Commentary: Merrill Olive (1818 – 1883) lived his entire life in Wake County, NC. He married Martha Jane Upchurch in 1855. This union would produce five children. Martha Jane was the daughter of Tabitha Upchurch and the granddaughter of Nathan, head of Upchurch Clan #3.

- 214 Merrill Olive b. June 23, 1816 d. Oct. 21, 1883 (his death date on his tombstone is July 21, 1883). This is the Merrill Olive said to be a first cousin to Cader Olive which would make Cader's father, James Olive, a brother to William, Jr. Merrell's wife was Martha Jane Upchurch, b. 10-28-1820, d. 1-12-1892. Both are buried in Olive Chapel Cemetery in Wake County. Also buried here is Martha, dau. of above, wife of I. S. Barbee, b. 11-8-1860, d. 8-27-1914.
- 1829 and 1831 Howell paid taxes for Merrell on 200 acres in White Oak District.
- 1832 Merrell is listed as orphan of Wm. Olive along with Polly and Betsey. Merrell was only 16 years old then.
- 1837 Merrell paid his own taxes on 200 acres in White Oak.
- 1839 and 1840 Merrell paid his taxes on 200 acres and also paid taxes for Elizabeth Olive on 276 acres in same dist. These were evidently his mother's taxes.
- 1841 Merrell paid taxes on 396 acres in White Oak.
- 1850 Census lists Merrell as 34, farming and living with him are Elizabeth Olive 65 and Clarinda Olive 21. We do not place Clarinda unless the census age is wrong because his sister, Clary was married in 1820. Of course, census ages are often wrong and this could be his sister, perhaps a widow. Her married name was Wilson but the census taker could have misunderstood that.
- 1860 Census for Wake Co. lists Maril 44, farming, Jane 39, William 4, James 2, Tabitha 1 and Elizabeth 75.
- 1880 Census lists him Merrill 65, farmer, All family born in North Carolina. Martha J. 59, Wm. S. 22, Talby E. 21, Martha J. 19 and F. D. (dau.) 18.
- 2141 James H. Olive b. 1-25-1856, d. 5-6-1910 m. Georgetta F. Johnson b. 1-9-1853, d. 2-29-1892—dates from their tombstones. He was a farmer.
- 1880 census lists him as 24, farmer, all family born in North Carolina, Georgetta F. 28, wife; Percy W. 1, son (born in October) and Joseph Johnson 26, brother-in-law living with them.

- 2143 Tabitha Olive m. Mr. Page, has one child. She was living with her parents in 1880—listed in census as Talby E. 21.
- 2144 Martha Olive b. 11-8-1860 d. 8-27-1914 m. I. S. Barbee, has no children. Living at home in 1880—listed as Martha J. 19. Mrs. Grace Lane wrote "Aunt Dee had two children. She died the year I was born so must have been older than Tabby and Martha." She may have just died younger than her sisters.
- 2145 F. Diana Olive (Aunt Dee) m. Mr. Lawrence. Her death notice is in the Biblical Recorder for Oct. 21, 1896, lists her as Mrs. F. Diana (Olive) Lawrence. She is in the 1880 census as F. D., 18. Mrs. Lawrence had two children. Is one of them Mrs. Clara Goodwin who was born a Lawrence?
