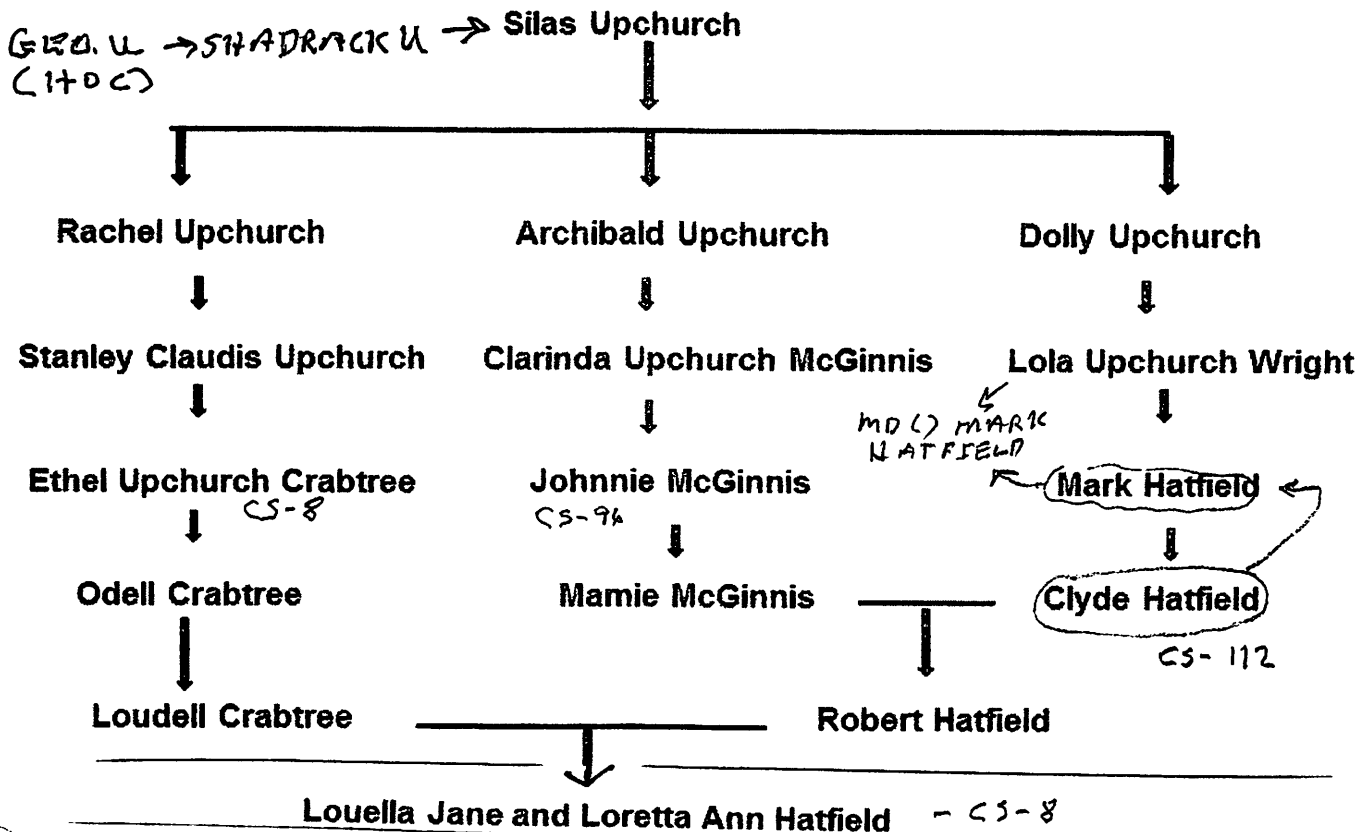

You go from Dolly to Lola to Mark to Clyde who married Mamie McGinnis.

My checking shows Dolly had Lola who married Mark Hatfield who had Clyde who married Mamie. So Clyde would have been a 2nd cousin of Mamie's father Johnnie McGinnis and thus a 2nd cousin once removed of Mamie whom he married.

If you can confirm this or otherwise get me on the right path I will continue with my work on the records that are of mutual interests to us.

