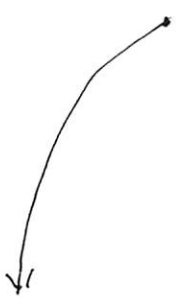

Although this is the earliest surviving record of our Ray ancestors owning property in Wake Cty, NC, there were probably earlier deeds that were destroyed y the 1832 fire in the Register's office. The 1781 Wake County Tax list (Captain Robert High's District) shows Luke Rake Ray as the owner of 100 acres, 4 hours and 12 cattle valued at 116 pds. On March 4, 1783, Luke acquired by grant 158 acres on the north side of the Neuse River. On November 16, 1791 by State Grant #1103 Luke Ray acquired 150 acres on the north side of the Neuse River and on both sides of Horse Creek adjacent to Stafford's Corner, Cedar Hill anda small path. Your email of 16 JUN 07 12:05 PM refers to ALBERT HAYS RAY (Actually ALBERT HAYWOOD RAY). He is covered on the above referenced Master Outline.

Your email of 16 JUN 07 12:59 PM treats the family of BURNELL RAY (I carry him as BURWELL J. RAY - See Child #3 of James & Gilly). I reformatted (manually) your email so as to get all 3 pages on one sheet. It is enclosed as Sheet A. I worked with this before finding out that some of it is wrong. Robert K. Ray and his family do not belong here. This family actually belongs to ROBERT IVERSON RAY who is not a son of Burnell (Burwell) Ray but rather a son of Buchner Ray. On sheet (A) you list a child W^m B. RAY as a son of Burnell/Burwell and I elsewhere show the same [see pg 2 on master outline]. However, you have a birth date of 1853 whereas I have 1857. I suspect the two are not the same - but it would be nice to know for sure.

We still don't have the children of Burwell J. Ray quite right and I would be happy to interact to get this straight if anyone has interest.

Your email of 16 JUN 07 1:22 PM asks if I have contacted the lady in Texas yet. The answer is "Not that I know of". Is she the Mrs Margaret E. Herney in Footnote 3? I would be happy to contact her. The data listed looks like mine. I

Could not open the 3 attachments provided with this email.

I acknowledge receipt of your email of 16 JUN 2007 5:25 PM which provided 14 pages of RAY marriage from MD, NC and VA. I have placed this in my Marriage File for future reference. I'm scanning this & note several marriages for individuals who are familiar to me. I am sure the list will come in handy along the way.

It seems we do have interest on an ongoing basis although my other projects leave me quite limited time to spend on my RAY heritage. However, a little bit of detail going back and forth can be helpful. It would be of interest to me to have a sketch of your line back to the NC Rays. This might help to suggest some fact or circumstance that would be of mutual interest.

You report that Luke Ray had a son James Ray b 1785 who married Gilly Upshurds. For years I have collected and organized data on James & Gilly and can share that with you if you desire. I am quite interested in getting more details on this couple and their descendants if you or others would like to collaborate in this undertaking. However, I doubt this work will shed much light on linking together the generations that preceded James Ray b 1785. [Incidentally, you have his death date as 1819 which has to be wrong]

Although my records on James & Gilly are much more complete than what you sent, I still found some "new" stuff in what you sent for them. Some of the new stuff seems OK and some not.

You show several children of BURWELL J. RAY (son of James b 1785) and I have validated most of them which were new to me. However, the child named William M. Ray b 1853 seems to be the wrong William. I have him as William B. Ray b 1857, which I believe to be correct.

For Thomas Ray b 1839 (son of James b 1785) you show a marriage and children I cannot validate. He married Martha A. Stallige and I find them as the 1870 and 1880 NC Census without any children.

My records for James & Gilly and their

descendants are far from complete and I am sure some errors have crept into my Master Outline. We have more work to do here.

