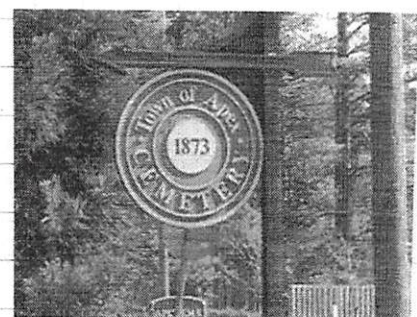

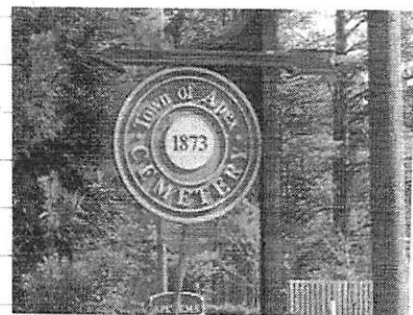

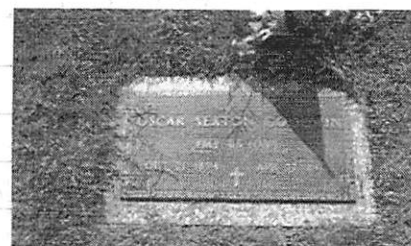

Shortly after arrival in Grimes Co, TX Virgil A. Loftin
& his son died. Clementine remarried & moved
to another part of the state taking Carrie Loftin
& Hattie Loftin with her. Clementine died shortly
thereafter. The dau's probably went to stay with
their Aunt Annie Smiley who was also one
of the 19 on the GA-TX trip.