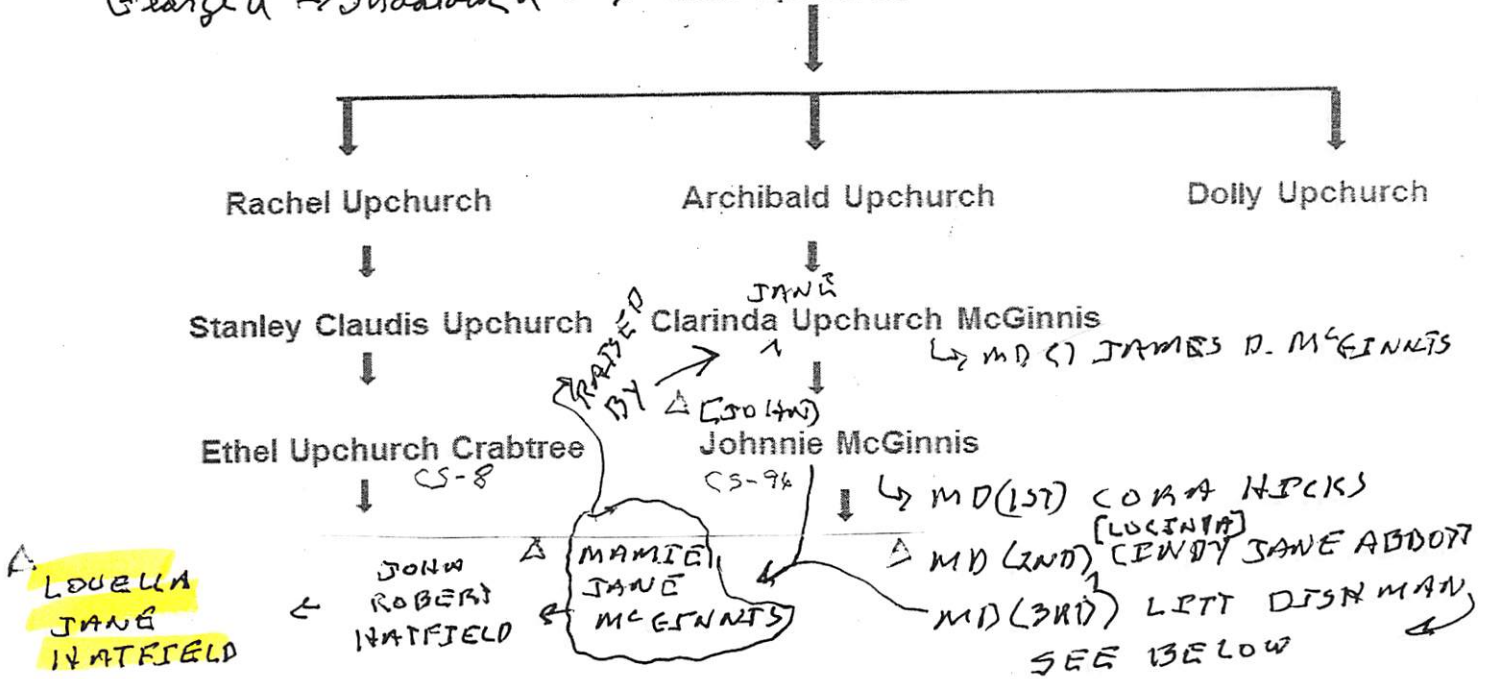

With regards to our Great Grandma McGinnis, very little is know about her. From what Grandma Mamie told us and based upon the grave that we visited, her maiden name was Sydria Mason, but her nickname when she was younger was Litt which based upon her middle name. Her first husband was a Dishman and Grandma Mamie had some half brothers and sisters that she lost touch with because her mother died when she was very young. Her father, as was typical in those days, remarried and Grandma Mamie was raised by her McGinnis grandparents. My sister and I are going down to Tennessee/Kentucky to check on Pop's grave and to visit our McGinnis relatives and hopefully finally visit our Grandpa Johnnie McGinnis's grave in the Dishman cemetery in Slickford Kentucky.

I was pleased that you were able to find details on my website by searching. I remember fondly exchanges with Ethel and need to go back and have a look at our exchanges.

Thanks for your comments on the Meal is Gone. I would like to explore the prospects of getting this reprinted because it is such a fine commentary on a local scene and one so important to Upchurch and allied families. Can you put me in touch with the author?

Any help you can give us on Allied Families would be appreciated. Are you in a position to help with transcribing documents? Special talents and money are always appreciated. Your help could be directed to adding to the enrollment of the George Upchurch Family to which you belong. We have to build momentum so we can get to the place where we can feel better about preserving the records long-term.
