He married Arried Minda Turner (March 17, 1889, d May 10, 1969) on December 1, 1909 in Rockdale County, GA. They lived in Rockdale County (Jesse was a farmer), until his father passed away. Correct date; william Lamar unchurch, born in Henry County on December 24, 1917 on the old homesite that belonged to his Grandmother, Lucinda Abigail Chaffin, Sept 28,1838 -July 11, 1924. Uncle Lamar will be 98 come this Dec 24, 2015.
The home-site has belonged to her father, Tyre Chaffing [Jan 23,1797 - Mar 26, 1878] who got the land when Henry County was founded in 1820.

We have been unable to find records of Tyre chaffin birth in VA but we know that he was one of the founding fathers, of Henry county. Claburn unchurch came from Franklin, NC about 1830's. At that time Henry county included all or part of Clayton, Rockdale, Newton \& Dekalb counties.. Clayton and Henry are still. in court on part of the county line.
