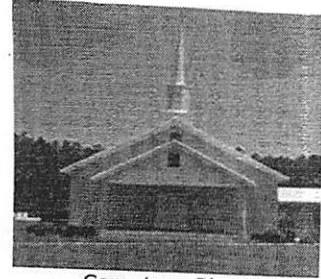

It's a sign of old times — produce stands using honor system

Last Saturday, I told the kids we were going shopping, and they cleaned themselves up in a hurry, anticipating a trip to Wal-Mart in Knightdale. But when we headed down Smithfield Road, away from U.S. 64, they started asking questions and grumbled when I confessed we weren't going to a regular store.

We turned right on Old Ferrell Road, and the first stop was Akland Orchard. "Who do you pay?" Dorothy asked. Bags of red and yellow apples lined the shelves under a shelter, but no one was in sight.

I showed her the slot for money on the back wall and explained the apples were sold on the honor system. Dorothy wondered if people ever stole the fruit, but orchard owner Jerry Akland said later in a telephone interview that most people are pretty honest.

"They're almost too honest," he said. "They go out of their way to make sure they do it right."

His losses are minimal, he said, adding he would expect people to want to bite into an apple and taste it before they bought any.

Akland's been in business for almost 10 years and considers the orchard a success. "If people like

it, it's successful," he said. Apples started coming off the trees in early September and will be available

a little while longer. Peaches are his biggest seller, though, available from the first of June until the end

of August.

Although Akland sells his apples picked and bagged, the peaches are sometimes offered on a "pick your own" basis.

"It's harder for us because we have

delicious apples that were so juicy that Rob suggested we never buy apples at the grocery store again. Apples this fresh made everyone forget all about Wal-Mart.

Our next stop was on Mailman Road, where William Pope has a "pick your own" vegetable busi-

ness. A tobacco farmer who plans to retire this year, Pope has no intention of stopping working.

Although he's sold produce this way for seven or eight years, this year wasn't too successful, he said. "I didn't advertise much."

Next summer, he hopes to sell butter beans, peas, tomatoes, okra and pumpkins. In the past, he has sold and donated pumpkins to the

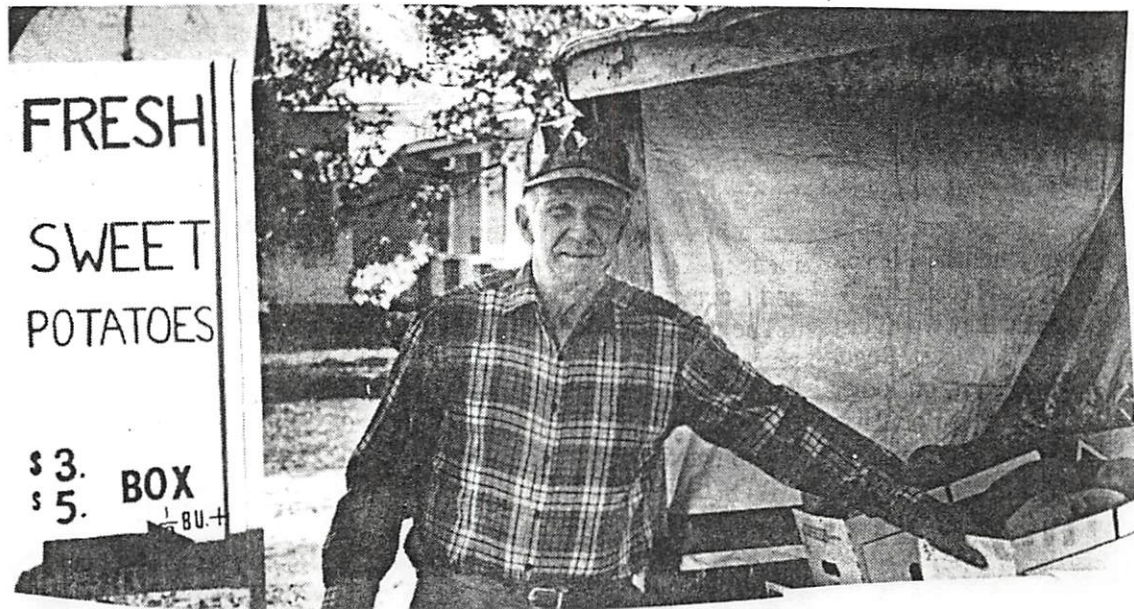
tell people where to pick," he said. "It's kind of fun, though. People seem to like it."

We purchased a half-bushel of golden

local schools. "We had a field close to Knightdale Elementary School and would let them come out and pick some," he said.

Children seem to make him smile and, although he didn't have any produce for us, he did introduce us to his dog, Trick, and take us to see his goats. The goats are being raised for milk and meat and he has about 20 so far. "It gives me something to do," he said. "I'm not one to just sit down."

A drive down Rolesville Road brought us to the home of Phillip Moody, another semiretired tobacco grower.



