# George Mincey remains one step ahead of the competition

The smell of leather greets you as you enter George Mincey's shoe repair shop at 124 Gannon Ave. in Zebulon.

The hum of his old sewing machine, a sound that has been music to him since he was 13, gets a little louder with age.

The first thing most customers notice is the number of shoes stacked all around his work area. One wonders how he keeps them all matched and knows whose shoes are whose.

"I know people by their feet instead of by their name," Mincey said, pulling nails out of the sole of a man's black dress shoe. "When I go out, I look at people's feet. My wife really fusses at that."

Mincey has recently relocated his shoe repair business from Wendell to Zebulon, a move that continues a family tradition.

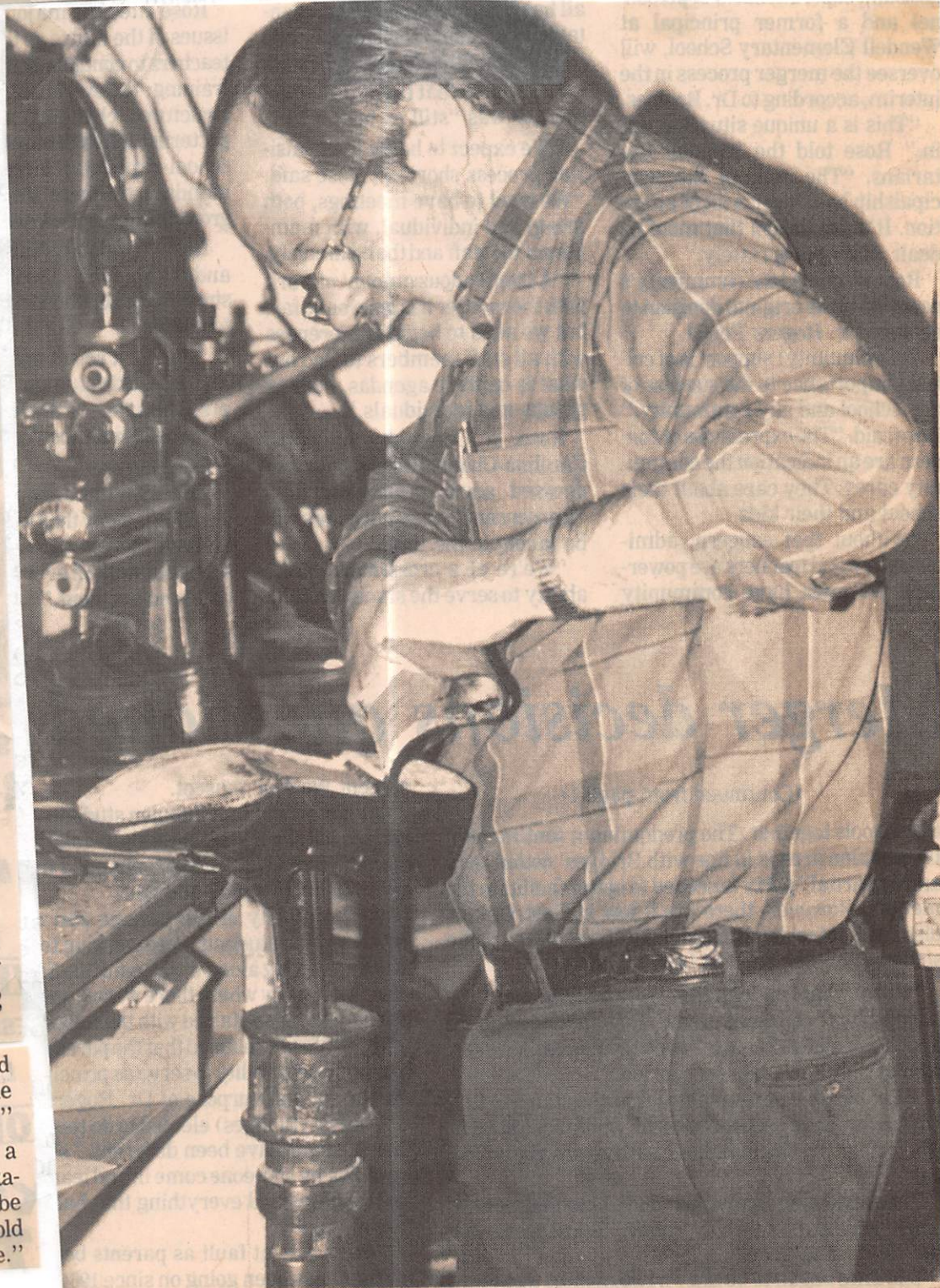
Mincey's Shoe Shop was first established in Zebulon in 1958 when his father, Milton Mincey, purchased the shop and equipment from Marion Horton.