On my recent trip to NC I happened to visit Franklin Co, NC and just happened to get involved with discoveries that pertained to the siblings of Gilly Upchurch - especially her sister Elizabeth Thane Upchurch and her brothers Jamison Upchurch and Kearney Upchurch as well as their parents ~~John~~ James Upchurch, III 1775-1845 and nee Elizabeth Thane Butler. I assume you have no reason to be interested in these discoveries or it takes one away from RAY connections. However, as I continue to explore the Upchurch families in Franklin Co, NC for the 1750-1850 era it is likely that more RAY reference will surface. I will be alert to see if any of these trace back to Luke Ray b 1760.


In looking over my RAY files I encountered an odd RAY reference that involved Orange Co, NC. It was in the St Louis County Library. I have enclosed a copy in case it helps you with the Rays of the 1700's

If you have proof that James Ray b 1785 was in fact the son of Luke Ray b 1760, I would find it very useful for my files. I wonder if there is proof that Luke ever lived in Franklin Co, NC. We know that James lived there.

As a final point - I have a series of books on estates, wills, deeds, etc of Franklin Co, NC for the 1800's and before. It has been a while since I have put these to use. If you think it useful I would be happy to add to my "to do" list a project to go over these books to see if they have information on RAY families that would place them in Franklin Co, NC in 1850 or before.

You asked about 3 Upchurches-Moses, Charles, and Richard. Here is a sketch.

Richard U,II [Abt1725-Abt1798] was the first Upchurch to arrive in what is now Franklin Co. His 11 children are the ancestors of about 1/2 of all of the Upchurch Family in America post Revolution. He arrived about 1755 in Franklin Co. His sons included Nathan[my GGGF], Moses, Charles, and Richard,III[Abt1750-1817] When the name Richard Upchurch is mentioned, as in your email, one has to use ages or some other factor to know whether the reference is to II or III. Often it is impossible to know which one was involved as both were very active in Franklin Co in the period 1775-1798.

Charles named a son Thomas Gay Upchurch so we think that Charles may have married a Gay but that is not proven.

Richard Upchurch,III had a son James Upchurch,VII who had a daughter Gilly Upchurch who married James Ray [1785-after1860]. I am unclear if James was the son of Daniel Ray or of Luke Ray and seem to have it both ways in my records. Perhaps you can clarify.

I think it is a given that James and Gilly started out in Franklin Co but their married life seemed to unfold in Wake Co.-- I suspect in Little River Township just next door. Phil Upchurch

Page 7 On July 20, 1763, Timothy Ryal Medlin sold to William Cade 100 acres on the north side of the Little River in Johnston County.

In 1763, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) was included on a list of insolvents in Granville County.

In 1764, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) (Madlen) (Meddelon), planter from Bute County, sold 100 acres of land to John Franklin on north side of Crooked Creek in Bute County adjoining William Maynard and Julius Alford, witnessed by William Maynard, James Bolton, and Julius Alford.

Bute County, which bordered Virginia, was formed from Granville County in 1764 and was named after John Stewart, Earl of Bute, who was the first Lord of Treasury under King George III. Bute County occupied the part of Granville County formerly known as St. John's Parish. The Medlin families slowly migrated from southeastern Bute (later Franklin) County down into the heartland of North Carolina.

On August 15, 1764, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) purchased 100 acres of land in Johnston County on the south side of Moccasin (Mockerson) Creek.

In 1766, William Owen Medlin (Sr.), Joseph Medlin, Timothy Ryal Medlin, and William (Owen) Medlin (Jr.) were listed as taxpayers in Bute County.

On April 25, 1767, John Medlin (Madlens) received a land grant from Governor William Tryon for 100 acres on Rich Land Creek, joining Joseph Dunn, Weirs line, and Henry Atkinson in the section of old Cumberland County that was later partitioned off in 1784 as Moore County.

Page 8 On February 15, 1768, Timothy Ryal (Royal) Medlin, planter from Bute County, sold 100 acres of land to Andrew (Drury) Cade in Johnston County on the north side of the Little River and a fork of Julises Branch, adjacent to land owned by Drewry Cade, witnessed by James Batten and Joshua Mize. ↑

On June 3, 1768, in Bute County, 380 acres were sold to John Young at the sale of the estate of John Medlin (Modglin), deceased, held by Julius Nichols, late sheriff, as recorded in August 1768 court by deputy sheriff William Moore. Joseph Wright was listed among the buyers.

