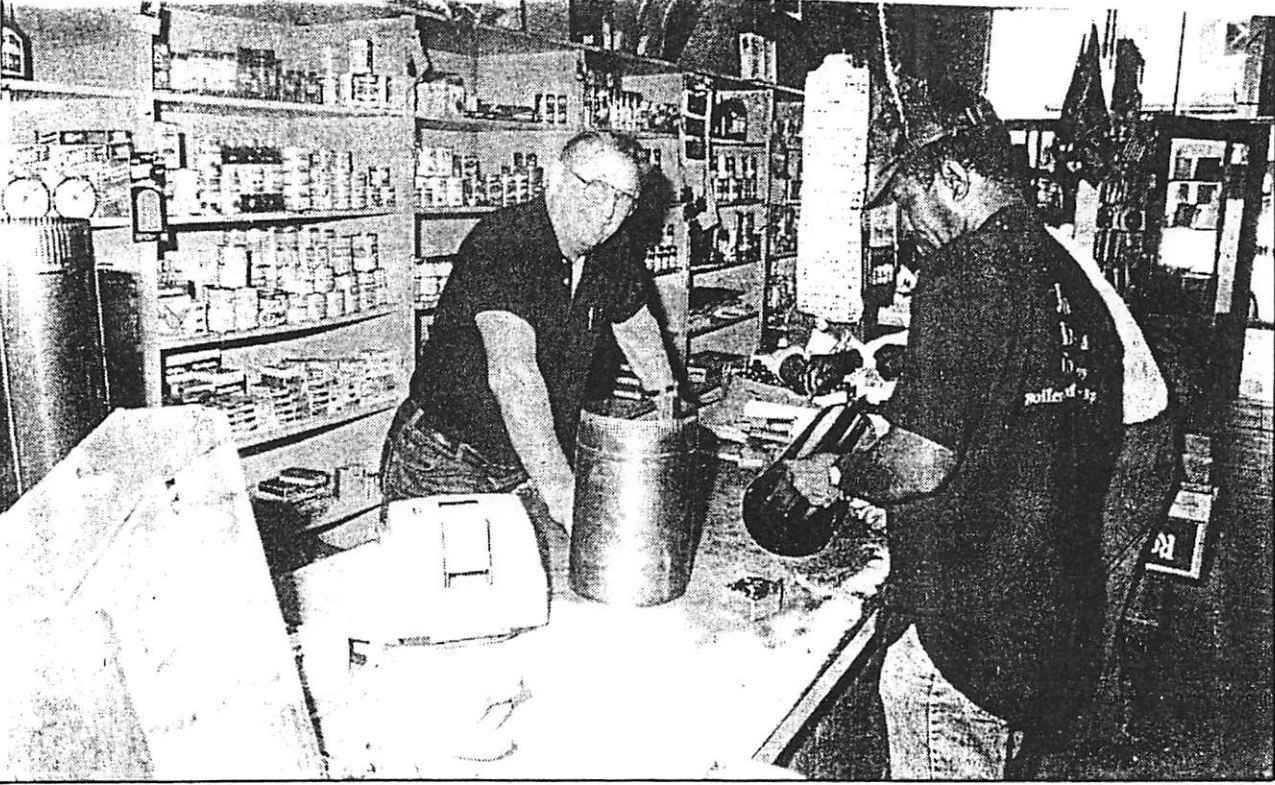

Longtime grocer retiring, closing shop

Time is running out for customers of the Apex Grocery. Come November, owner Harry Beasley will be closing down the 46-year-old general store to retire, and his long-time patrons will have to find somewhere else to go.

"About 60 years I've been coming by here. I used to come here when I was about four or five years old — I'm about 77 now," Leather Harrington said.

"When you came down here then you'd only see an automobile every now and then — most people came down on wagons," he reminisced. "He ain't going to close up, he'd hurt too many people like me and a whole lot of other people."

Beasley's brother Richard opened the grocery in 1950, and Harry joined him after his father's City Feed Store burned to the ground in 1955.

Originally located on the west side of downtown Salem Street, the Beasleys bought, in 1957, the building in which it is now housed.

The store catered mainly to the area's tenant farmers in its early years, Beasley said.

The farmers were given a stipend credit line at the store by their landlord, and they bought all their worldly goods there in the spring and summer work months.

"That's the reason all the stores in Apex carried a variety," Beasley said. "Feed, seed, fertilizer, just whatever it would take to grow a crop of tobacco."

"We had washing powder, Clorox, shoes, clothes — that was before all these chain stores started moving in."

He still carries a variety, everything from seeds, grapes and turnips to buckets, overalls and cokes.

"Since I was a little bitty boy — about 25 years — I've been coming here off and on," Samuel Mangum Sr., said.

Mangum brought his young daughter Deonna in Friday afternoon, to purchase mustard greens for his patch and "to bring her in here to see where daddy used to come and buy stuff."

"I spend about \$100 a week right here in this store buying garden seed, grass seed, fertilizer and hams," Moody Long said.

