" to Goodrich Alford his son. The Will was written 13 July 1768 and probated in November 1771²².

1771 in Bute County Court

"Ordered that William Tanf be Overseer of the road in the room of **Francis Johnson** & Ordered that he keep the same in repair with the Taxables usually working thereon"²³.

- △ □ "Ordered that **Jacob Hartsfield** be Overseer of the road in the Room of **Francis Johnson** & it is further ordered that he keep the Same in repair with the hands usually working thereon"²⁴.

Notes: Jacob Hartfield along with Julius Alford had crooked Creek grants. (See attached map.)

"Francis Johnston" is listed in the Bute County 1771 Tax List²⁵

1771 WAKE COUNTY was created in part from the Northwestern part of Johnston County SEPTEMBER 1772, Wake County

- △ **Julius Johnston's** name appears on a "Jurors Road List" to lay off a new road from the Bute County line, crossing Moccasin Creek and continuing on and intersecting a new road at Mark's Creek. Some (but not in any order) on the list are William Pace (2), Benjamin, Moses, Richard and Charles Upchurch, Edward Hocutt, Pettypool Massey, Edward Earp²⁶.

1777 Nash County created from lands in western Edgecombe County

1778 Wake County Land Warrant 640 20 Oct 1778

- △ **John Ledbetter** enters 600 acres of land in Wake Co. lying on the north side of Neuse river, and on both sides of Rocky Branch joining the lines of Julius Johnston, Lodwick Alford, and Isreal Privitt, including said **Ledbetter** improvements. 600:50/15³⁰

- 1779 Wake County "Jany. 1st, 1779 Charles Upchurch enters three hundred acres of land in Wake County on the south side of Mokason Creek, joining the lines of Pettypool Massey, & Julius Johnstone. Including an improvement made by said Johnstone³⁴.

"Caveat Entered by Julius Johnston. Land given up by Upchurch to Johnston and the money returned"³⁵.

"Febry 1, 1779. Julius Johnstone Enters 640 acres of land in Wake County, Beginning at

- △ □ □ Elisha Strickland's line at Pettypool Massey's corner, running south to Joel Bolton's corner, thence west, including said Johnstone's improvements.³⁶

March Court 1782, Wake County

"A Deed from Richard Upchurch to Julius Johnston was in open court and duly acknowledged & ordered to be registered"³⁸.

1782. Wake County, North Carolina, Court Records Book B1, p. 238, 20.

December 1782 Richard Upchurch conveyed deed to Julius Johnson³⁹.

In 1782 or 1783, Julius Johnston is listed in Captain William Earps District in Wake County⁴⁰. He is the only Johns(t)on in the district. He owned 740 acres of land, 2 horses, 9 head of cattle and no Blacks. It appears that his neighbors were some from the earlier days on Crooked Creek but are probably a later generation.

The list contains Lodwick Alford. Charles Upchurch and Julius Johnston next to one another.

Two names away is Richard Upchurch Jr. and he is on the page with Benjamin Upchurch,

Nash County, 1786 JULIOUS JOHNSTON of Nash Co, NC, planter to NATHAN UPCHURCH, planter, Aug 21, 1786, for 40 pds specie a tract of 250 acres on the waters of Mocoson Creek

- △ △ and on Julious's Branch adjoining JAMES BOLTON, it being part of a survey taken up by said JULIOUS JOHNSTON. Wit: RICHARD UPCHURCH, BENJAMIN

Note: A search of the Nash County Court Minutes, Deeds and Land Entries reveals no Julius Johnston records in Nash County. However, this deed shows that he was in Nash County at the time. One must remember that the "corners" area of Johnston / Wake, Edgecombe / Nash and Granville / Bute / Franklin was not a large area.

Wake County, 1787 "A deed from Julius Johnston to Nathan Upchurch was in open court duly proved by the oath of Richard Upchurch a Witness thereto and ordered to be registered"⁴³.

