DETAILS RE CO "I"

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington), Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I. After joining the regiment, the company functioned as a part of the regiment, and its history for the war period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864, and 15 September through December 1864. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.

Regarding Martha A. Moxey - I found a birth date of 1825 in Virginia from another family tree. That seems pretty close. The next sibling showing on the 1850 census is Elizabeth & she was born about 1829 in Virginia. (see #4) I would assume that Martha died when Henry was born in 1846 or shortly thereafter.

Richard married Malinda Jane Phelps in 1848 when they were still in Missouri, so I would think that Martha A. Moxey Upchurch is buried in Missouri.

We find Richard & Malinda living in Yount, Napa County, California in the 1860 census (see #1). He married Mary Mangus in Napa County 15 June 1862. So I would think Malinda died living in Napa County between June 19, 1860 (date on 1860 census is 19 June 1860) and June of 1862.

Richard & Mary lived in San Luis Obispo in 1870 (see #5). In the 1880 census (#6), the family is living in the Arroyo Grande area in San Luis Obispo County & Richard is a widower again. When I contacted the cemetery in San Luis Obispo, I found a grave for a "female" Upchurch, died from suicide, 29 Jan 1878 in San Luis Obispo. The daughter, Susan (d. 1914) is also buried in the same area that was pointed out to me. There are no stones for either.

Richard did have a 3rd wife but Frank & Susan both born 1857 are Malinda's children (2nd wife). Frank not on 1860 census (see #1) which is weird because he is in the 1870 census. (see #5)

In the summer of 1874 the federal Ordnance Department notified Gorman that North Carolina's state militia would receive \$45,000 in arms. Young men in and around the capital city responded by forming two companies: the Raleigh Light Infantry, commanded by Capt. Basil C. Manly, and the Raleigh Light Artillery, under Gen. William R. Cox and soon afterward Capt. Alexander B. Stronach. Local mechanics, led by R. T. Boshier, attempted unsuccessfully to organize a third white unit. The Oak City Blues, a black company, was organized in either 1874 or 1876 under Capt. Calvin Dunston. He was followed by Capt. Andrew J. Haywood.<sup>4</sup>     △

The North Carolina General Assembly created a State Guard and organized the state into three military districts as soon as federal troops withdrew in 1877. When the last U.S. soldiers vacated Camp Russell (formerly Pettigrew Hospital) east of Raleigh, the State Guard commandeered the six-acre installation in time for its first encampment during State Fair week.<sup>5</sup>

By September the promised guns had still not arrived, but evidence suggests they came by the following April, when Raleigh Light Infantry took about forty-five guns for a demonstration at the Charlotte Centennial. They performed a nineteen-gun salute at Raleigh's Fourth of July celebration in 1875, when "No. 1" exploded prematurely and "horribly mangled" Messrs. Williams and Bingham. *Daily Sentinel* (Raleigh), Apr. 7, 1875, 1; Apr. 12, 1875, 1; July 6, 1875, 1.

The Raleigh artillery unit apparently disbanded between 1880 and 1883, when it was no longer listed in city directories. *Raleigh City Directory, 1880-81, 194; 1883, 175.*

By 1890 the Oak City Blues disbanded and left the Charlotte Light Infantry as the state's only black military organization. The Adjutant General's report shows the Blues returned forty-five Springfield rifles and accessory equipment to the state arsenal in 1890. *Raleigh City Directory, 1880, 194; Historical and Descriptive Review (1885), 41; N.C. Adjutant General's Dept., Annual Report, 1890, 122.*

5. *Observer* (Raleigh), Oct. 5, 1877. Camp Russell was undoubtedly named for Capt. Edmund H. Russell, commanding officer of the first Union occupation forces in April 1865. Dear Phil,

I am very glad that I found your website as I had no idea how much family history I had.

