Martha Maxey

<u>Her</u> brother was born in VA and sister Elizabeth 1829 born in VA and both <u>her</u> parents were born in VA. So we can assume <u>she</u> was also born in Virginia. See 1850 Census for John Maxey born 1791 Virginia. They are living in Missouri.

<u>She</u> died about 1846 in Missouri probably in childbirth. Child Henry born about 1846 see John Maxey born 1791 VA – 1850 Census MO. I would assume <u>she</u> is buried in MO.

(no number) On 14 Sep 1997 RPU examined a book entitled <u>Missouri Marriages to 1850</u> located in the Lake St Louis Branch of the St Charles Co, MO Library. There were only two marriages listed as follows:

- Richard D Upchurch 1 May 1845 (Schuyler Co, MO) to Martha A Maxey
- Richard D Upchurch 16 Apr 1848 (Scotland Co, MO) to Malinda Jane Phelps [Note: It is reasonable to presume that the 1845 marriage produced a son Henry Upchurch born 1846 who is the Henry Upchurch age 14 shown on the 1860 Census in Sullivan Co, MO presumably in the home of his grandfather John Maxey. This Henry Upchurch born 1846 and Henry S Upchurch born 1842 have been assumed to be one and the same. However, if Henry S Upchurch was in fact born in 1842 the two Henry's are different people.]



Regarding Martha A. Maxey – I found a birth date of 1825 in Virginia from another family tree. That seems pretty close. The next sibling showing on the 1850 census is Elizabeth & she was born about 1829 in Virginia. (see #4) I would assume that Martha died when Henry was born in 1846 or shortly thereafter.

Richard married Malinda Jane Phelps in 1848 when they were still in Missouri, so I would think that **Martha A. Maxey** Upchurch is buried in Missouri.

We find Richard & Malinda living in Yount, Napa County, California in the 1860 census (see #1). He married Mary Mangus in Napa County 15 June 1862. So I would think that Malinda died living in Napa County between June 19, 1860 (date on 1860 census is 19 June 1860) and June of 1862.

Richard & Mary lived in San Luis Obispo in 1870 (see #5). In the 1860 census (#6), the family is living in the Arroyo Grande area in San Luis Obispo County & Richard is a widower again. When I contacted the cemetery in San Luis Obispo, I found a grave for a "female" Upchurch, died from suicide, 29 Jan 1878 in San Luis Obispo. The daughter, Susan (d. 1914) is also buried in the same area that was pointed out to me. There are no stones for either. Richard did have a 3rd wife but Frank and Susan both born 1857 are Malinda's children (2nd wife). Frank not on 1860 census (see #1) which is weird because he is in the 1870 census. (See

#5)
