Moved with the Edwards family to Merry Oaks in the Cape Fear township of Chatham county where they built and operated a boarding house and he built and operated Yates Store for many years. The boarding house and store are on the south side of the Norfolk Southern Railroad tracks from old US 1 highway. This is Old Christian Chapel rd. It adjoins the Triangle Brick property right at the interchange of US 1 South and Old US 1. Also listed in th 1900 Chatham Co NC census New Hope township on page 189a, the 1910 Chatham Co NC census Cape Fear township on page 64a. Earnest and Eutie (Eustis) are listed in the 1910 Rowan Co NC census page 170b as boarders in the home of David B Patton and working for the Steam Railroad. In the name of God Amen I Daniel McFarland of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make Publish and Declare this to be my last will and Testament in manner and words following that is to say that my Executor hereinafter named shall provide for me a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relations and friends and pay for the same out of the first monies that may come into his hands as a part and parcel of my Estate

Item 2^o My Will and desire is that my Executor hereinafter named shall pay all my just debts and collect all that may be due me at my decease and should there be a surplus in his hands after paying and collecting that it be disposed of as named in Item 1^o 7^o & 8^o.

Item 3^o I Will and bequeath to my beloved nephew James A McFarland One hundred & eighty five acres of land including the old homestead

Item 4 I Will and bequeath to Caroline Salmon wife of Ruford R Salmon all my interest and claim in and to Twenty six acres of Land lying near the McFarlands Millpond adjoining the land of said R R Salmon said tract is known as the Nancy McFarland tract

Item 5 I Will and bequeath to Caroline Hicks wife of Sam Hicks Twenty five acres of Land it being the lower half of the Bostick tract

Item 6th My Will and desire is that my Executor shall take the residue of my lands and all personal property I may leave not otherwise disposed of and apply the proceeds as directed in Item 1^o 2^o 7^o & 8^o.

Item 7^o My Will and desire is that my Executor pay to the doing of any bequest

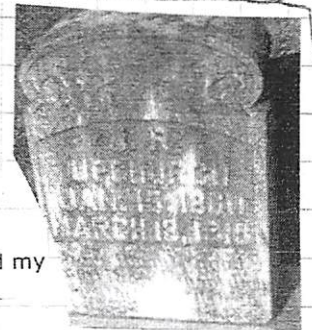

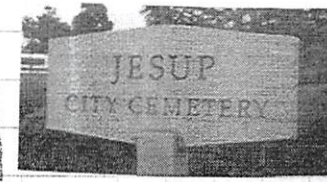

Obituary Condolences

MARGARET M. ALKEK, an acclaimed philanthropist and arts patron whose generosity of spirit set the tone for charitable giving in Houston and across the state, passed away peacefully in the presence of family and friends on Thursday afternoon, the 24th of March 2005. The daughter of Charles and Letyr Knight McFarland, she was born on February 23, 1916 in Houston, Texas, and graduated from San Jacinto High School in 1933. She attended the University of Texas at Austin, where dashing young oilman Albert B. Alkek of Victoria courted her by swooping his airplane low over her dormitory, to the delight of her classmates. By 1934, Margaret and Albert Alkek were married. From the earliest days of their 61-year marriage, Mrs. Alkek worked side by side with her husband to build a successful business. He made the deals and she kept the company's books and inventory. The couple later diversified their business interests and established residences in both Bandera and Houston. Mrs. Alkek brought to her marriage a solid appreciation for family life and public service. She was a member of a number of genealogical lineage societies and keenly appreciated her own family's history and that of her hometown and state. She also enjoyed reading, dancing, and visiting with friends. Education was important to Mrs. Alkek, who returned to college in the late 1940's and graduated with honors from Victoria College in 1951. Even as a young wife and mother in Victoria, she was active in the League of Women Voters and a member of the "Pink Ladies," the Hospital Auxiliary for Victoria's Citizens Memorial Hospital. She began this work with her mother and continued volunteering with her daughter, Margaret Alkek Williams. This community service was complemented by generous contributions. The Alkeks shared their financial success with the philanthropic world, giving more than \$50 million to programs that advanced medicine and education. At Mr. Alkek's death in 1995, Mrs. Alkek became chairman of the newly formed Albert and Margaret Alkek Foundation. Mrs. Alkek devoted her time and resources to many nonprofit organizations that were close to her heart. The Houston Ballet Foundation, Houston Grand Opera, the Museum of Fine Arts, Houston, and the Moores School of Music at the University of Houston were among the arts programs she favored. Educational and community programs included Delta Delta Delta, the Kronkosky Library of Bandera County, the University of Houston System, and St. Christopher's Episcopal Church in Bandera. Mrs. Alkek established scholarships at Texas State University-San Marcos, the University of Houston-Victoria, Northwood University, and the Texas Military Institute. She also was a tremendous advocate for medical programs such as the Cancer League, the Crohn's & Colitis Foundation of America, the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston, and the University of Texas M.D. Anderson Cancer Center, home of the Albert B. and Margaret M. Alkek Hospital. At Baylor College of Medicine, the Margaret M. and Albert B. Alkek Building for the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences, the Alkek Tower, the Alkek Fountain, the Alkek Eye Center, the Margaret M. and Albert B. Alkek Department of Medicine, and the Margaret M. Alkek Distinguished Chair in Medicine honor Mrs. Alkek's philanthropic vision. As chairman of the board of the Albert and Margaret Alkek Foundation, Mrs. Alkek personally oversaw the strategic investment of more than \$70 million in medical, educational, and cultural programs, including a landmark \$31.25 million to Baylor College of Medicine in 1998. "It's thrilling to wake up and be able to do something and be productive by helping in as many ways as you possibly can," Mrs. Alkek said at the announcement of the Baylor gift. Over the years, Mrs. Alkek continued to be involved in her community. Her friends admired her gracious enthusiasm for helping others and her energetic support of their fundraising efforts as well as her own. One of the greatest joys in her life was her friends. A long-standing member of the Episcopal Church, Mrs. Alkek attended St. John The Divine in Houston and St. Christopher's in Bandera. Mrs. Alkek received many honors, including a 1996 Honorary Doctor of Philosophy Degree from St. Mary's University. The Huffington Center on Aging at Baylor College of Medicine recognized her service on its board with the Spirit of Anne Morrow Lindbergh Award in 1998. In 1999, Northwood University presented her its Distinguished Women's Award. In 2000,

