I also have been unable to find her in the 1900 Census (and of course that darn 1890 census!).
I have a Book of Remembrance in my possession from my great grandfather (son in law of Henry Thomas Lawrence) that lists has Haywood Lawrence married to Elizabeth Upchurch and Hoywood's father being named William Haywood Lawrence. But Gayle is right, we haven't been able to find anything on his family besides the marriage record and this book I have.

I have also been wondering about the Mimms. It seems that the husband of Elizabeth Mimms served in the same Civil War Company as Haywood Lawrence, Company G 48th Regiment. But I guess this only proves that they were neighbors at the time of the formation of the company. Turns out I am related to the Mimms, but through my grandmother's father, rather than her mother. They may have some sort of family relationship, that I haven't seen yet

# McIver in command of her future, goals

When she was attending classes at East Wake High School, Megen McIver of Zebulon wasn't quite sure what she wanted to do with her life.

She knew she wanted to do "something with medicine" ophthalmologist or pharmacist, maybe even a doctor.
Then one day, her eyes caught a glimpse of a brochure - join the Navy, become a nurse, have your college education paid for. "I thought it would be fun, so I went for it," she said.

It was a "shot in the dark." There were never any pressures from her family or friends to "be a nurse" or "join the service." This was her own idea.

Now, $2^{1 / 2}$ years later, after gradrating from EWHS in 1992, she has no regrets. A junior at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, she spends much of
her time in either nurse white or Navy blues.

Not only is she taking her ROTC duties seriously, they're taking her seriously, too. This past summer, she served as commonder for a platoon of 20 Navy midshipmen. She was the big boss. When she spoke, they listened.

Her responsibility was "being in charge of the platoon," she explained. It's the commander's duty to "make everything happen." Being in charge meant leading the midshipmen in drills and getting them ready for inspection, as well as anything else she felt needed to be done.

She enjoyed her semester as commander. She could have turned it down, but being in ROTC means responsibility, "and most people want the responsibilty."
This semester, she will not be able to take part in drills because of a scheduling conflict with a nursing class. She will still lead the color guard and be active in the unit, "but I can't do drill and I can't hold a bibllet (job)," said Ms. McIver.
Nursing class duties keep her busy as well. Last semester, she worked at Duke Hospital Megan Mclver in the med-surge
(post-surgery) unit. This sementer, she'll be working with pediatrics at UNC's hospital.
One would think her plate is full with both nursing and ROTC requirements, but Ms. McIver does have other interests. At one time, she was a member of the pistol team, competing in different contests at colleges across the
country. That has since fallen by the wayside, to her regret, because the college's shooting
range "is out of commission."
As a requirement of her scholarship, once she graduates, she'll be stationed and begin her tour of duty at one of four naval hospitals - San Diego, Calif.; Pensacola, Fla.; Bethesda, Md.; or Portsmouth, Va. She has hopes of also being sent to Japan for training.

Ms. McIver is unsure if she's going to make the Navy her career. "I'd be glad to stay in though. The pay is good."

All she knows now is that she "loves nursing" and she "loves the ROTC" - which is "like being in a big fraternity." She feels that with the ROTC, she has made friends for life.

At the time of graduation, Ms. McIver will have the rank of ensign, equivalent to that of second lieutenant in the Army.

Raised in Zebulon, she is the daughter of Penny McIver and Jim McIver. Her only sibling, Grey, is beginning a career in the service also, but not the Navy - he's going to be an Army man.

She said she likes to return home, but it's often "hard to find the time." And it's easy to see why.
