Navy Seaman Apprentice Michael C. McClain, a 1993 graduate of Apex High School, recently participated in the eighth annual Fleet Week celebration in New York City on board the amphibious assault ship USS Nassau homeported in Norfolk, Va.

McClain was one of more than 6,000 sailors and Marines from the several Atlantic Fleet ships who joined for this international naval review and celebration, which included diplomatic, ceremonial, memorial and recreational events. The week began with a parade of ships past the Statue of Liberty. This year's Fleet Week honored the nation's maritime forces, and commemorated the contributions and sacrifices of World War II veterans.

McClain just completed a six-month deployment to the Mediterranean and Adriatic seas supporting the international efforts off Bosnia. During the 25,000-mile voyage, McClain spent more than 110 days at sea.

He joined the Navy in December 1993.

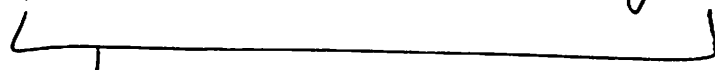

## Robert (Robin) Chamblee

### Little River District, Bertie and Wake Counties, North Carolina

Robert was probably born ca. 1738. His first land transaction was in 1759 in Bertie Co, Nc. Robert most likely married Esther Warren, daughter of Benjamin Warren, Sr.. of Bertie County, NC. There is one single reference to Robert and Hester (Esther) Chamblee together in court records. Esther Chamblee is listed as a member of the Poplar Springs Baptist Church in Franklin Co, NC. In 1744, Bertie Co, NC, Benjamin Warren proved his rights and listed his wife, Esther and others: James, Benjamin, Margaret, Mary Patience, William and Esther Warren.



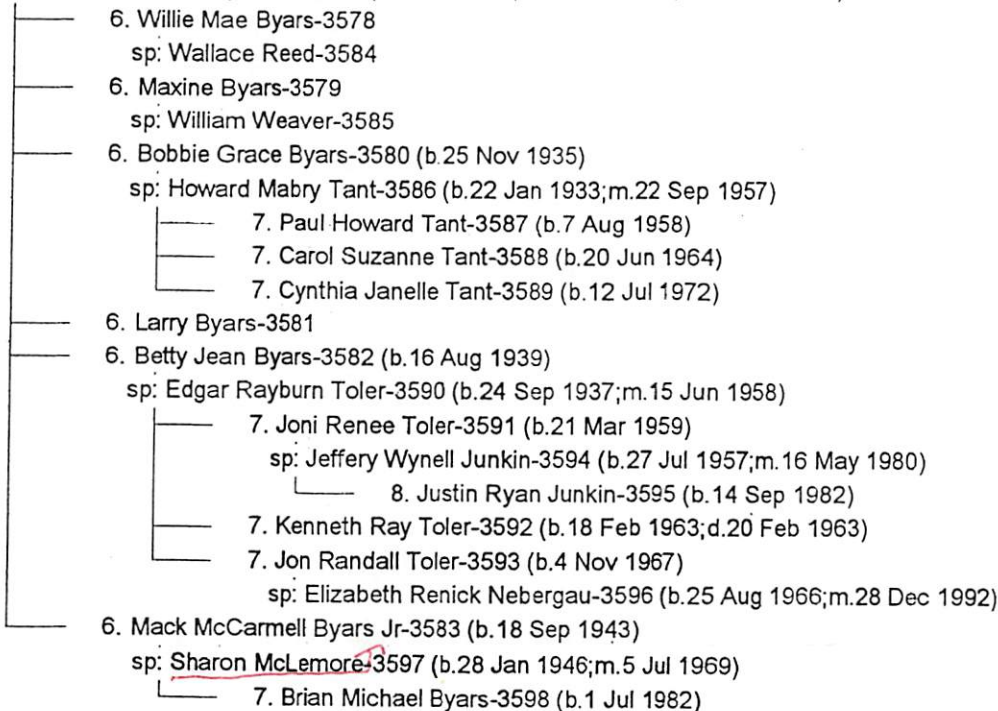

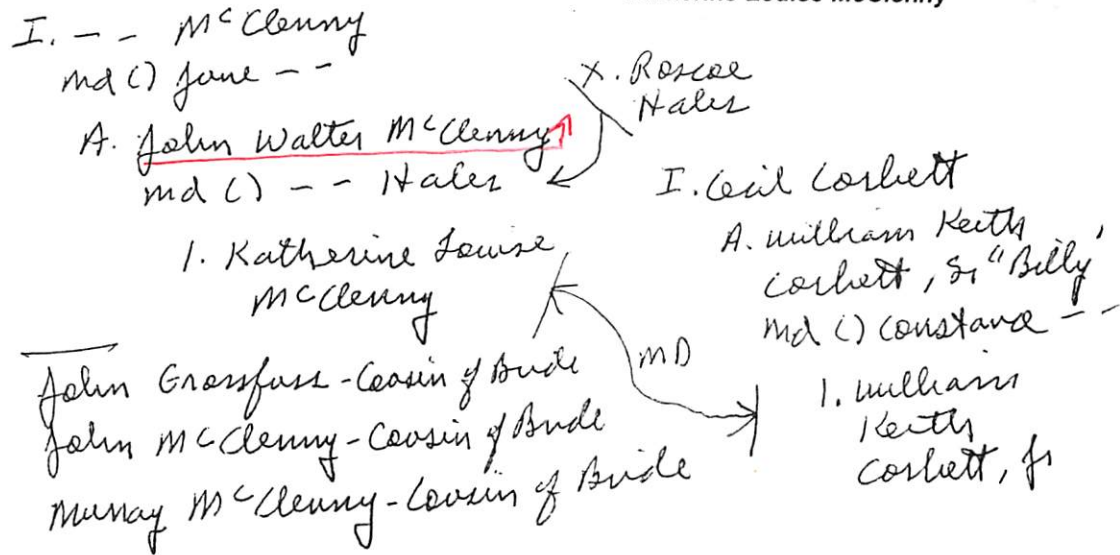
