Nathan Upchurch I and his brother Moses Upchurch married and started their families in Franklin Co. NC about 1802. Both moved to the area near present day Apex, NC. Nathan

Dear Debbie,

Thanks for your letter of November 2, 2006 and for the gift of Thomas Howell Upchurch. Such items are always appreciated. He does indeed belong to my Wake County, NC relatives.

We were in Raleigh the last two weeks in October and I had intended to call you. We ran out of time. It is always this way. I have already made a list for our next trip and so far it has 57 things on it to do - not in order of priority. Calling/Visiting you is number 23 on the list. Our next trip will most likely be next spring.

I am pleased to know that Upchurch Family members continue to visit the UPCHURCH home you maintain so well. I will be happy to hear from them at any time. We will soon have EMAIL which will make it easier to interact with cousins, cooperators, and friends.

one of the reasons my trips to NC have become so crowded with activity is that my work on uncovering the history of that part of Wake County in which I grew up has become a major project. It is developing into what will be a history of Rhamkhatt - its People and Times. This has involved getting & processing hundreds of deeds, death certificates, cemetery recordings and numerous interviews. Thus I am headed to be one of Wake Counties Local Historians.

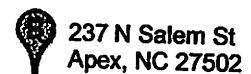

① Raleigh, NC - "The Reverend Thomas Meredith, who founded the Baptist Interpreter in Edenton in 1832 and changed its title to the Biblical Recorder in 1834, moved in 1838 to Raleigh - where the Biblical Recorder is still published. (37, pg 35).

THOMAS MEREDITH

① The Baptist Seminary was founded in Raleigh, NC in 1859 at Blount & Edenton Streets. In 1905 it became Baptist University for Women and in 1909 trustees renamed it Meredith College to honor Baptist leader Thomas Meredith. He had urged such a seminary in 1838. (37, Pg 84)
