## JANE A. MC DONALD BELL

The eighth child of Leon Guy and Ethel Iva Upchurch McDonald was born October 19, 1916 in Huntsville Township, Schuyler County, Rushville, Illinois on a farm 20 miles west of Rushville.

My parents Leon Guy McDonald and Ethel Iva Upchurch of Timewell, Illinois were united in marriage at Fargo, Illinois on October 8, 1903. To this union were born ten children - seven girls and three boys. I was named for my great-grandmother, Jane Knight, Dad's maternal grandmother and for a neighbor friend of the family, Mrs. A. M. Eastman Benson. Mrs. Benson married the Hon. S. S. Benson in Springfield, Illinois August 16, 1871. She did not use her first name on her marriage certificate, just A.M. I have her 16 x 20 marriage certificate; and my Mother and Dad's marriage certificate. Dad said that

if I lived a good life as my namesakes, then I would be a fine person. I have thought of that remark often throughout my many years of living.

My first special memory was of the birth of my youngest sister, Margaret, who was born August 10, 1921. This was the time of the Brown County Fair. All of the children wanted to go to Mt. Sterling to attend the event, excepting myself. I wanted to stay home with the new baby. I cared for my mother and the new baby. At five years of age, I am sure that I was a "great help." I held Margaret as I sat in a small chair that had belonged to Mother's family when they were growing up.

The tragedy in our family was when Lela was burned. She liked to make candy out of molasses by boiling it until it thickened. She was four years of age. Mother was doing the washing in the old smokehouse where a gasoline engine motor ran the machine. After so much begging, Mother finally let her make some candy in a little skillet. Mother let her stand on a chair to reach the stove. Lela knew that if she took off the small center lid of the stove the fire would be hotter. In doing this, her thin little dress went over the open fire, causing it to burn on her chest and face. Mother heard her and was there in a minute, wrapping her in a small rug to extinguish the fire.

Dr. Hecox was called of course; he used an unguentine ointment to help heal it. It also acted as a cooling agent. Mother and Dad sat with her night and day to save her life.

A neighbor that wanted to see Lela brought her young daughter along. It turned out that she had the scarlet fever and Lela was exposed and had a bad case of scarlet fever on top of the burn. With her scarlet fever, the neighbors could not come to sit with Lela to help as we were quarantined. It took



all winter for each of us to have the fever. Roy was going to high school in LaPrairie and stayed nights with Mrs. Benson. One evening Roy came to Mother to say that I may as well come home as I have the fever. Mother said he was so lonesome for all of us, not being used to a quiet home. I was the last to have it. They were ready to lift the quarantine. The Doctor okayed the other ones to go to school.

During this time, one of the neighbors would bring the groceries to our front gate, then Dad would pick them up. I assume that Dad paid him then. Goldie and Helen were old enough to cook and take care of us younger ones.

I attended grammar school at Washington, District 63 in Schuyler County from 1922 until 1930. I had two classmates; however, they did not pass first grade as they missed so many days. From that time on, I was in the class alone excepting for the fifth grade. That year a family moved into the neighborhood with a girl my age for one-half a year of schooling.

When I took my 8<sup>th</sup> year scholastic test, I went to Rushville as it is the county seat. I scored the second highest in the county. A neighbor boy from another school scored the highest. My teacher, Mrs. Nelda Cain was proud to have a pupil score so high.

Being an only pupil in grammar school was a handicap when I went to high school at Clayton, Illinois. At high school, I was with 25 other students. Twenty-five was the biggest freshman class then.

I enjoyed Lela and Margaret when I was in grammar school (as well as my lifetime.) When I came home from school, I would read my books to them. They were too young to know if I read the right words, but Mother was always there to correct me. We would also sing any song that was from school or Sunday School. Of course, I was the teacher. Mother knew that I was a good babysitter and she would praise me for being a good sister.



We walked 3/4 of a mile to our country school. We had such a good Dad. He would take us to school when it was very cold or snowy. During the winter time he had a set of sled runners that he would put the wagon box, filling the wagon with straw to keep us warm plus blankets or quilts. He would hitch the two horses to the sled and in the evening he would come to take us home. How happy we were to hear the sleigh bells on the harness of the horses, as we knew Dad was outside.

The roads were too bad for driving the car. During the winter months he would jack up the car on wooden blocks to take the pressure off the tires. When he was driving the car to town or somewhere, he would stop for us to ride home if it were nearly time for school to let out. He would be visiting at the end of the school yard with a neighbor who lived there.

Dad would read the funnies to us Monday evening. (They called funnies comics in later years.) We had no Sunday newspaper deliveries on a rural route. We four youngest girls would sit on the arms of the rocking chair or in his lap as he read and explained them to us, as we were too young to read them. I only remember "Katzjammer Kids" "Maggie & Jiggs" and "Barney Google." There was no doubt other funnies.

