

Mackey "Louisa" Upchurch XID 89

Commentary: There is some suggestion that Mackey "Louisa" Upchurch and her husband, Kinnion Jones were half-siblings. However, the second marriage of Kinnion suggests that is not the case. Nevertheless, more research is needed.

- (1) From RPU's Master Outline on Nathan U II, son of Nathan I , head of Upchurch Clan 3.

Nathan Upchurch, II, married Tilitha Patrick Jones. Tilitha had one Jones child. Thought to be Kinnion L. Jones (b. abt 1825), who married **Mackey Louisa U** – the first child of Nathan U, II. If so, Mackey Louisa must have been a daughter of a first wife of Nathan U, II. Thus, Mackey and Kinnion would have been step siblings- almost too complex to be true – RPU.

This Biofile will attempt to provide evidence as to relationship between Tilitha Patrick Jones, Mackey Louisa and Kinnion Jones. - JCB

In addition to Mackey Louisa Upchurch, one can find her brothers William and Alvin N. Upchurch. Note Henderson Pitman as a 17-year-old. Is he a son of Talitha? Also note that Louisa's son William appears as a one-year-old.

In 1860, we see Louisa and Tallity (sic) Pitman. If this is Talitha, then she married a man named Pitman and had the son named Henderson, as was seen in the 1850 census. Also note that Louisa's children, Helen, Charles, and George are present in the home.

License to me, at my office, with your signature subscribed to the Certificate under this License, and with the
blanks therein filled according to the facts, under penalty of forfeiting two hundred dollars to the use of any
person who shall sue for the same.
