Dear Cousin Linda,

Many thanks for your letter of 3 MAR 2002 and for the details provided. I have read over it a couple of times and have now started the serious part of cross-checking and making filing profile sheets on the individuals named in your letter. Since you mention some wide ranging subjects, I will comment on segments of your letter as they are processed less I forget what I had in mind at a certain point in time.

Enclosed sheet "A" is an excerpt re the will of Amy Diner - 1864. I can make sense out of the Henderson U part. He was the son of Eaton U and the GS of Charles U - Head of clan and Henderson U was in Henry CO, GA (on the 1860 census). I could not make any connections for the others named. However the Upchurch, Diner & Lindsey families were closely associated in Franklin CO, NC

as of the 1800 era. Eaton U & Keaton U, both sons of Charles U - Head of Clan, were in GA in the early 1800's having come from Franklin Co, NC. From the census records we know both had sons & daughters born in the early 1800's but we do not know the names of all of those children. Assuming that the Susan U who wd James Henry Butts was the dau of Charles U, HOC, it makes sense that Susan could somehow been involved with her siblings Eaton & Keaton & their families. However, I do not sense you propose that the 1864 will of Amy had any special connection to Susan. Still, it is good to get those papers sorted out.

I checked all the material you presented from the book "Henry County, Tenn - Old Time Stuff" by Ed Whitley. It is all confirmed by records in my files for the William U, IV / John U, V Subdau of Henry Co, TN.

Re Upchurch/Butts connections in NC - I have checked my sources and cannot find any. The BUTTS profiles I have are all for 1900 & beyond.

I have will Abstracts for Franklin Co, NC (By Stephen Bradley) for 1785-1834 and find no Butts entries in the indexes. I have for Franklin Co, NC court minutes, deeds, Tax lists.

I have Heritage books for Johnston Co, NC (O BUTTS),  
 Wake Co, NC (1 Butts <sup>Family</sup> entry - copy enclosed), Harnett  
 Co, NC - 9 Butts families in Index - I checked  
 all & find them to be present only since  
 about 1900. I don't know where these  
 BUTTS ancestors came from. There do not  
 appear to be BUTTS entries in my search  
 for the 1750-1850 era - but maybe we  
 missed some.

The story with the Alford's is different. There  
 were many Alford-Uplunch interactions starting  
 in 1755 in Franklin Co, NC when our  
 ancestor Richard U, II arrived there. There have  
 been many intermarriages & the two families  
 continued to interact in central NC in recent/  
 present days. I have large files. However, I  
 do not know of interactions in the GA  
 area or both families had descendants to  
 move there. Yet such interactions would  
 not surprise me. I would be happy  
 to have input or questions on the  
 Uplunch/Alford interactions

Enclosed is a copy of my extract sheet ["B"] made on a portion of your letter. - All extracted and posted in the profiles of all concerned.

Your 1800 & 1810 Census Records for Franklin Co, NC for the Charles W Household and for the 1810 Census for the Jubal W Household agree with mine.

Enclosed is sheet "C" where I have tried to show what the Charles W Family might have looked like. The XXX's would represent miscarriages or deaths in childhood - not uncommon for that era. Thus we identify 5 possible children by name (assuming we continue with Susan) and unnamed daughters born about 1786 & 1803. Their names may yet be learned - or perhaps they, too, died in childhood. Comments on "C" ??

As a next step I created a master outline for the Charles W / Susan W Subclass which is enclosed. This is the format I use for all Upchurch Subclasses. The first 11 pages of this master outline covers Susan W, her children, grandchildren and GG children. The descendants (if any / if known) of the GG children are covered in continuation sections as indicated by numbers on the

left hand side of the paper. Two of these exist and are included (after the pink sheet). I was surprised how much information I had from you and others to get this master outline started. I would appreciate it if you would look this over and let me have any corrections or additions you have.

Indeed, I am really excited about how much progress we have made on this matter which is of mutual interest. There are many ways we could proceed. Please let me have your ideas on what we should do next.

It is fascinating to me that the paths of these families were from time-to-time together - then apart - then together again. We have much more to learn about the several families and the locations (states) in which they lived.

Did I miss something?

[NOTE: The above Henderson U is no doubt Henderson U s/o Eaton U & Gs/o Charles U - Head of clan. However, in my Profile system I find no DRIVER/UPCHURCH connections in GA. Profile sheets have been made/ filed for each of the names listed above even though some of the females may be listed by their married names

completely documented. Charles was sold in NC<sup>2</sup> as of 1810 but he was in Putnam Co, GA as of 1820 & 1821. He was in Green Co, GA in 1823 and then in 1830 in Henry Co, GA

The 1790 & 1800 census records show Charles had two daughters born in the 1780-1790 period, either one would have been of the approximate correct age to have been the Susan U who md farmer Henry Butts in Putnam Co, GA. Up to now we did not have a clue as to the names of these two daughters. We have no hard evidence that either of these two daughters survived and moved with their father & their brothers to GA - but all the known facts fit and there is no other known branch of the Upchurch family that would likely have had a daughter Susan U b 1782 who would have been expected to have been in Putnam Co, GA in the 1810 era. I am anxious to know your opinion of this proposal and however possible to collect more data - which, hopefully, will be confirming in nature - but not necessarily.

