2. Jesse² Bunn (John Burn¹ (Bunn)) was born Abt. 1760, and died 1816 in Wake Co., NC⁴. He married (1) Unknown. was born⁵. He married (2) Levinia Walker 06 Nov 1813 in Wake co, NC, USA⁶. She was born⁷, and died 1825 in Wake Co, NC.

Notes for Jesse Bunn:

Jesse Bunn served in the Revolutionary War (page 1023, Vol 16, State Records of North Carolina). He enlisted in 1782 for a period of 18 months and was a Private in Raiford's Co 19th Regiment of NC Continental Lines Abraham Shepard, Col), He was discharged from service in 1783. Jesse owned in excess of 1000 acres of land in Wake and Franklin Counties of North Carolina. Most of his property lay along the Moccasin Creek that divided those counties.

Children of Jesse Bunn and Unknown are:

i. Alfred Walker³ Bunn, married Rebeckah Medlin, 28 Feb 1826, Wake Co, NC, USA.

Notes for Alfred Walker Bunn:

After the death of his mother Alfred received 220 acres of land (page 69, Record Book 7, Wake Co, NC) in Wake Co, NC, that his father had left to his mother at his death. That property was located where Spring Branch joined Moccasin Creek in Wake County. In addition, Alfred received 31 more acres in that same area that was his share of what his brother Jesse Walker Bunn would have received from his mother had he been living at the time of the division.

ii. Delilah Bunn, died 22 Sep 1868, Green Co, AL

iii. Elizabeth Bunn, born about 1795; died Marshall Co, MS

iv. Green Walker Bunn, born 1788, Wake Co, NC; died Oct 1851, Franklin Co, NC

v. Jesse Walker Bunn, born about 1799, Wake Co, NC; died between 1818 – 1825

Notes for Jesse Walker Bunn:

Jesse Walker Bunn served in the War of 1812. His military records indicate that he was only 15 years old when he was enlisted into the 43rd US Infantry in North Carolina by Lieut Combs for a period of 5 years on April 18, 1814. The records further indicate that he had blue eyes, light hair, and a fair complexion and that he was born in Wake County, NC. While on duty, Jesse was at Camp Federal Point, Camp Greenfield and was confined at Fort Hampton for desertion. Last entry indicates that he was “learning music”. This documentation can be found at the Olivia Raney Library, Raleigh, NC on micro film #233 titled US Army Register of Enlistments 1798 – May 17, 1815, Vol 3, Page 93.

Jesse Walker Bunn acquired land in Wake County, NC, from John Hopkins on 13 Jan 1818. However, he did not live long enough to received land from his father who had left 850 acres (page 384, Record Book 12, Wake Co, NC) to his wife Levinia that was to be divided among his children at her death. Apparently, Jesse Walker Bunn died prior to 1826 since in the division of that land in 1826 after the death of Levinia (Page 69, Record Book 7, Wake co, NC) his share was divided among his surviving siblings.

vi. Gilly Bunn, born about 1800, NC10.

Notes for Gilly Bunn:

Williford Upchurch [son of James Upchurch, VII & grandson of Richard Upchurch, III] was to appear before the Justices of Franklin County, NC, Court of Pleas and Quarter Session to be held in Wake County, NC, in November of 1820 to answer a charge of Bastardy, committed on the body of Gilly Bunn. The 1850 Census for Franklin Co, NC, indicates that Polly Bunn, 14, was living in the household with Gilly. The 1870 census for Franklin co, NC, indicates that Ann Medlin was living in the household with Gilly Bunn at the time of survey.

Note: As of 17 Aug 2002, I find no reason to object to the above five children being of the first marriage of Stephen Upchurch. He had time to produce five prior to his second marriage Mar 1841. He is on 1830 Census Franklin Co, NC, head of a seven-member household, only one of which is less than five years old (a male) and thus possibly his son (tentatively Benjamin Upchurch). I cannot find Stephen Upchurch on the 1840 census in Wake or Franklin Cos, NC or otherwise; hence his first marriage could have been dissolved by 1840 and his children "distributed". In fact in 1850 child #5 Charlotte Upchurch is in a home headed by her grandmother Charlotte Upchurch [nee Pearce]. In 1860 Child #4 Lucinda Upchurch is age 23 (born about 1837) and in home of her father Stephen Upchurch and his second wife. [DS reports Lucinda age 25 on 1850 with father which is correct.] – RPU

Robert (Robin) Chamblee

Little River District, Bertie and Wake Counties, NC

Robert was probably born circa 1738. His first land transaction was in 1759 in Bertie Co, NC.

Robert most likely married Esther Warren, daughter of Benjamin Warren, Sr., of Bertie Co, NC.

There is one single reference to Robert and Hester (Esther) Chamblee together in court records.

Esther Chamblee is listed as a member of the Poplar Springs Baptist Church in Franklin Co, NC.

In 1744, Bertie Co, NC, Benjamin Warren proved his rights and listed his wife, Esther and others: James, Benjamin, Margaret, Mary Patience, William, and Esther Warren.
