

A chancery court Loose Court record states the following:

Gillum Upchurch died intestate, in Jackson County, Tennessee. A lawsuit, H.R, Upchurch vs. Byrd Anderson etal. It involved land he owned in District #11, Buffalo Hollow, Flynn's Lick in Jackson Co. Gillum's first wife Sarah Anderson, daughter of Caleb Anderson, inherited the land.

A deposition of Gillum Upchurch made before his death stated "I am the reputed father of two children each by different women" He stated his brother was Thomas Upchurch, father of T.B. Upchurch; stated his wife Sarah died when their 3rd child was born and it lived 15 days; that their son H. Ross Upchurch was age 2 and Carter Upchurch was age 4 when their mother died.

A deposition by Asia Jackson states 'H.R. Upchurch and John M. Upchurch are my uncles and Gillum Upchurch my grandfather.
