"Herbert Edward Newbolds (son of William Newbolds and Lola Jane) was born May 07, 1920 in Marion, Illinois/Marion. Williamson Co., IL, and died August 19, 1982 in East Chicago, Indiana. He married Betty Ludean McTosh on September 24, 1946 in Marion, Illinois, daughter of Austin Bud McTosh and Mary Bell Johnson.

He went into service during WWII and served his country for four years. He didn't rise through the ranks, but did make PFC. I have his Army separation record on file. He had a kidney infection and he was discharged from the Mayo General Hospital in Galesburg, Illinois on July 20, 1946. The disease also affected one eye. \* He was awarded the European Theatre of Operations Medal with 4 battle stars, Good Conduct Medal, Combat Infantryman's Badge, American Theatre Medal, and World War II Victory Medal. At the time of entry he was living in Marion, Illinois. He married grandma in September of the year he was dischaged. I am assuming the were seeing each other before he enlisted. There is a rumor that grandpa had an affair with an un-named woman in Germany and together they had a daughter. He only had an 8th grade education which wasn't uncommon in those days. He owned and operated his own trucking business prior to entry into service. He kept his own books and made contacts himself. He employed 3 of his brothers and supervised thier work. He owned four 1-1/2 ton trucks that carried up to six ton loads.

\*In the family bible it is recorded that grandpa was a sharpshooter and did his basic training in Fort Bening, GA/NC and Stone(?), FL. He was born, lived and married in Marion, Williamson County, IL. He died in Hammond, IN. When I was little he and grandma lived in Whiting, IL.

I have also managed to find his social security number. It is 360-16-8876."