Dad would play ball at our school picnics with other men and all the children. I could never hit the ball, as I could not see well enough. Dad would say hold the bat still and we will get a run. It worked of course, except that I could not run very fast and would be put out at first base. Lela was a fast runner and won the school races for our age group. I got my glasses at age 12 - what a different world it was for me! Then I could not play ball for fear that I would break my glasses.

### A SCHOOL STORY

Bill Knight was always our Santa Claus. After the Christmas Program he would come in from the porch "Ho, Hoing" as Santa did on those days. Since the papier mache mask was so poor for reading the names on the packages from under the Christmas tree, the teacher would read the name for Bill to repeat as giving the gift to the proper child. Once Bill forgot. When the teacher said "Bill Knight," he stuck the gift into his pocket. A huge cry went up, for the children saw what happened. He lost his identity as Santa although he tried to alibi his actions.

When Dad would be cutting wheat, he would use a McCormack Binder. It would cut the wheat with a sickle bar and lay it on a bed that moved along. At a given time the wheat would be tied into a bundle and dropped on the ground. This equipment took a team of four horses. In order to turn the equipment around, it used a lot of space, so Dad went up and around the field. When he got to a small strip left to cut, he would tell us children to come out with a box to catch some baby rabbits. Before the appointed time, we would be sitting at the end of the field just waiting for Dad to stop cutting. Then he would take the horses to a shady spot for them to rest and be out of the way. We then would catch as many baby rabbits that we would with Dad's help. Our knowledge of caring for rabbits was nil, but we did enjoy them, giving them clover and cows milk from a bottle with a nipple on it. They of course lived awhile, after which time

we would have funerals. We were good on funerals, having buried baby chickens, baby birds, cats and any animal that died in our care.

### FAMILY STORY AS I REMEMBER IT

My sisters Goldie and Helen had a recipe for making soda crackers that they had taken from the newspaper. Goldie always liked to cook and bake, making really good cakes and pies. The girls waited until Mother and Dad had a trip to town before trying the cracker recipe. A trip to town was an all day affair then. It was so much work, mixing and rolling the dough, cutting the crackers. The project was a failure and the problem was how to get rid of the dough. They finally decided the best way was to bury it. They buried it in the orchard. Having done this, they thought that was all well! It was - until a few days later, we had a nice warm summer rain. The dough started to raise, coming to the surface. Of course, Dad would be working around the orchard and could not image the great glob growing out of the ground. Finally the girls had to confess. Dad thought that it was so funny that no one was scolded for the waste of material. After that Dad would say "pass the crackers" when we were at the table eating, as though he had made a mistake instead of saying "pass the bread."

Our mailbox was 3/4 of a mile from the house. It seemed a long way in the summer heat. If we had ordered something from Montgomery Ward or Sears Roebuck, we were most anxious to go check on the mail. Dad would let me ride "Old Baldy" a white horse about 20 or 30 years old he had owned since he was a colt. I had to ride bareback. I don't know why I didn't have a saddle. When I got to the mailbox to reach for the mail I slid off and couldn't get back on. I took the horse as close to a big roadside embankment so I could jump back on. However, Old Baldy would not stand still for me and when I dropped the reins, he started for home and I had to walk. He would go just far enough for me to catch up and then he would go ahead, stopping to eat grass along the way. He was smart enough not to get home too soon, or he would be in trouble with Dad. I know now that Dad was watching for me, to see that I wasn't hurt. When I got home, he asked "did you fall off?" I didn't admit to such a thing; though of course he knew.

Haying was a fun time in the summertime. The farmers would exchange work and furnish horses and wagons to bring in the hay from the fields to the barn. To prepare for the hay to be put in the loft, Dad would open the big white door at the top of the barn, to the loft. He had a hay fork with ropes, at the top of the form was a pulley. When the fork was pulled to the top of the door, there was a railing that went into the barn. When the fork full of hay reached the proper part of the barn, it would be tripped, letting the hay fall. "There was also a rope threaded through the center of the barn with more pulleys. A rope was attached to a tree and to the harness of a horse, the same Old Baldy that wouldn't let me get on when I rode him to the mailbox. I rode the horse raising the fork of hay until Dad yelled "STOP!" and then tripped the fork of hay. I would then turn the horse around to be ready for the next trip. This was fun for us. We took turns as we grew older. Mother said that Dad could not have all of her girls for doing farm work. He could just hire it done. Putting up hay was one of her exceptions. Hazel liked to do farm work, however, I did not.