If my proposal on Susan U is correct there (3) then followed another unusual coincidence. When Susan & James Henry moved to Henry Co, TN they encountered there the well established family of John U, II. One could imagine that the Hankins - Butts - Upchurch - etc families knew each other all along back before 1800 and that they sort of kept up with the wanderings of the various families and somehow decided in the early 1800's to be together in Henry Co, TN. This could be true as families did sort of plow together across the country - to GA, TN, MO, TX or wherever. However in this case I am guessing that they got to Henry Co, TN because of the availability of land or because it was a natural pathway west.

In any case we now see that Susan U in the 1830 era was living in the same community as her 2nd cousin John U, II.

Surely they talked about their Upchurch heritage but it is easily possible they could not



figure out how they were related. I did  
 evaluate that Susan & James Henry had  
 a ~~son~~ Delaney Butts who married Jesse  
 U, a son of John U, IV. Thus the children  
 of Jesse & Delaney were Upchurch related  
 through their GF John U, IV and through  
 their GM Susan (Upchurch) Butts. ④

We can fine tune our dates as we go  
 along. As an example the first child of  
 Jesse & Delaney was Alexander U b abt 1828.  
 If this ~~date~~ can be confirmed it would likely  
 seem that the Butts family got to Henry  
 Co, TN somewhat before 1828 to allow time  
 for Jesse to court & marry Delaney & to have  
 a child. There can be some "slippage" in  
 such calculations so the more we can fix  
 the dates with certainty, the better.

Incidentally, I am reasonably sure that  
 Jesse & Delaney did not move to TX. - Rather  
 their son Alexander U moved to TX.

Linda, I am hopeful that when you  
 get and study this package you will

have some reactions and possibly some more names to put into the picture. (5)

I am anxious to create in my records a master outline for the Charles W/Susan W subclan. This would include all the descendants of Susan and James Henry Butts. As a start can you tell me how you trace back to this couple. Perhaps you have an overall family tree of sorts you could send me.

On my side I think there are more elements in my system that could be of interest to you. It all depends on the kinds of things that interest you and how you want to proceed.

I'll look forward to hearing from you - and many thanks for heating up the trail for Susan W.

July 11, 2001

So glad to hear your troubles are behind you. It must have seemed like a nightmare. You were certainly wise to have good insurance!

Thank you for sending me the information on your many Publications. I am impressed!

Now, the information I have for Susan Upchurch is very sketchy. I received her and her husbands name from the Texas branch of the Butts family and have no document of my own for this. I have done some Census checking and found a Henry Butts residing in Putnam Co., Ga. In 1820. I have corresponded with other Butts researchers who have found a Henry and Susanna Living in Ga. No details yet though.

Here are some details about them and their family which are well founded.

- △ The Texas branch said that Henry was also known as James Henry.
  - △+△ Henry and Susan raised their family in Ga., from about 1800 to 1830.
  - △ Their oldest son Salathiel moved to Henry Co., Tenn. About 1827. It is thought that he married there before moving to Missouri where he was in 1830.
  - △ When Salathiel moved to Jackson County Missouri, many family members came. Also those connected by marriage such as Hawkins and Stayton.
  - △+△ It is not known for sure if Henry and Susan went to Tenn. Or Mo. As yet, I Have not been able to find anything to indicate their whereabouts except a Reference about them in old letters written by their children.
- We know that in their families, they often married cousins.

I will give the family group as it is known now. The order of all the children is not totally accurate.

- △ Father: James Henry Butts B. about 1780
- △ Mother: Susan Upchurch B. about 1782

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Their children: It is assumed they were all born in Georgia.

- △ + △ Rebecca Married a Hawkins - sold property in Tenn. to John Upchurch
- △ + △ Delaney Married an Upchurch - Jesse? - had 14 children
- △ + △ Salathiel B. 1810 Md. Stayton
- △ + △ Henry B. 1811 Md. Drummond
- △ + △ Andrew B. 1812 Md. Lovelady
- △ + △ Nancy Md. Drummond
- △ + △ Eleanor Md. Baker
- △ Levi Md. Not known

O f these children, four moved to Texas after marrying. Those were

△ + △ + △ + △ Delaney, Andrew, Nancy and Levi.

A frustrating part of this research is not being able to locate death or
