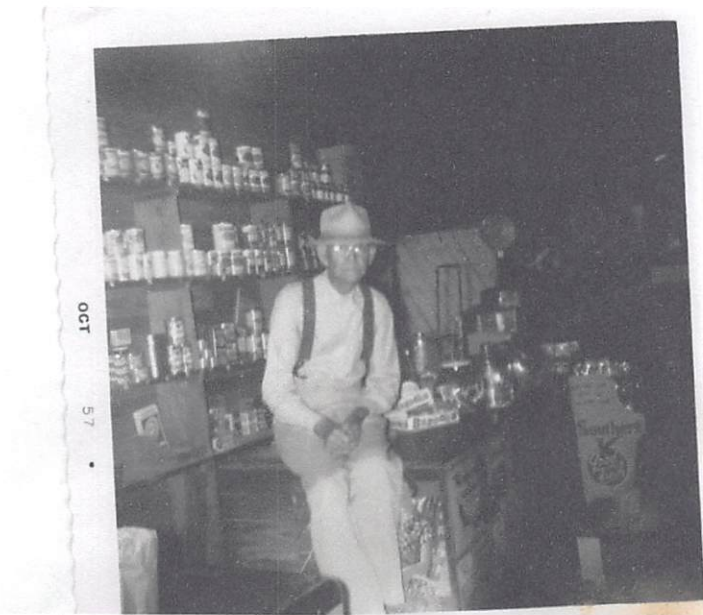

Many Sundays when his children [uncle Lamar or Aunt Ruth, aunt Mary McCart or us] come home for lunch [Dinner], Granny [Minda] would cook fried chicken. Granddaddy Jesse, would sell the good white pieces in the store before the company could seat down to dinner.

With Jasper & Lucinda living close to Sharon Baptist, they were members there. Tyre Chaffin help start Sharon church in 1825.

Correct date; William Lamar Upchurch, born in Henry County on December 24, 1917 on the old homesite that belonged to his Grandmother, Lucinda Abigail Chaffin, Sept 28, 1838 - July 11, 1924. Uncle Lamar will be 98 come this Dec 24, 2015. The home-site has belonged to her father, Tyre Chaffin [Jan 23, 1797 - Mar 26, 1878] who got the land when Henry County was founded in 1820.

We have been unable to find records of Tyre Chaffin birth in VA but we know that he was one of the founding fathers, of Henry county. Claburn Upchurch came from Franklin, NC about 1830's. At that time Henry county included all or part of Clayton, Rockdale, Newton & DeKalb counties.. Clayton and Henry are still in court on part of the county line.
