Blast from past explodes at bank

True treasures must be protected. So it's only logical a collection of priceless baseball memorabilia from Wendell history-makers be kept secured near a vault.

Right off Main Street, First Citizens Bank currently offers a peek in the past at three local legends of the diamond: Jake May, Fred Henry and Charlie Rowland. "We wanted the exhibit somewhere safe," said Ray Hinnant, president of the Wendell Historical Society. "We figured a bank is about as safe a place as you can get."

And the depository now has more than money drawing interest inside it. Branch Manager Terry Hodges says the curiosity case attracts a crowd every time the building fills up. They come for the bucks, then they linger for closer looks.

A separate board is dedicated to Jake May, the most highly deco-

rated of the group, because the 5-foot-8 pitcher grew to giant proportions in the professional ranks.

Born in 1895 near Youngsville, Frank Spruill "Jake" May moved to Wendell in 1907 and played with its town-sponsored club in 1912 along with Grover Rhodes, Mallie Todd, Coach/catcher Lawrence "Rube" Poole (then owner and editor of The Gold Leaf Farmer), John Buffaloe, Sam Jones, Luther Mattox, Paul Whitley, Zeb Richardson, Hannis Harper, Hank Hinton and Henry.

In 1917, May signed a contract to finally play for pay as a member of the St. Louis Cardinals clan. He was worth every nickel — and then some. May once pitched a no-hitter during an off-season stint in Cuba. During World War I, he enlisted in the army and worked the bases with a traveling troupe that entertained countrywide troops. Back in real business by 1922, he had set a Pacific Coast League record that still stands today by amassing a 35-9 record on the mound in one summer season.

Dubbed the "Wee Carolinian" by sportswriters of the age, publicity nearly brought an epic promotion. The New York Yankees offered the Vernon Tigers (of Los Angeles) \$75,000 for the south-paw's services. But the owner declined the deal at the last minute.

May wound up with the Cincinnati Reds organization from 1924-1930 before being traded to the Chicago Cubs in 1931. Call it his big break.

With his patented "jug-handle curveball" clearing May's way, the Cubs claimed the National League pennant and advanced to face the Yankees in the World Series.

May made two relief appearances in front of the nation's eyes and left one big impression by besting Babe Ruth on consecutive at-bats. Both times, Ruth went down watching.

The umpire in the clash, G.L. Magerkurth, later wrote May a letter offering his side of the story. "I remember the whole thing as vividly as yesterday," came the words in a 1960 correspondence. "You had a great day, for you struck out Babe Ruth two times in a row with your jug-handle curve after working the count down to 3-2, and I called him out twice. He turned and yelled at me, 'Where the (BLEEP) was that last one?' I jumped at him and yelled, 'Right through the (BLEEP) middle.' Babe looked at me and said, 'Ain't it the truth?'"

Ruth and the Yankees would enjoy the last laugh. The slugger was dusted by two straight pitches against Cub hurler Charlie Root. He stood up, shook his fist at the hill and swore he was going yard. He did, winning the game. New York eventually conquered the series via a 4-0 sweep.

But May, well, he savored his last hurrah. He retired immediately after the event, grabbing his \$593.16 share of the Chicago bonus and returning to Wendell. Here, he spent the rest of his life (which ended in 1970) farming tobacco and hunting.



Henry died in 1987 as a Wendell boy done good and come home.

Charlie Rowland invaded the Pittsburgh Pirate enterprise for an extended minor-league progression from the 1920s into the 1940s.

The triumphant trumpeted trio earns praises and gazes in their own corner of overdue fame for another month. Until then, anyone and everyone is welcome to meet Wendell's finest citizens at Wendell First Citizens.

Jake May's master pitch was the "jug-handle" curveball, which he used to maximum efficiency in the 1932 World Series by striking out Babe Ruth — two times in a row.



Though the meaning behind the nose touches remains unclear, it is certain the 1932 Chicago Cubs advanced to the Fall Classic riding the arm of "Wee Carolinian" Jake May.

