DETAILS RE CO "I"

MONTGOMERY, Eli Private

Born in Chatham County and was by occupation a
mechanic prior to enlisting in Wake County at age
30, 28 May 1861, for the war. Discharged at
Petersburg, Virginia, 5 July 1862, by reason of
"cardiac disease" and/or "depressed fracture of the
cranium."

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was
from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in
Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp
of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington),
Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to
this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I.
After joining the regiment, the company functioned as
a part of the regiment, and its history for the war
period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

The information contained in the following roster of
the company was compiled principally from company
muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864,
and 15 September through December 1864. No
company muster rolls were found for the period prior
to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September
1864; or for the period after December 1864. In
addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor
records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war
records, and other primary records, supplemented by
state pension applications, United Daughters of the
Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and
histories, all provided useful information.

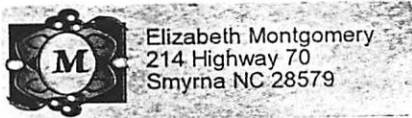

Norris House built about 1840 at present 100 SOUTH ELM ST. in APEX, NC by J. M.C. ELLINGTON who started a large lumber business. The Railroad came in Civil War

J. A. Norris moved from the Fugway, NC Area to Apex in NOV 1880 as a better base for his lumber & turpentine business. He bought Ellington house & added a tower. The wife of J. A. Apex native is noted author

Julia Lilly Montgomery Street, 88, is an award-winning author of children's books who grew up in Apex in the days when the town was little more than a railroad depot, a main street and a bundle of houses.

Mrs. Street moved to Apex when she was 18 months old.

Her father, Dr. Samuel Lewis Montgomery, died suddenly in Apex on a family visit; so her mother, Elizabeth Norris Montgomery, moved to Cary from Concord and kept a boarding house to support her older children, Bays and Amy.

Mrs. Street's aunts Stella, Maude and Maybelle Norris wanted to keep Mrs. Street - the baby - to raise.

Julia grew up with the three aunts, with her uncles Jesse and Garland Norris, and with her grandfather, Jesse Allen Norris.

"Grandpa" Norris had large farms in the area and Garland and Jesse Jr. owned a soft drink bottling company.

"When I was growing up in Apex it was a very small town, and everybody knew everybody else," Julia said. "The main street was the center of town, and Baucom's Drug Store was a meeting place. I remember the Baucom family, the Pearsons, the Olives."

Mrs. Street, who now lives in Winston-Salem, attended First Baptist Church while in Apex.

She graduated from UNC-G, then known as Woman's College, in 1923.

"After my senior year in college," Mrs. Street said, "I worked for the Children's Home Society in Greensboro for the summer, then went to Winston-Salem to teach first grade.

"In the spring of 1924 I met Dr. Claudius Augustus Street, a Harvard Medical School graduate from Linville Falls, N.C., who was then Forsyth County Doctor."

That September, the two were married in Raleigh.

Dr. Street was one of North Carolina's first pediatricians.

He died in 1968 of a sudden heart attack.

Apex Memories

Mrs. Street has fond memories of her childhood in Apex. Her high school days were her best ones here.

"When I was a little girl one of my favorite things to do was making 'pinny shows.' That was digging a hole in the ground, lin-

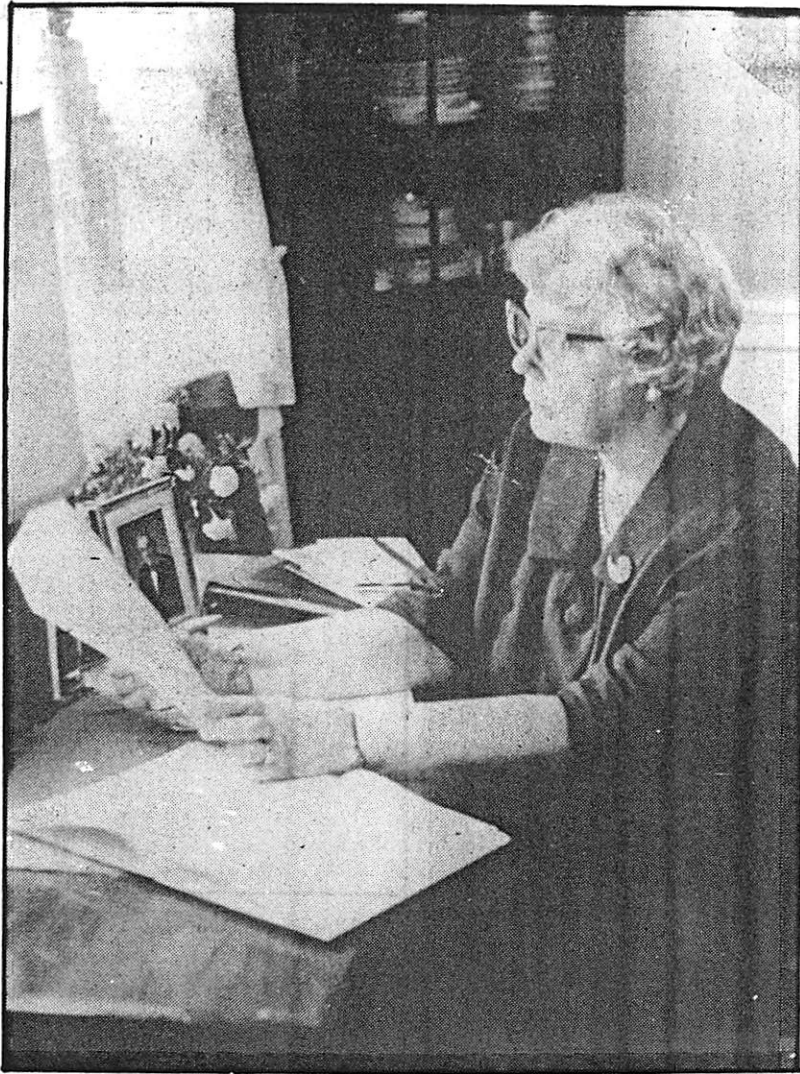
ing it with moss and flowers, covering it with a piece of glass and charging a straight pin for anyone to look at it.