On February 6, 1769, William Owen (Oen) Medlin (Meddelen), planter in Johnston County, sold 100 acres on the south side of Moccasin Creek adjacent to Elisha Strickland in Johnston County to Demsey Sumner, witnessed by James Bolton, Julius Johnson and Drury Cade.

In February 1769 in Johnston County Court, William Owen (Oen) Medlin proved a deed from Sampson Bracwell and Christian Bracwell to Pettipool Massey. Needham Bryan was present and was appointed a justice for Johnston County by commission from the governor.

On March 10, 1769, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) bought 177 acres of land in Bute County on the south side of Crooked Creek from Julius Johnson, witnessed by James Alford, Robert Chamblee, and James Strickland.

On March 20, 1769, John Medlin sold to Joseph Dunn the 100 acres of land granted on Richland Creek in old Cumberland County (later Moore County).

On February 9, 1748, Richard Medlin, Jr. is listed as a chain carrier with William Cade on a survey of land deeded on April 30, 1753 to Lodowick Alford for 600 acres on north side of Little Creek in Granville County and Johnston County.

On July 19, 1750 in Chowan County Court in Edenton, Timothy Ryal (Royal) Medlin, orphan aged 15 years, was ordered bound to apprenticeship until age 21 under James Flood.

On October 6, 1750, the will of James Douglas was witnessed in Bertie County by Joseph Medlin.

Around 1750, part of the Richard Medlin ^[SA] family must have migrated northwesterly and returned back into Virginia for a few years before returning southwesterly to North Carolina again. This cycle of crossing the border must have been repeated more than once as the Medlins slowly migrated westerly.

On October 8, 1754, Joseph Medlin and John Medlin (misspelled Meldey) were included on a muster roll of the North Carolina Militia Regiment in Granville County, North Carolina, under the command of Colonel William Eaton. Joseph Medlin was enlisted in Captain Osborn Jeffreys' Company along with his neighbors William Maynard, Julius Alford, James Bolton, and William Cade. John Medlin was enlisted in Captain Benjamin Simm's Company along with neighbor Lodowick Alford. The house built in 1770 by Osborne Jeffreys, the first sheriff of Franklin County in 1779, is still a current well-known landmark in the southern part of modern Franklin County, between Crooked Creek and Little River, just above the Wake County line.

On May 2, 1760, Joseph Medlin of Johnston County deeded to Timothy Ryal Medlin (Timothy Royal Medford) a feather bed for love and affection. Johnston County was formed in 1746 from Craven County.

Pg 7 On June 7, 1762, Patrick Medlin was listed as a sworn chain carrier on a survey of land in Orange County on both sides of Wolf Island Creek deeded on December 24, 1762 to Mark London. Orange County was formed in 1752 from Johnston, Granville and Bladen Counties.

On January 15, 1763, in Johnston County, Joshua Mize sold 100 acres on the north side of the Little River to Timothy Ryal Medlin, witnessed by Joel Medlin (Medford) and William Anderson Fowler.

On January 15, 1763, in Granville County, William Owen (Oen) Medlin (Sr.) witnessed a deed of William Wilder of Johnston County to Nathaniel Carter.

William Owen Medlin, (Sr.) migrated over a large territory in eastern North Carolina and Virginia. William Owen Medlin (Sr.) and his wife, Rebecca Wilson, were believed to have had four sons: William Owen Medlin (Jr.) born around 1745, Bryant Medlin, Sr. born around 1748, Shadrach Medlin born in 1749, and James Wilson Medlin, born around 1750.

On January 24, 1763, William Owen Medlin (Sr.) of Granville County purchased, from William Wilder of Johnston County, 100 acres of land in Granville County on the north side of Flat Rock Creek adjacent to William Maynard (Mainer), witnessed by William Maynard and Nathaniel Carter.