His name does not linger around these parts just on his tombstone. It dots the sign leading to Wendell Country Club. Not a golfer himself, May donated the land as an entrance so others could engage in the sport.

In the end — and well before the end — it was the human side of May which really created his immortality. "He was so good to me. So very good to me," said June Fowler, his only daughter. "I was spoiled rotten, I guess."

Another minors celebrity of the bygone era was Fred Henry, who slithered to the nickname "Snake" due to his quick and agile hands. He remained on the brink of stardom for a long, long, long time. Henry posted a .302 career batting

average over 24 farm-system campaigns with gangs like Milwaukee, Montreal and New Orleans. He logged 3,200 hits and two league MVP ovations.

"Snake" slithered into just 29 major-league contests with the Boston Braves, where he was limited to a .187 average at the plate. Still, he hobnobbed among the elite. Spring training sessions found him rubbing elbows with Ruth, Lou Gehrig, Ty Cobb, Lefty Grove and Walter Johnson.

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington), Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I. After joining the regiment, the company functioned as a part of the regiment, and its history for the war period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864, and 15 September through December 1864. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.

MAY, Prior, Private

Enlisted in Wake County on 5 March 1864, for the war. Captured at Petersburg, Virginia, 6 February 1865, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland until paroled and transferred to Boulware's and Cox's Wharf, James River, Virginia, where he was received 20-21 February 1865, for exchange. Reported present with a detachment of paroled and exchanged prisoners at Camp Lee, near Richmond, Virginia, 27 February 1865.

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington), Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I. After joining the regiment, the company functioned as a part of the regiment, and its history for the war period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864, and 15 September through December 1864. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.

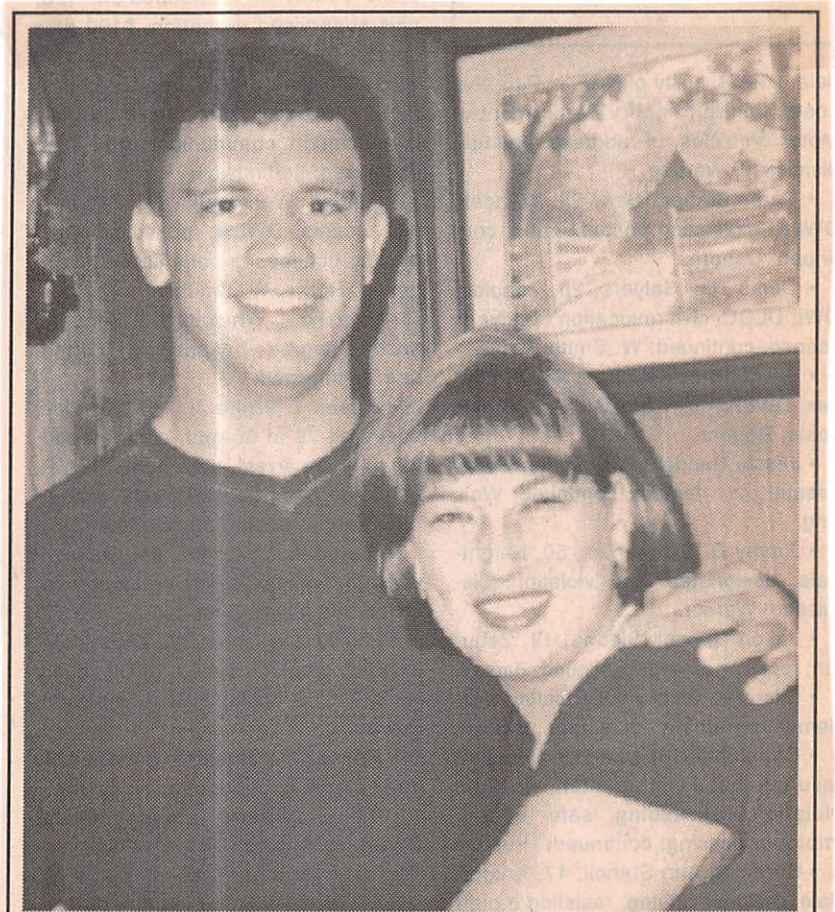