"Another of our favorite things to do was to go fishing in the mill pond on Grandpa's farm. We did that a lot."

"Another favorite occupation was climbing 'my tree' in the front yard and watching the trains go by. The railroad ran in front of our house — I loved to count the freight cars, read the names on them and guess where they came from and what they hauled.

"Once a circus unloaded on the lot next to our house and I had a wonderful time sitting in my tree and watching the elephants and other animals being unloaded. I never before knew that giraffes had long eyelashes."

The old Norris home, no longer standing, had two lattice summer houses (gazebos) in the front yard; in one, Julia had a rope swing and, in the other, she read or painted.

"Another favorite occupation was the singsings that we sometimes had around the piano in the parlor," she said. "These were often joined by neighbors on Sunday evenings."

In Raleigh

From the ages nine to 13, Julia lived in Raleigh with her mother, who had moved from Cary and opened a boarding house for college professors.

"One time she woke up us three children at 4 a.m. and took us out on the front porch to see Halley's Comet," Julia said. "It was an awesome sight — a big, bright white ball with a wide tail stretching across the sky."

Julia, like her mother, was an animal lover, and while in Apex she had a devoted bird dog, Old Dan, as a constant companion, and many cats and kittens — at one time 13.

In Raleigh, pets weren't as easy to keep.

"One time one of the professors (at the boarding house), who had been an engineer on the Panama Canal, bought a little lion cub from a show at the State Fair and brought it to us," Julia

said. "Sad to say, it was against the law to keep wild animals in town, and he had to take it back. I cried for days."

Back in Apex

"When I was 13 I went back to Apex to live," Mrs. Street said. "Aunt Maude was sick and wanted me back and I stayed there the rest of my teen years. My beloved mother died when I was 16 and I was devastated. My greatest solace was a wonderful teacher I had named Miss Ruth Evans; she comforted me.

"Another fine teacher I had in high school was Mr. John C. Lockhart.

"Some of my friends were Annie Mae Bell, Lucille Betts, Esther Pate, Roy Pearson, George Rogers, Ralph Poe and others."

College Years

Mrs. Street graduated from high school in 1916 and attended what was then called The State Normal and Industrial College in Greensboro through the end of her sophomore year, when her Grandpa Norris died.

"I had no money to go back on, so I taught school for three years, two in Rocky Mount and one in Greensboro, then went back to college — it was called Woman's College then — and

graduated in 1923."

During the period between her first two and last two years of college, Mrs. Street lived in Raleigh in the summers with her aunt, Mrs. M.T. Norris.

"During that time, I went to summer school in Chapel Hill," Mrs. Street said. "One summer I had the wonderful experience of being in a playwriting class taught by Dr. Fred Koch of Playmaker fame. In my class was Paul Green, the later-famous author of "The Lost Colony" who was, incidentally, a distant cousin. Also in that class were the later famous authors Thomas Wolfe, Bernice Kelly Harris and Legette Blythe. Chapel Hill was a grand, fun place to be."

Married Life and Career

After Julia Lilly Montgomery became Mrs. C.A. Street, she had two children, Carol Montgomery Street McMillan and Claudius Augustus Street Jr.

"Dr. Street was a wonderful man," Julia said. "Our 43 1/2 years together were all happiness."

It was after her children were grown that Mrs. Street began extensive writing.

"Over the years I have written many stories and poems for Sunday School papers and magazines, and radio scripts," she said, "but I did not write a book until after my last child was married when I was 57."

Mrs. Street has published two small books of poetry, printed and bound by Cynthia Olive Hensel, who was born and grew up in Apex and lived in Winston-Salem.

The books of poetry are entitled "Street Lights" and "Salem Christmas Eve."

Since that time, Mrs. Street has had published by well-known publishers seven books for young readers, most of which are in school and public libraries in North Carolina.

All seven books have North Carolina historical settings.