she received the Maurice Hirsch Award for Philanthropy from the National Society of Fund Raising Executives. She received the first Women of Achievement Award at the 2000 National Convention of Delta Delta Delta in Washington, D.C. Mrs. Alkek is survived by her daughter, Margaret Alkek Williams; her grandson, Charles A. Williams, and his wife, Randa Duncan Williams; and her great-grandson Harrison M. Williams; all of whom will keep her name and kindness alive in perpetuity through the family's commitment to help others. Friends are cordially invited to a visitation with the family from six until eight o'clock in the evening on Wednesday, the 30th of March, in the foyer and library of Geo. H. Lewis & Sons, 1010 Bering Drive in Houston. The funeral service will be conducted at two o'clock in the afternoon on Thursday, the 31st of March, in the Sanctuary of St. Luke's United Methodist Church, 3471 Westheimer Road in Houston, with the Rev. Dr. Laurens Hall of St. John The Divine Episcopal Church officiating. Honored to serve as pallbearers include Dr. Bobby R. Alford, James L. Daniel, Dan L. Duncan, Kenneth W. Hicks, Dr. Dan B. Jones, Michael R. McDonald, Joseph H. Peck, Jr., and Scott B. Seaman. Immediately following the service, the family will attend a private committal service at Memorial Oaks Cemetery in Houston. For those who so desire, and because of the family's involvement with a variety of organizations, memorials in Mrs. Alkek's name may be directed to the charity of one's choice.

This information was contained in UPCHURCH FAMILY OF ENGLAND, VIRGINIA AND NORTH CAROLINA, by Belle Lewter West.

EDITOR'S NOTE: Margaret, did Revolutionary soldier Richard or Nathan Upchurch apply for a pension? There may be some helpful information to be found in his petition for the pension, for the family status of the veteran was frequently mentioned.

Since it is likely that Mackey Johnson Upchurch being a "femme covert" [married woman] held no property in her own right, one is unlikely to find an estate settlement for her, but you should be on the safe side and check.

Once in a while you luck out when a woman who received something as a "life tenant" in a will; she had the use of the property or slave during her lifetime, and at her death it was to be divided in equal parts for her heirs. This frequently happened when her father wanted to leave something to her, but did not want to go to the trouble or expense of setting up a trusteeship for her, yet did want the property/slave to be free of her husband's control and his creditors! If this happened in Mackey's case, when she died the executor/administrator of the donor's estate would show that the estate had taken charge of what she had the use of, and made an equal division to the "heirs of her body" naming the heirs, and generally giving their receipts for the shares.

Obviously this gets involved, yet some great information comes out of your effort!

John McFarland b. 1798 and his wife Margaret Baker are buried in the Jonesboro, NC (now absorbed by Sanford) area but the graves have been plowed over and cannot be located. The family was first shown in Moore Co but their land fell into See Co when Moore Co was split. The grave of John Baker McFarland and his wife Ruth Brooks exist in a 9 grave cemetery in the Jonesboro, NC area and the family has protected this site.

