A Wake County Cattle Club, organized in 1885, began hosting an annual spring Cattle Show in the capital city where hundreds of animals—mostly Jerseys, plus a few Devons, Guernseys, Holsteins, and Ayrshires—were on display. Participants in 1886 included W. C. McMackin, William B. Grimes, W. G. Upchurch, T. B. Bridgers, B. P. Williamson, W. C. Stronach, Capt. J. B. Burwell, Dr. James McKee, Maj. R. S. Tucker, M. T. H. Murray, Dr. Richard H. Lewis, R. B. Raney, and Dr. Henry M. Tupper, all of Raleigh Township; and Maj. John M. Crenshaw of Forestville. While organizers continued calling their event the "Cattle Show," they later added horses. The 1890 show, held at McMackin's pavilion stables on Morgan Street, began with all the animals parading down Raleigh's Fayetteville Street, led by Stanley's Brass Band. The main features were a butter display and an auction of both cattle and horses.⁷³

Raleigh plays a key role in this lawyer's life

RALEIGH
Playwright Ian Finley has been burrowing into Raleigh's history for several years now, unearthing stories from graveyards to by-gone boulevards. His latest excavation taps into the mother lode of its legal community.

"Seventy Years on Salisbury Street: Scenes From the Life of a Raleigh Lawyer (Or It's a Grand Night for Singing)" is the ornate title of a short-run drama about Robert McMillan, often called the dean of Wake County's criminal defense bar.

"He almost single-handedly changed the perception of the practice of criminal law from a rather tawdry profession, in some ways considered just a step above criminals, to make it clear that the criminal lawyer - both prosecution and defense - is the guardian of the rule of law," Finley said.

The play, which will be staged twice as a fundraiser for Burning Coal Theatre

Company, has a cast of 10-six of whom play McMillan at various stages in his life. "It's a remembrance of his life and the development of the city of Raleigh," Finley said.

McMillan worked for his father right out of law school, served in the Marines in World War II and in Korea, became solicitor for the city of Raleigh, and started

his own practice in the 1950s.

Finley said in many ways McMillan is the picture of a Southern gentleman but without a trace of aloofness. And, he said, McMillan, 86, is a grand storyteller in his own right.

"I knew the play would be a theatrical success when I interviewed him along with [lawyers] Wade and Roger Smith, who he helped men-

We had a cordial 15 minute chat and he invited me to call or visit at any time.. Robert A reports that Vaughan Ray was a good friend of his father. Robert knew Mark Ray well.
