○ Extract of Deed made 25 MAR 1939 in Wake Co, NC conveying two tracts to the holdings of Eugene D. Cross. See his Biopile for full copy of court action - RPA interpretation of circumstances. It appears Eugene loaned money on 11 OCT 1932 to W. C. LYNN and his wife (Vergie Cornelia —) They could not repay the loan and on 3 MAR 1937 the 2 tracts of land pledged as security were sold at the courthouse steps to make Eugene whole. This 1937 action was taken by & in the name of his then Guardian C. M. Cross (Columbus M. Cross, brother of Eugene) and R. C. PERRY. The Guardian bid 4,000 as high bidder & thus the Commissioner L. S. BRASSFIELD issued a deed to make Eugene whole. The two tracts were in Leesville TSP, Wake Co, NC - described as follows:

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Tract #2 Adj. LUKIE DALE LYNN, L. P. SORRELL (DR) ANGELINE KING, CANDACE KING, WILEY LYNN, ELIZA J. LYNN (d. intestate) (Refers to deed Julia Lynn et al to THEODORE LYNN 18 FEB 1908

The above references were made while visiting the "EDWARDS" cemetery west of Rd 1831 across from the home of Eugene D. Cross. The tour group agreed this is where Mattie & the other Edwards are buried. The land here was owned by the WILSON family. Lorena came to the burials here of Sallie Creighton and a baby - a child of Mattie born after Bessie. Adolphus Creighton dug the grave for Mattie here. Lorena does not recall Cousey having the name Pauline. Cousey left MUTT with all the little children and the Lynn family came to the rescue - WARD LYNN, IRVING LYNN & EMMA LYNN - siblings. Cousey had been living on the Wilson Place - Bessie was born on "the corner" [HWY 50 & 6 FORKS RD?] Lorena was living at Ham's Super Creek when Bessie was born.

- △ BRATTON, CHARLES, Private
Enlisted in Wake County, September 17, 1864, for the war. Present or accounted for on company muster rolls until January-February, 1865, when he was reported as "absent on detached service."
- △ COOK, JOSIAH, Private
Enlisted in Wake County, September 16, 1864, for the war. Present or accounted for on company muster rolls through February, 1865. Paroled at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9, 1865.
- △ CRABB, DANIEL W., Private
Enlisted in Wake County, September 10, 1864, for the war. Captured at Winchester, Virginia, September 19, 1864, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until paroled and sent to Cox's Landing, James River, Virginia, for exchange February 13, 1865. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, February 15, 1865, and is reported as present at hospital through February, 1865.
- △ DAVIS, CHARLES M., Private
Enlisted in Wake County, August 10, 1864, for the war. Reported on company muster rolls as absent sick through February, 1865.
- △ DAVIS, EVEN, Private
Enlisted in Wake County, September 10, 1864, for the war. Admitted to hospital at Charlottesville, Virginia, September 23, 1864, with "v.s. left hand" and was furloughed on September 30, 1864. Reported on company muster rolls as absent without leave from November-December, 1864, through February, 1865.
- △ DELAP, SAMUEL, Private
Enlisted in Wake County, July 15, 1864, for the war. Present or accounted for on company muster rolls through February, 1865. Deserted and took the Oath of Allegiance at Washington, D.C., March 29, 1865, and was "furnished transportation to Hancock County, Ohio."
- △ ELER, L. D., Private
Enlisted in Wake County, July 15, 1864, for the war. Captured at Fisher's Hill, Virginia, September 22, 1864, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until paroled and transferred to Aiken's Landing, Virginia, for exchange on March 17, 1865.
- △ HAMPTON, ROBERT, Private
Enlisted in Wake County, September 17, 1864, for the war. Captured at Cedar Creek, Virginia, October 19, 1864, and confined at U.S.A. General Hospital, West's Buildings, Baltimore, Maryland, October 24, 1864, with "g.s.w. left hip. f.w." Paroled at this hospital February 16, 1865, and sent to James River, Virginia, for exchange. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, March 4, 1865, and was captured in hospital April 3, 1865. Took the Oath of Allegiance at hospital in Richmond, July 15, 1865.
- △ HEDGECOCK, ELISHA, Private
Enlisted in Wake County, September 10, 1864, for the war. Present or accounted for on company muster rolls through January-February, 1865, when he is reported as "absent on detached service." Nature of detail not given. Paroled at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9, 1865.
- △ JONES, JOHN, Private
Enlisted in Wake County, September 10, 1864, for the war. Admitted to hospital at Charlottesville, Virginia, October 23, 1864, with "v.s. left hand" and was furloughed November 8, 1864. 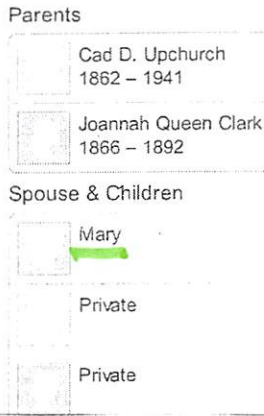

Lorena does not recall Cousey having the name Pauline. Cousey left MUTT with all the little children and the Lynn family came to the house - WARD LYNN; 1800 or LYNN & EMMA LYNN - siblings. Cousey had been living on the Wilson Place - Bessie was born on "the corner" [HWY 50 & 6 FORKS RD?] Lorena was living at Hamie Super Creek when Bessie was born.