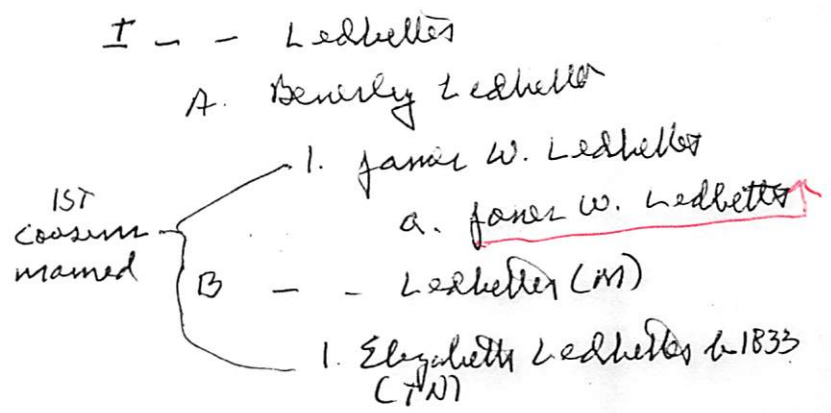

Apex man charged with rape, kidnapping

An Apex man was arrested and charged with rape and kidnapping early Sunday morning, according to Captain S.M. Pickett of the Wake County Sheriff's department.

Leander Ledbetter, 35, of Route 2, Apex, was charged with first-degree kidnapping and first-degree rape. He was charged with raping a 22-year-old woman at knifepoint in a car after she left with him from a bar, according to Apex Police Chief Ronnie Hearn. The incident took place on Perry Rd., a dirt road off of

Hughes St. in Apex at about 5 a.m. Sunday.

The victim who suffered from head lacerations, a cut on her shoulder and bruises reported the crime. She was attended to by the Apex Rescue Squad. Apex police sergeant Bill Stevenson, the first to respond to the call, turned the case over to the Wake County Sheriff's Department who arrested Ledbetter at 6:10 a.m. Sunday.

Bond was set at \$100,000, and Ledbetter remained in the Wake County Jail Sunday night.