The books are: "Fiddler's Fancy", 1955, about a day in the life of Dr. Street's mother when she was a girl; "Moccasin Tracks", 1958, about the Cherokee Indians;

"Drover's Gold", 1961, about stock driving and treasure hunting along the Buncombe Turnpike; "Dulcie's Whale", 1963, about Cape Lookout in World War I;

"Candle Love Feast", 1959, about the Moravian Christmas Eve service; "North Carolina Parade" with Richard Walser, 1965, stories of history and people (two editions by UNC press and now in paperback by Broadfoot's of Wilmington);

"Judaculla's Handprint and Other N.C. Mysteries", 1975, N.C. ghost stories, (now in paperback by Briarpatch Press, Davidson N.C.)

Mrs. Street has won the AAUW award three times for best juvenile book of the year in North Carolina (for "Fiddler's Fancy" "Dulcie's Whale" and "North Carolina Parade"), and a Distinguished Service Award from UNC-G for preserving North Carolina history for school children.

Other Hobbies

In addition to her writing, Mrs. Street loves to paint and once won a blue ribbon at an art show for a portrait of an old woman. The painting is entitled "The Snuff Dipper."

"I also love to knit and have made dozens of caps for friends and for premature babies at Forsyth Hospital, a large number of afghans, and many, many

sweaters for grandchildren and great-grands," Mrs. Street said.

She did volunteer work at Forsyth Memorial Hospital for fifteen years and wrote a book column for a Winston-Salem based weekly newspaper, *The Suburbanite*, for five years until the paper ceased publication last year.

Mrs. Street has nine grandchildren, (including this reporter), and seven great-grandchildren.

A book club in Apex is named for Mrs. Street.

She is honored by having her photograph hanging in the children's room at the Apex Library.

"One of my great pleasures," Mrs. Street said, "is the yearly visit of members of the Julia Montgomery Street Book Club of Apex."

Julia still writes, though not quite as much as she once did. At 88 years old, after such a busy life, she deserves to slow down a little.

A tribute to Julia Montgomery Street by the Apex Book Club

In June, 1967, a meeting of a new book study club was held for the purpose of forming a book club. The object of this club would be to meet monthly to study and enjoy literature - either fiction or non-fiction, poetry or the arts, and also promote cultural activities, share ideas, and nurture friendship and good will among the members and the community.

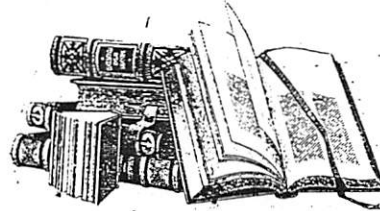
At the second formative meeting in July, it was decided to name the book club for Julia Montgomery Street, an author who was reared in Apex by her aunt, Maud Norris.

Mrs. Street was the author of many children's books and was living in Winston-Salem. She sent her appreciation for honoring her by naming the newly formed book club for her. Her appreciation letter was in the form of an essay entitled My Apex Years. She told of "playhouses she made around the roots of the big, old trees that studded her Grandpa Norris's yard." She described herself as a lone child in a houseful of adults - when she was not in some far-away imaginary place. She spoke of the hours she spent in one of the summer houses that graced the "yard behind the picket fence" - dreaming, reading, and writing. Thoughts of writing a novel were even then in her head, but she was too busy being a young lady to bring those ideas to fruition.

Through her college years, early marriage and child rearing, she was too busy to pursue her writing. She did, however, write a few short stories and some radio plays during those years.

When both her children had left for college and her husband was busy practicing medicine, she found time on her hands. In her words, she was not a joiner, bridge addict, or a clubber. It was then she began writing "full-time."

To quote her, "I found that the Apex years had implanted in my sub-conscious a very firm foundation for the work I have done. At seventy, I am still a child at heart

and I long to climb to the top of the cupola on the old house at Apex, write a half-dozen more books and attend a meeting of The Julia Montgomery Street Book Club."

Her husband, Dr. C. A. Street was 78 years old when he died in 1968.

On Sunday, Oct. 27, 1968, The JMS Book club invited the community to come to the Apex Community Library from 3:00 until 5:00 p.m. to say "Hello" to Mrs. Street. A presentation of a complete set of her books was made to the Library in her honor.

In May, 1973, Mrs. Street again came to Apex and was honored as a distinguished citizen and her picture was hung in the new Depot-Turned-Library.

In 1984, seven members of the JMS Book club visited Mrs. Street in Winston-Salem. We lunched with her at the Tavern in Old Salem and had a long visit with her in her home. Her beloved cat sat with us as she kept us a captive audience while she told of her many remembrances, mostly of her by-gone days in Apex. Some of us also visited her on another occasion.

We were saddened by her death on September 19 and these remembrances of her are our way of paying tribute to our friend. We are truly honored that our Book Club bears her name. We are thankful for her many children's books, her poems, stories, scripts, newspaper and magazine articles. Most of all, we treasure her friendship over the years, her interest in Apex and "her Book Club." She has been an inspiration to us and we will miss our friend.