Ruth Beverly McFarland is the dau of Tyram Clinton McFarland and the gd of John Baker McFarland. I explained my slim leads to Ruth and she was appreciative.

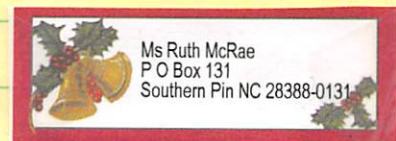

Although my earlier information was that James M. U and Isabella Thomas, your first letter set me to thinking that perhaps Isabella Thomas was a married name and that possibly she was nee Isabella McFarland - leading to the use of McFarland as a middle name for one of her children. Now that we have several pieces of the puzzle it appears that this is exactly what happened.

For the James M. U family I show 8 children, one of whom is not named. At present I would conclude that 5 of the 8 which were born between 1859 and 1868 were children of James M. U and Isabella. For the other three (born before 1859) (one of whom is unnamed) I would conclude that they are not children of James M. U & Isabella. However, I am not sure if they were children of Isabella which she brought to the marriage from her first husband or whether they are children of James M. U from his first wife - or maybe some of each. These three children did go by the name of Upchurch - but one

was named Frank Thomas Uphurch giving a hint that there could have been a child of Isabella and her first husband and that they named him Frank Thomas with this becoming Frank Thomas Uphurch when Isabella and the second came

For the James M. Uphurch family I have varying amounts of information on his children but most is sketchy except for Charles McFarland Uphurch. A grandson of Charles McFarland is a good friend of mine and a most productive family history collaborator

James M. Uphurch was the son of Whitney Uphurch and the grandson of Moses Uphurch. Moses Uphurch is of the 5th generation of Uphurches in America. There are 22 known 5 generation family members. Each of the 22 heads an Uphurch clan according to my way of keeping records

my Grandfather was a 2nd cousin of James M. Uphurch. Both were Civil War veterans.

Enclosed are details on my genealogical work and a copy of our "freedom" document.

Incidentally, the Waylen Upchurch mentioned in your 25 NOV 1996 letter is well known to me and married in our name several years ago. We are in regular contact.

Having made a very nice advance in our family history that is of mutual interest the question is where do we go from here. If you have all you need that is great. For my part, I continue to collect details on all Upchurch descendants. I would be very interested to learn more about James M. Upchurch and his two wives and their descendants. I don't know if you are prepared to do more searching of the records on this group. From my standpoint, I am happy to share anything I have and to pose questions about what is needed.

It is great to hear from you and I hope we may continue to help each other

Moore County was formed from Cumberland County in 1784. It was named in honor of Captain Alfred Moore, a Revolutionary War soldier who later became a Judge of the United States Supreme Court.

In the mid 1700's, the first white men settled the bottomlands along Deep River in the clay country of Northern Monroe County, and by the time of the Revolution, the North and Central parts were thinly but evenly settled, mostly by English and Ulster Scots and a few Germans.

CHATHAM COUNTY

Chatham County was formed in 1771 from Orange County. The Assembly met in December, 1770, but Chatham and three other counties were not established until 1771, effective April 1771. The county was named in honor of William Pitt, Earl of Chatham. He was an eloquent defender of the American Cause in the English Parliament during the Revolution.

It is located in the central section of the state and is bordered by Wake, Harnett, Lee, Moore, Randolph, Alamance, Orange and Durham Counties. The county covers an area of 707 square miles.

The first courts were held at the home of Stephen Poe. Commissioners were named to designate a place for a courthouse, prison and stocks.

HARNETT COUNTY

Harnett was formed from Cumberland in 1855. The county was named in honor of Cornelius Harnett, a Revolutionary Patriot, president of the Provincial Council, president of the Council of Safety, delegate to the Continental Congress and author of the Halifax Resolutions of April 12, 1776.

The county is situated in the eastern portion of the state and is bordered by Cumberland, Moore, Hoke, Lee, Wake, Johnston, Chatham and Sampson Counties. Harnett County covers an area of 606 square miles.

LEE COUNTY

Lee County was formed from parts of Moore and Chatham Counties in 1907. The first county offices were upstairs over the Carter Furniture Company. The first Lee County Court was held in the old Opera House in the Page Trust Company Building in 1908, with Judge B.F. Long presiding. The following officers were elected: John C. Watson, sheriff; T.N. Campbell, clerk of court; T.M. Cross, register of deeds; and B.C. Pearce, treasurer. The first county commissioners were: John R. Jones, Jesse L. Godfrey, J.F. Jones, J.J. Edwards and J.F. Womble. Their first meeting was held February 17, 1908.