I've been looking through the Ancestor ID register and have found that Belle Upchurch Place is XID 54252; she is the one who did all the research into the family's history. Her older brothers were William Upchurch 11813 and John Richard Upchurch 54250. She married Levi Rector and had a son William Earl Rector. I don't know exactly what happened to Levi Rector other than he died. From what my mother remembers, it was no real secret, but she never actually asked. Belle was married a second time to Melvin Leroy Place June 15, 1922. She died March 6, 1973 in Bartlesville Ok. I've included a copy of Belle's research updated to Microsoft Word. When comparing Belle's history with the bulletin, there are a few interesting things that I noticed. Belle makes no mention of Jonas Alexander son of Buckner. She also has a few another generation of Wesley's children.

My maternal grandmother was Mildred Ellen Upchurch XID 54255. She married Charley Mock who served as a Tech Sergeant in the US Army Air Force during WWII. After the war, they moved to Rangely Colorado and then on to Cut Bank, Montana. He worked on oil drills for Texaco and she was a home maker. They had 3 children Wayne Charles Mock, Cheryl Kay Mock (Mansen; my mother) and Kathy Sue Mock.

You are correct in placing us in Clan IV/Buckner sub-clan. Belle traced our lineage through Buckner's son Sion Upchurch 1255. Sion's son Silas 1285 married Mary Ellen (Mollie) Walker 54248 and had 3 children William, John Richard and Cynthia Belle. My great grandfather John Richard married Lilly May Anderson and had 3 children, Mildred Ellen, Opal Lee, and John Richard Jr. After Buckner moved to Ill., it seems Sion continued to go further west through Joplin Mo. and residing in Cherokee county Kansas. Sion owned and operated a general store there in Cherokee County Kansas. His son Silas continued to run the store until 1900 or so when he moved his family to Nowata, Oklahoma. There he opened another general store and left it to his son William. The store closed in 1955 when Will retired.

In addition to Belle's research, there are a good number of photos of family members as well. Most of the photographs are of Will Anderson and Gilda Belle but there is 1 of Silas Upchurch 1285 by himself and one with Phoebe Briggs 1258 her daughter in law Mary Ellen and her grandchildren William, John, and Belle. There are several photographs of the general store and one of Wilson Upchurch. There are several more professional portraits of Mary Ellen Walker's parents Dr. William Anderson Walker and his wife. There are also a number of letters between Lucy Mattix 52449 and William. The names of the individuals have been written on the back of many photos and my mother has identified the handwriting belonging to either Mary Ellen Walker or Mildred Mock. When Belle place died, I believe she passed on her research and photos to Mary Ellen Walker, who subsequently passed them on to Mildred Mock. When she died 7 years ago, the collection was still in the closet of my parents' house. None of us realized the treasure trove we had until recently. I hope to get all of these scanned in the upcoming months and I will send you copies.

I'd like to know more about your repository. As much as I would like to keep the collection, I think it would be better to place it in an archives. My family and I didn't know what we had until recently. If you have the facilities to house the collection, I would be willing to consider donation.

P.S.

Belle's history also includes a good amount research on other lines of my family's history. Belle split it between the Upchurch-Walker branch and the Briggs-Anderson branch. There are some letters between Mary Ellen Walker and her grand niece Shirley George Towner who researched that side of the family as well as photos of many of these people, for which I would also like to find a place.