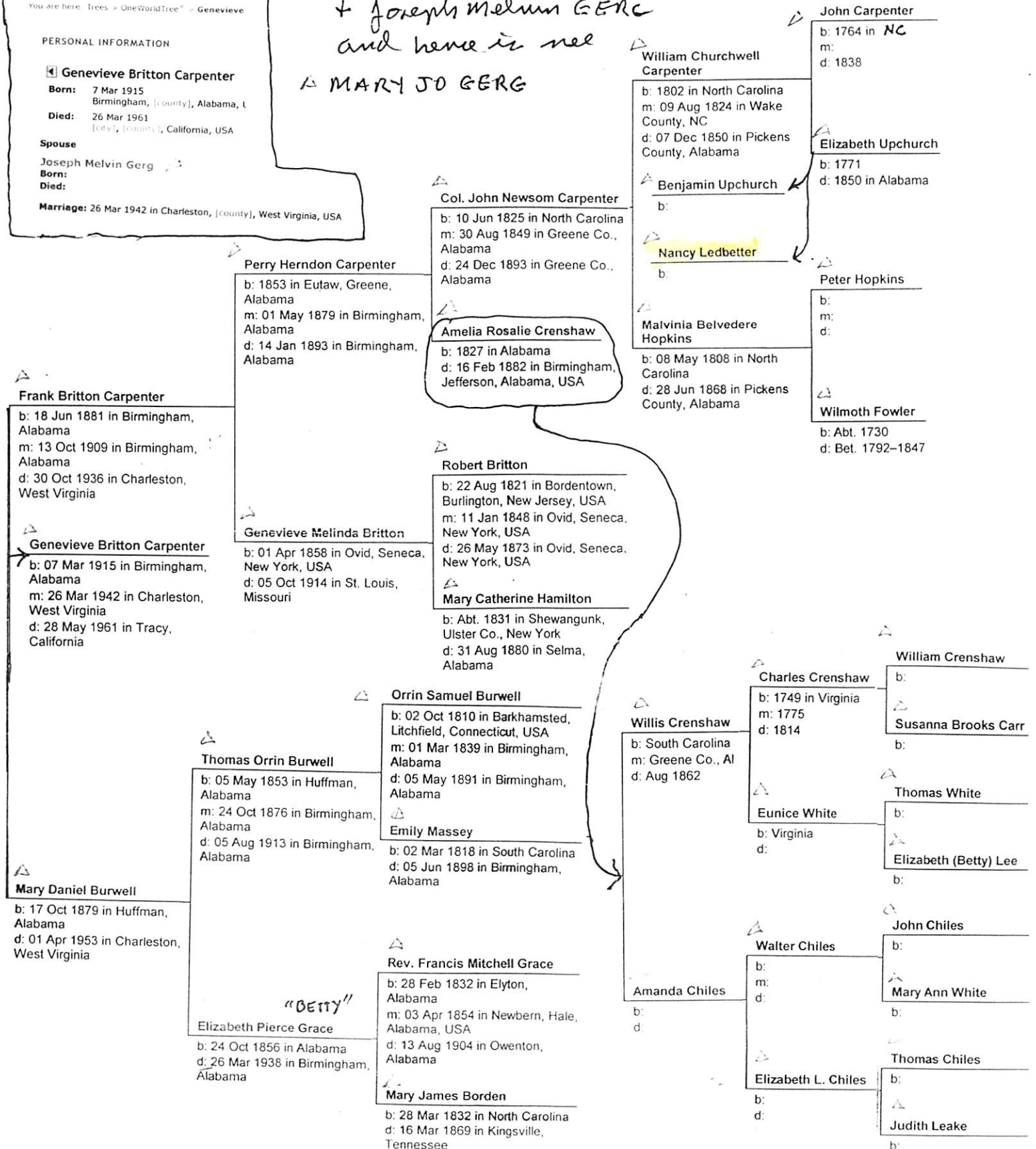

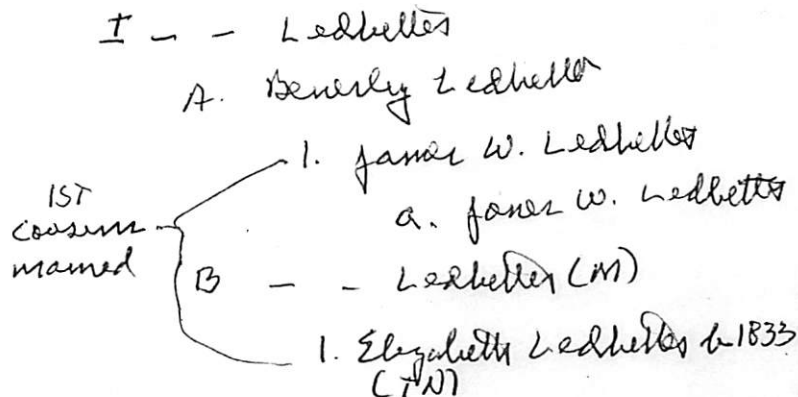

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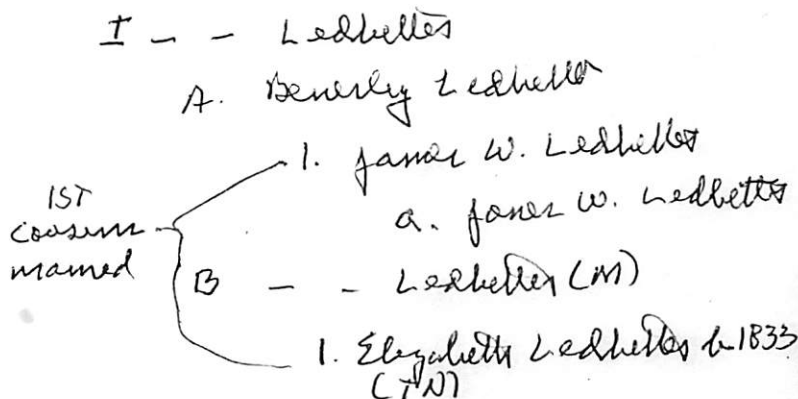