When we were younger, Hazel and I would disagree about things. To stop an argument, Mother

would make us sit on a straight back chair in the kitchen where she was working, until we would say that we were sorry. Hazel would soon be sorry and was free to go play. I was never sorry and would sit and sit. Mother would say "are you sorry yet?" I would say "no." When she was ready to leave the kitchen she would say that I could go if I would be good. I enjoyed the rest, and did not feel punished.

When haying or threshing on the farms, each farmer's wife had to prepare a dinner to serve the men at noon. The women would help each other as their turn came. With our family we were more than enough to do the work without outside help. However, Mother would go to help Mrs. Peck, our nearest neighbor. Mrs. Peck really wanted to do her own dinner and she did not want too much help in seasoning her food. She was rather heavy compared with us McDonald girls, who were all skinny. She was glad to have our help in preparing green beans, shelling peas, cleaning radishes, etc. The main help was getting the extra chairs from the many rooms upstairs, stretching the table and setting it for so many men. Mother was as good of a cook as Mrs. Peck, the difference being that Mother had to stretch her food to feed so many of us. Mrs. Peck would put on the cream and butter with a heavy hand. She fried chicken in a two-inch skillet of pure lard, never turning it more than once. Our gift for working there was a choice piece of chicken. She would ask us what piece of chicken we wanted, and then put it in the warming oven of her cook stove. It would be just right for us. My favorite piece was the breast and of course it would never have been left after so many men had their dinner. It was ever so good. We also had to do the dishes. Mother would come to help serve the food and help with the dishes. It didn't seem like work to do other dishes than our own.

### Second Schuyler Girl Is Accepted by WAACs

Miss Alzina Jane McDonald, a daughter of Mr. And Mrs. Guy McDonald of Huntsville township, who enrolled in the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps at Chicago, has received orders to report for duty at Chicago on April 19<sup>th</sup>. From there she will be sent to Daytona Beach, Florida, for her basic training. She had been at the home of her parents the past two weeks awaiting her call to active duty.

Mother always bought around 200 baby chickens each spring, getting 100 each order. They were placed in a brooder house separated from the hen house. They were kept warm from a brooder house heater. A kerosene type of lamp, that had a galvanized top covering a circle of about 6 feet to allow the chicks to go under to keep warm. When the chicks were old enough they were allowed out to make room for the second batch of 100.

The chickens were used for our food when they weighed three pounds or more. Those not eaten were used to increase Mother's flock or to sell. She sold the roosters and saved the pullets for two or three seasons, culling the oldest ones for sales as they didn't produce enough eggs to make it profitable by keeping them any longer. Uncle Owen Upchurch, Mother's brother, had a route to buy the farmers chickens and eggs, also to sell grocery items.

Sometimes a hen would make a nest in the woods and lay 14 eggs or so. In three weeks, her chickens would hatch and she would bring them to our yard to show off her family. This was inconvenient as the hen had to have special attention or the older chickens would fight the babies. Mother told me that I could care for them as I saw them first. I put her in a tin chicken coop with her 14 chicks. I was to water and feed her for several days until she knew where "home" was; then I could let her out as they would then go there with her family each evening. Mother said if I would care for her, I could sell the roosters and she would keep the pullets (hens) as they were called for the first year. I was already spending the big fortune as each rooster would be about \$3.00 each. Of course I thought that half would be mine to sell. However, tragedy struck - the second or third day. I had the hen shut in the coop - it was like 100 degrees that day. We were having the thresher crew and much excitement with so much activity. When I remembered my old hen, she had had a heat stroke and fell on her chickens, killing all except two. How sad! Even after 70 some years, I remember my sadness of having been so careless as to cause so many chickens to die.

However, I bounced back and took the two babies to our yard and kept them in an old tire from a car and fed and watered them. My nephew, Bobby Gene, and niece, Betty, lived nearby. They came to Grandma's every day. They really liked my chickens. Bobby liked them so much, that he loved one to death. Then I had one. It was a beautiful chicken, light buff with white feathers. Since it was a hen it belonged to Mother. She had it for several years. The following year she let it set on a nest of eggs. Out of the goodness of my Mother, she gave me \$3.00 when she sold her chickens, since I had such bad luck.

### FLOWER GARDEN

Mother and Dad had two large gardens. In one garden Dad usually planted potatoes and sweet corn and a few rows of pop corn. He could bring in a plow to keep the weeds down and hill up the plants. The other garden was for all other vegetables.

We all had to work in the garden hoeing weeks. When I was working along side of Mother, I always wanted to know "how far did I have to go?" or "how many rows?" One day Mother said "why don't you make a flower garden in front of the other garden, to the east of the house, next to the yard. This suited me just fine. It was a joy to plant flower seeds. I had all annuals, such as zinnias, marigolds,

asters, daisies, white and Black-Eyed Susans, etc. We had flowers in the house all summer as Mother liked flowers as much as I did. I had one big orange/red zinnia that was outstanding. I planned to save it for seeds to be used for the next year. No one was to pick it! However, my nephew, Bobby Gene, thought it was pretty and low and behold, it picked it. This was the end of saving it for a whole row of orange/red zinnias for the following year.

