Regarding Martha A. Maxey - I found a birth date of 1825 in Virginia from another family tree. That seems pretty close. The next sibling showing on the 1850 census is Elizabeth & she was born about 1829 in Virginia. (see #4) I would assume that Martha died when Henry was born in 1846 or shortly thereafter.

Richard married Malinda Jane Phelps in 1848 when they were still in Missouri, so I would think that Martha A. Maxey Upchurch is buried in Missouri.

We find Richard & Malinda living in Yount, Napa County, California in the 1860 census (see #1). He married Mary Mangus in Napa County 15 June 1862. So I would think Malinda died living in Napa County between June 19, 1860 (date on 1860 census is 19 June 1860) and June of 1862. Richard & Mary lived in San Luis Obispo in 1870 (see #5). In the 1880 census (#6), the family is living in the Arroyo Grande area in San Luis Obispo County & Richard is a widower again. When I contacted the cemetery in San Luis Obispo, I found a grave for a "female" Upchurch, died from suicide, 29 Jan 1878 in San Luis Obispo. The daughter, Susan (d. 1914) is also buried in the same area that was pointed out to me. There are no stones for either.

Richard did have a 3rd wife but Frank & Susan both born 1857 are Malinda's children (2nd wife). Frank not on 1860 census (see #1) which is weird because he is in the 1870 census. (see #5)

Pilgrimage to Zebulon uncovers family's roots

Mary Fisher Finch Monson of Charlotte and first cousin Ruth Anne Fisher Veazey of Hendersonville paid a visit to Zebulon May 22 and stopped at Zebulon United Methodist Church which was pastored from 1917-1921 by their grandfather, George Washington Fisher. Stained glass windows in the chancel area of the church memorialize George W. and Ida Love Fisher.

Another memorial stained glass window honors J.D. Finch and Sallie B. Finch, Mrs. Monson's paternal grandparents who

joined Zebulon Methodist in 1912. Her ancestors, both the Finches and the Fishers who served in many towns in the Methodist ministry, are buried in Zebulon Town Cemetery. Mrs. Fisher came to Zebulon to live with her daughter, Alma Love Fisher (Mrs. Waylon) Finch, after the sudden death of her husband in 1926. Fisher was serving the second year of his appointment to the Garner charge when he died suddenly.

Mrs. Monson grew up on Horton Street in Zebulon, the daugh-

ter of Waylon and Alma Fisher Finch. Mrs. Veazey, the daughter of the Rev. Edgar B. Fisher, visited her Aunt Alma and her cousin, Mrs. Monson, during their youth.

I remember when "Miss Alma" visited me for the first time when we moved to Zebulon in 1959. When she learned her niece married my second cousin, Dr. Alexander Holloway Veazey Jr., she treated me like a member of her family.

G.W. Fisher's granddaughters said they were touched to see the restored and refinished pulpit from the original Zebulon Methodist Church where he delivered four years of sermons. Mrs. Veazey believes her father, Edgar, also preached behind that pulpit as a visiting minister.

Many older members of this church will remember that Miss Alma always mentioned that her father preached from this pulpit when it was used for programs in the old fellowship hall. The granddaughters found the first entry made by their ancestor in 1917 in the oldest membership roll book.

Mrs. Monson said she was thrilled to see the original communion set, polished and on display in the historical case in the vestibule of the church. When a new communion set was obtained many years ago, the original went home with Miss

Mary Fisher Finch Monson of Charlotte and first cousin Ruth Anne Fisher Veazey of Hendersonville paid a visit to Zebulon May 22 and stopped at Zebulon United Methodist Church which was pastored from 1917-1921 by their grandfather, George Washington Fisher. Stained glass windows in the chancel area of the church memorialize George W. and Ida Love Fisher.

Another memorial stained glass window honors J.D. Finch and Sallie B. Finch, Mrs. Monson's paternal grandparents who

joined Zebulon Methodist in 1912. Her ancestors, both the Finches and the Fishers who served in many towns in the Methodist ministry, are buried in Zebulon Town Cemetery. Mrs. Fisher came to Zebulon to live with her daughter, Alma Love Fisher (Mrs. Waylon) Finch, after the sudden death of her husband in 1926. Fisher was serving the second year of his appointment to the Garner charge when he died suddenly.

Mrs. Monson grew up on Horton Street in Zebulon, the daugh-

ter of Waylon and Alma Fisher Finch. Mrs. Veazey, the daughter of the Rev. Edgar B. Fisher, visited her Aunt Alma and her cousin, Mrs. Monson, during their youth.

I remember when "Miss Alma" visited me for the first time when we moved to Zebulon in 1959. When she learned her niece married my second cousin, Dr. Alexander Holloway Veazey Jr., she treated me like a member of her family.

G.W. Fisher's granddaughters said they were touched to see the restored and refinished pulpit from the original Zebulon Methodist Church where he delivered four years of sermons. Mrs. Veazey believes her father, Edgar, also preached behind that pulpit as a visiting minister.

Many older members of this church will remember that Miss Alma always mentioned that her father preached from this pulpit when it was used for programs in the old fellowship hall. The granddaughters found the first entry made by their ancestor in 1917 in the oldest membership roll book.

Mrs. Monson said she was thrilled to see the original communion set, polished and on display in the historical case in the vestibule of the church. When a new communion set was obtained many years ago, the original went home with Miss

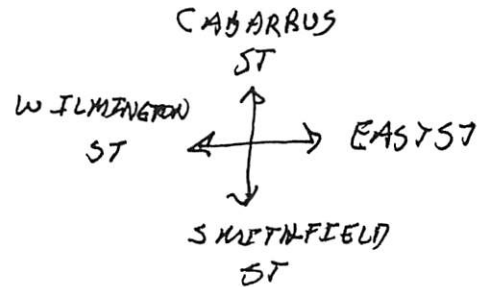