Long is one of Apex's older residents who often come to the grocery to sit and chat about things past, the current state of affairs and things yet to come.

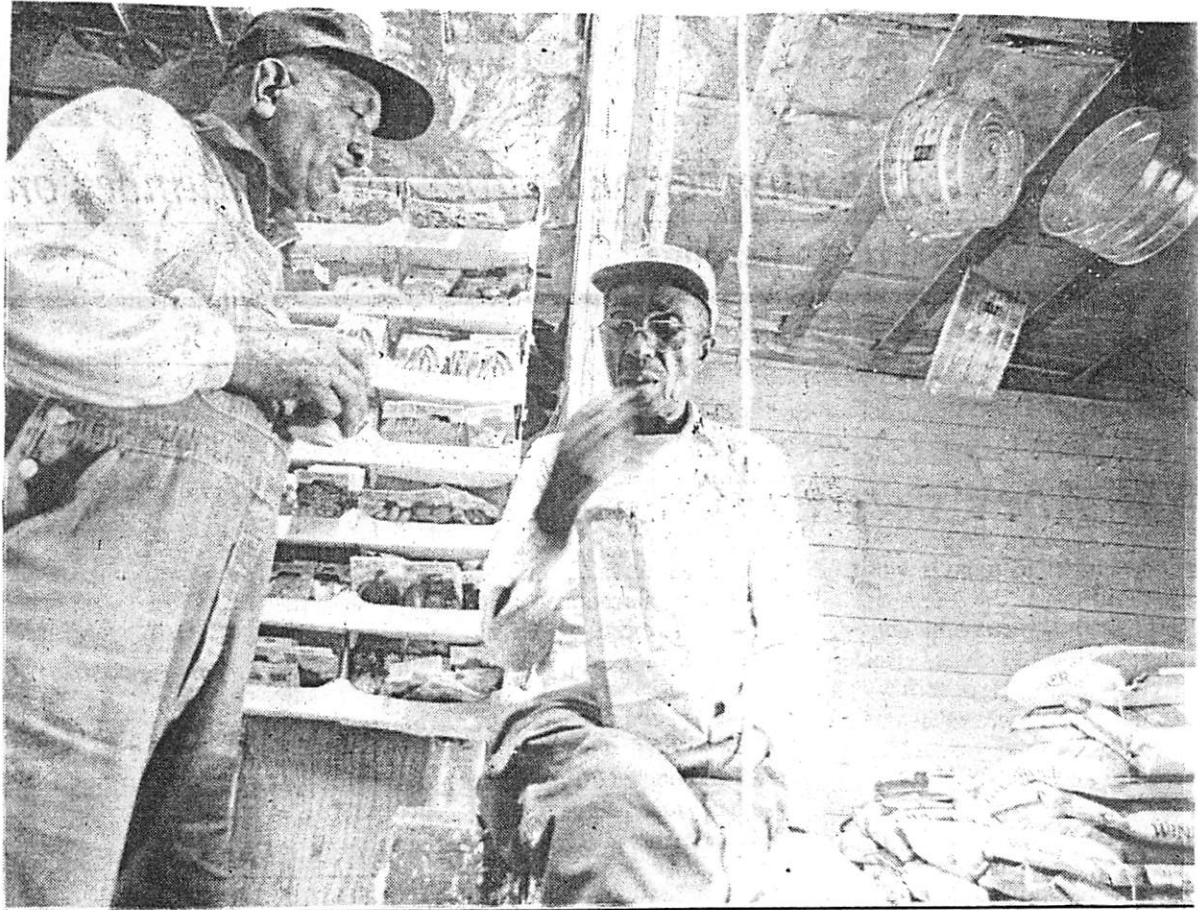
Some come in now to stock up on goods that will be gone in November, when the store closes.

Daniel Page, who came in to buy a stovepipe for a friend, also picked up apples and syrup.

"I want to get me some of that syrup before you close up," Page remarked to Beasley on Friday.

Beasley said that even though he'll try to sell off his inventory over the next few months, he will still order items people need.

"I've got a hotline right to the factory," he said. "I'm just not restocking."

Beasley has begun reducing prices on some items in order to move them. He's lowered prices on shoes, jackets and winter clothes and beginning Nov. 1 he said he is going to drop the price on all goods.

Beasley said that at the end of November he may hold an auction on the remaining items.

"I'm not happy at all about quitting," the 66-year-old Beasley said. "But there comes a time when everybody needs to retire."

While work wasn't too hard, Beasley said it has been rather confining, his being stuck in the store every day from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

He resides on Cunningham Street with his wife, in a house he has lived in for 39 years.

As for his customers, Beasley said in the old days they used to

hang out at filling stations.

"I expect some of them will miss it really," Beasley said. "It's been kind of a hangout but they'll find somewhere else to go."

"I know this is one of the best stores Apex ever had — I was trading with their daddy before

they ever took over," Frank Caufield said from his seat in the back room.

"Everybody knows me, I've lived here about 50 years," the retired 82-year-old dry cleaner said. "When it closes, I'll just sit home on the porch, I imagine."
