

Sarah Bonner Mabry “Sally”**no XIX and XIX – 4355**

Commentary: Sarah was the second wife of Willis J. Upchurch, son of Thomas Gay Upchurch and grandson of Charles, head of Upchurch clan 2.

E2 – Willis J Upchurch, son of Thomas Gay Upchurch, Sr; married (1st) 1850 Sarah (Sally Bonner) Mabry 1825 – 1860; (2nd) 6 Sep 1865 M A Whitehead Hutchens 1832 – 1916.

[Note see Sarah Mabry, XIX – 4355, which name I have used as 2nd wife of W J Upchurch. From this entry one could guess that Sally Bonner married a Mabry before she married W J Upchurch – RPU]

Sarah Mabry married 1850 Willis j Upchurch, born 28 Mar 1826, Henry Co, GA, died 1910. He was elder son of Thomas Gay Upchurch, Sr.

(2) See package from Ben Lane Upchurch, Sr 22 May 1980
Willis J Upchurch, son of Thomas Gay Upchurch, Sr married:
(1st) 1850 Sarah (Sally Bonner) Mabry 1825 – 1860
(2nd) 6 Sep 1865 M A Whitehead Hutchens 1832 – 1916

[Note: Does this mean Sarah had married a Mabry and that her maiden name was Sally Bonner?]

(3) See letter 13 Feb 1970 Martha Lucy Upchurch to William Kendrick Upchurch, Sr filed with Martha.

Willis J Upchurch born 1826 (Henry Co, GA) in Bowden Village, Carroll Co, GA. He was 33 and his wife Sarah [Mabry] age 38. Children are listed. Willis j Upchurch was in 8th Regiment GA State Troops, Co I as a PVT. Sarah died between 1860 and 1863 as Willis J Upchurch left his children with his parents when he went to war in 1863. When he returned he married 6 Sep 1865 M A Whitehead Hutchins and moved to Clay Co, AL.

[Note Hutchins = Hutchens (preferred for present – RPU) = Hudgins]