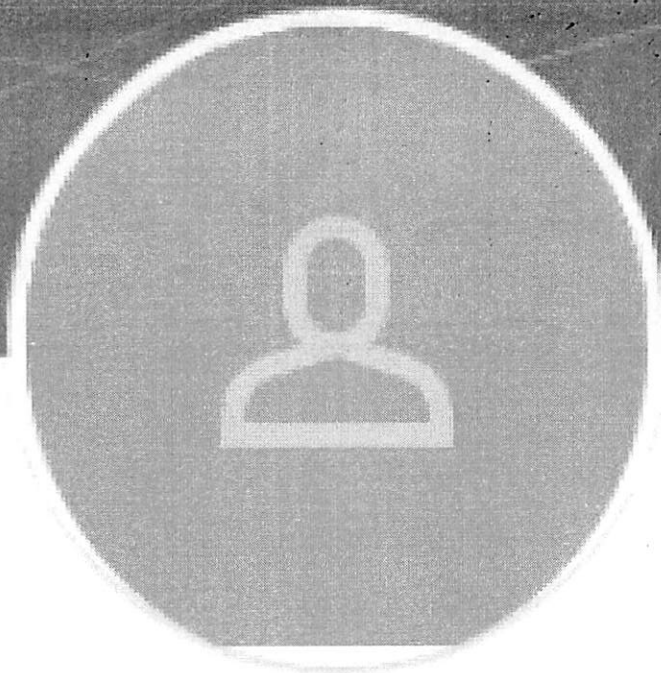

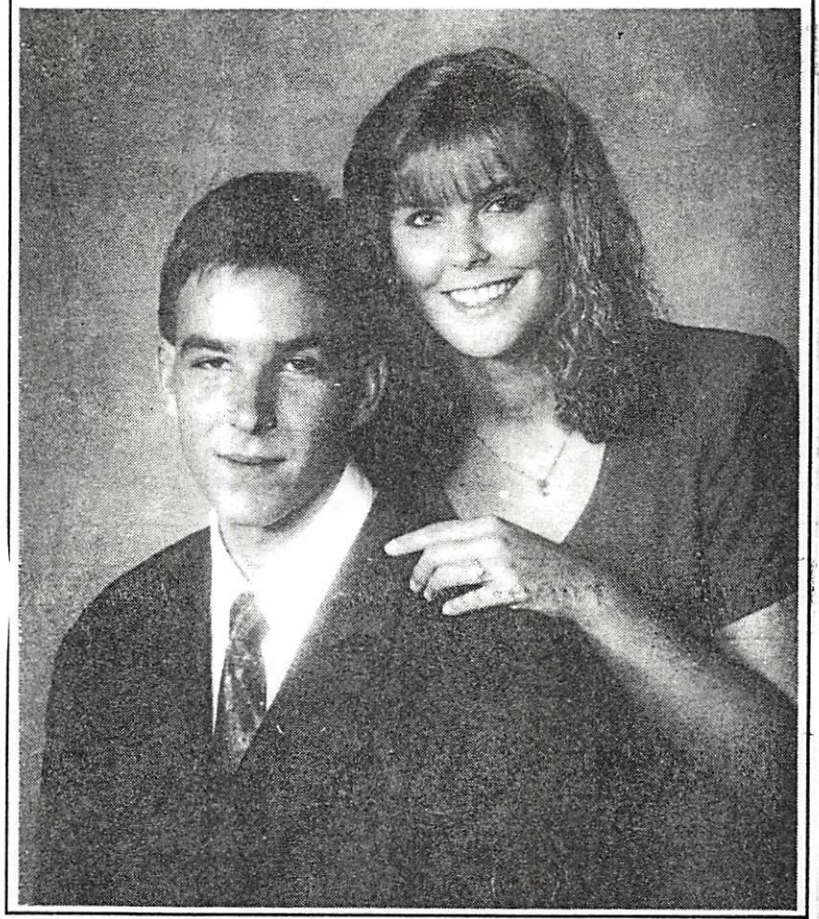

In 1835 and again in 1841 the United States Government published lists of soldiers of the Revolution who were pensioned for services in that war. At the risk of being tedious, I give the Wake County lists in full. Persons desiring a statement of the war record of any veteran herein named can obtain the same free of charge by addressing a request therefore to the Commissioner of Pensions, at Washington City. Except when other wise designated, persons mentioned were privates in the service of North Carolina. Some of the names are spelled differently on the two lists, and these variations I have indicated below. The list published in 1835 was as follows: Berthett ALLEN, James ADAMS, Philip ADAMS, James AMES, John AMOS, Christopher BABB, James BROWN, Jesse BRYANT (Virginia), William BURTON (or William H. BURTON), Jacob BYRUM, Benjamin CARPENTER, James CHRISTIAN 2nd, William CLIFTON, George COLE, Robert DODD, Reuben EVANS, John GREEN, Jesse HARRIS (or HORRIS), James HUGHES (Virginia), Thomas JINKS (Corporal), Francis JONES, Vincent KING, Joshua LYNCH, David MABRY, Jesse