In retrospect, it was wonderful to be young, to go through the lane, to the pasture and the woods section of the farm. My brother and sisters and I would walk together picking wild flowers for a bouquet for Mother. We would walk to a "big" rock, the creek would be at the bottom of the rocks and we could wade in it. We drank water out of the creek; it was so clear, we never had a thought of impurities. We picked many things in their season. There were blackberries, raspberries, and blue grapes. In the fall we had hickory nuts, hazel nuts, walnuts and butternuts. We got enough to last all winter, using the nuts in cakes and cookies.

Army Pfc. Kevin C. Stewart deployed to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, and participated in Operation Sea Signal, assigned to Joint Task Force 160, Joint Task Bulkeley. The soldier is a member of 1st Battalion, 3rd Air Defense Artillery from Fort Carson, Colo.

The operation is a humanitarian relief mission in which the battalion task force has the responsibility for regulating, monitoring and caring for three Cuban villages or camps with a total of 6,000 migrants. Most of the Cubans came from Panama where they have been involved in disturbances and riots that claimed over 250 U.S. casualties.

The soldiers' duties were to secure the safety of the migrants and U.S. personnel, to react to and quell any disturbances and riots that might occur in the camps, and to oversee and improve the quality of life for the Cubans inside their villages. Schools, chapels, athletics, musical instruments, carpentry tools and materials were provided to the Cubans.

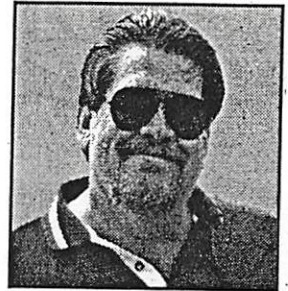

Delmer Duncan Crouch

Delmer Duncan Crouch, son of Dr. and Mrs. Archibald Henry Crouch, was born on September 9, 1911 at Forbus, Fentress County, Tennessee. He was the jolliest one of the three brothers and made friends easily. He grew up to only five feet and ten inches instead of the six foot size of his brothers.

D.D. (as many folk called him) was the hardest worker in the family or in the neighborhood. He dearly loved farming and was working in the fields with the black hired man at an early age. He finished at the Pickett County High School at Byrdstown, Tennessee and attended college at Tennessee Tech University in Cookeville for awhile.

Duncan married Pansy McDonald, daughter of Hon. J.Q. and Maggie Winton McDonald, on September 16, 1931 at Albany, Kentucky. They lived at Forbus, Byrdstown, and Muncie, Indiana during their marriage. Pansy taught in the Pickett County Elementary School system for many years and retired recently. She was a graduate of Tennessee Tech University. As present, she acts as a substitute teacher and lives in Byrdstown, Tennessee.

During the depression, jobs were scarce and Duncan would work in glass plants in Muncie, Indiana in order to make a living. After seven years of marriage, two children were born to this couple. Billy Kent was born on February 2, 1938 and Nellie Sue was born on September 16, 1942. They attended schools in Pickett County. Before they were grown, Duncan and Pansy divorced. Duncan went to California where he may still be living. He has not kept in touch with any of his family for a few years.

Delmer Duncan Crouch, son of Dr. and Mrs. Archibald Henry Crouch, was born on September 9, 1911 at Forbus, Fentress County, Tennessee. He was the jolliest one of the three brothers and made friends easily. He grew up to only five feet and ten inches instead of the six foot size of his brothers.

D.D. (as many folk called him) was the hardest worker in the family or in the neighborhood. He dearly loved farming and was working in the fields with the black hired man at an early age. He finished at the Pickett County High School at Byrdstown, Tennessee and attended college at Tennessee Tech University in Cookeville for awhile.

Duncan married Pansy McDonald, daughter of Hon. J.Q. and Maggie Winton McDonald, on September 16, 1931 at Albany, Kentucky. They lived at Forbus, Byrdstown, and Muncie, Indiana during their marriage. Pansy taught in the Pickett County Elementary School system for many years and retired recently. She was a graduate of Tennessee Tech University. As present, she acts as a substitute teacher and lives in Byrdstown, Tennessee.

During the depression, jobs were scarce and Duncan would work in glass plants in Muncie, Indiana in order to make a living. After seven years of marriage, two children were born to this couple. Billy Kent was born on February 2, 1938 and Nellie Sue was born on September 16, 1942. They attended schools in Pickett County. Before they were grown, Duncan and Pansy divorced. Duncan went to California where he may still be living. He has not kept in touch with any of his family for a few years.