"I learned the trade from my father," Mincey said. "They say that I am a lot like him."

In another time, Mincey would have been labeled a cobbler. "I loved it from day one," he explained. "... in my father's shop, I did a lot of what I like to call 'bad'

jobs like pulling out the nails and ripping off the soles. I didn't like a whole lot of that type of thing."

But when young George took a job with Pine State Creamery in Raleigh, he knew that he wouldn't be happy. "This is not for me," he told himself. "Shoe repair is for me."

## Side stepping

George Mincey carefully cuts away the sole from the bottom of a man's dress shoe. Shoe repair has been a part of his life since he was 13 and began working in his father's shoe shop.

He started his own repair business in Wendell in 1966. He worked from there for 22 years before deciding to relocate back to Zebulon.

Through the years, the competition in Wendell had increased whereas the competition in Zebulon had disappeared.

"My father got sick and retired," George related. "Then everyone sold out or moved out of Zebulon." Milton Mincey passed away about a year ago.

There are two other repair shops currently in Wendell. "There is too much work and not enough money," he added.

"Ever since daddy went out of business, I've always wanted to come back to Zebulon," he said.

"But I couldn't take another man's business. I couldn't treat another man that way."

Mincey waited until the competition in Zebulon was gone.

On this particular afternoon, Mincey was altering a leather vest for a customer and looking over a saddle sitting just in front of his sewing machine.

"I repair all kinds of leather goods," he said, pointing out several projects in progress among the pieces of shoes surrounding him. "You go into any shoe store and it is going to be a mess where you do all your work. I haven't had time to clean up yet today."

Mincey explained that he doesn't have an average customer as a women walked in to retrieve her shoes. "I've got all ages," he said, taking off the bifocals he now has to wear with hands covered with shoe polish. "There are a lot of people who can't find shoes to fit."

Besides repair work, Mincey sells new and used shoes, boots and takes special orders. "I have to special order one man's shoes because they

don't make a size big enough for him," Mincey said. None of his work, though, is custom made. "It's too expensive when you have to hand-make them.

"I'm hoping that all of my good customers in Wendell will continue to come here to do business," he added. "I really want people to come and see me. My store in Wendell was getting mighty crowded."

His decision to relocate to Zebulon was not one he made in haste. "It wasn't something I decided to do overnight," he said. "I even broke out in hives over it."

With the support of his wife, Peggy, and his two children, 26-year-old Barney and 20-year-old

Judy, he decided to make the move.

As he sat down in front of the sewing machine to finish putting a new zipper in a boot, Mincey explained that, for the most part, he has always worked solo. "I know mama helped daddy some," he said. "But I prefer to do it myself. I like to fix people's shoes like they were mine. No one could ever do it that way."

When he first started, he did have a young boy help him out for a while. "This boy came into my shop one day and was wearing a pair of tennis shoes with a lot of holes in them," Mincey said. "It was snowing at the time and I felt sorry for him. I gave him a pair of shoes and he said he

wanted to help in the shop to pay for them.

"That was the only good (helper) I ever had. He still comes in to see me when he is in town," he said.

Mincey explained that people don't realize that they get what they pay for when it comes to buying good, quality shoes. "The heels and the soles are what wear," he said. "If you pay good money for a leather shoe, you'll just get them broke in when they'll need resoled."

As long as the upper part of the shoe stays in good shape, the shoes can be reheeled and resoled several times, he added.

And that is what will keep George Mincey working and on his feet.