MANUEL, John MARR, Shadrach MEDLIN, Naaman MILLS, James NANCE, senior (Virginia), Jesse OSBORN, Drury PITTIFORD (Virginia), William POLK (Major), Elisha POPE (Virginia), Frederick RIGSBY (or RIGSBEE), Thomas ROSS, John RHODES, Aaron ROBERTS, Robert SNEED (Virginia), Joseph SHAW (Pennsylvania), Isaac SMITH, Samuel STANDEFORD (Virginia), Samuel SCARBOROUGH, senior, (Virginia), Jonathan SMITH, senior (Captain), John SHERRON, John SWENNEY, William TATE, Nathan UPCHURCH, William WILDER, Burrell (or Burwell) WHITEHEAD, John WALKER, John WILLIAMS, and Jesse WALL. In addition to the above, the list of 1841 gives the following names, without indicating rank, or State in which they served: James HARWARD, Thomas HOLLAND, Richard PIPEN, William SLEDD, Rufus WILLIE, and William WOOD. Some of these veterans were dead before lists were published. Joel TERRELL, whose name also appears on the pension roll of 1835, appears to have rendered his military service in the United States Army after the Revolution - possibly in the War of 1812.

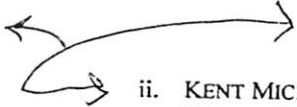

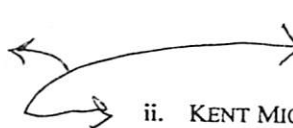

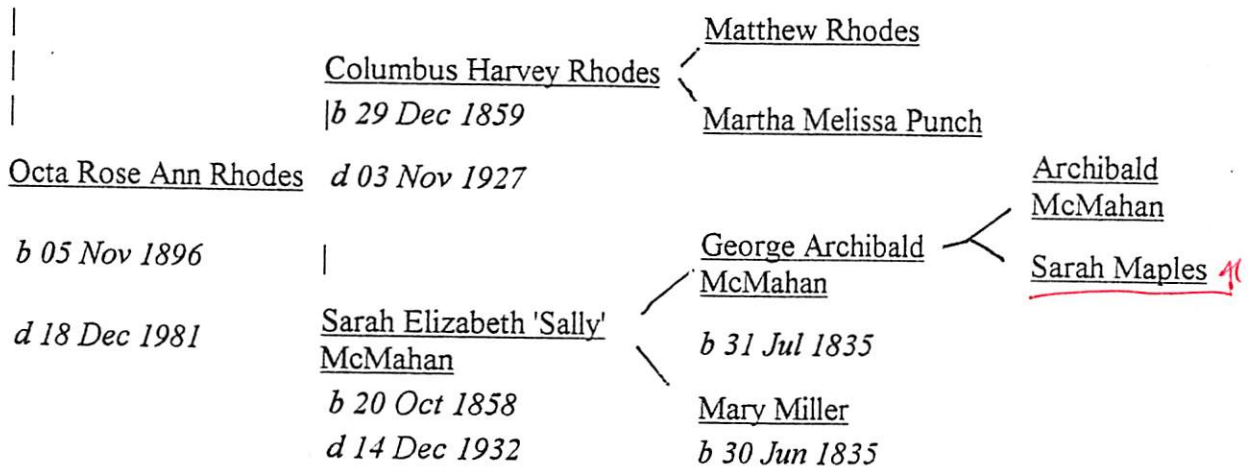