Moody sells sweet potatoes from a cart near the road and operates on the honor system. Boxes are \$3 and \$5. Customers select the size box they want and put the money in a slot in a locked box.

Moody doesn't worry about anyone stealing his sweet potatoes. "I couldn't ask for it to work any taken any from me," he said.

He first sold watermelons on the honor system. "It worked so well I decided to try it for sweet potatoes," he said, adding that many of his customers buy from him on a regular basis.

I bought a half bushel of sweet pota-toes, even though the kids said they didn't like them. They'll probably change their minds when I bake them a sweet potato pie.

The last stop was Wilder's Nursery on First Avenue, where grapes were hanging in abundance. If you plan to go, do it soon because owner Billy Wilder said they won't last much longer. The Black Regal grapes are the sweetest, but other varieties, such as the Carlos, Higgins and Frye are also available

Most people seem to be fairly honest, although someone did steal the cash box one night, he admitted. "I think they were disappointed when they found out how little money was in there."

Tyrone Debnam, a member of the N.C. Nurseryman's Association, helps out at the nursery. He sees its system as successful. "It really has done well. There really are some honest people here," he said.

Rob described the grapes as delicious, sweet and juicy, although we didn't actually pay to pick. We are going back, though, and this time we'll pay, just as soon as this story's complete.

The grapes are also sold on an honor system. Buckets are stacked by a pole near the nursery's of-fice, and a box is left to leave the payment in. "Just eating" is a dollar, and a container costs \$3.

The nursery has sold grapes for several years on a "pick your own" basis but not until now on the honor system. People seem to enjoy the convenience, Wilder said. "We

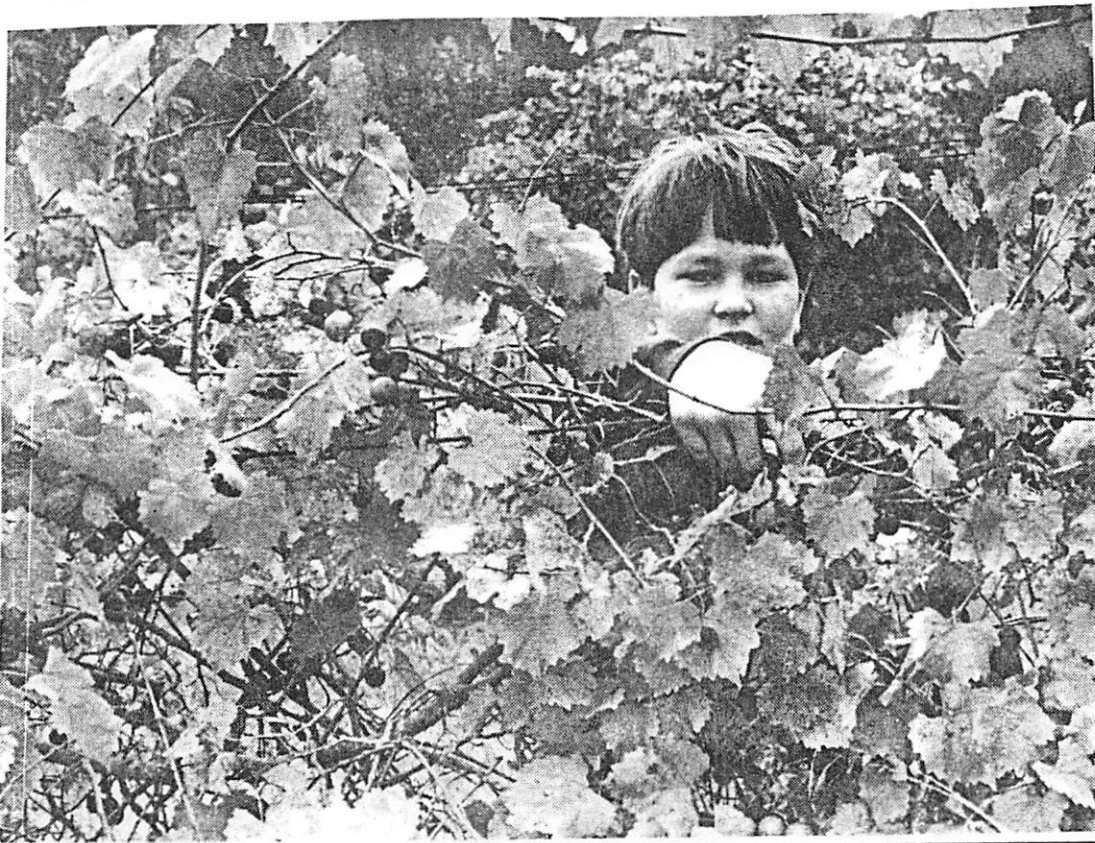

William A. Gilreath was born on February 12, 1829 in North Carolina. At present no information is available on his earlier life. He moved to Fentress County between 1840-50. He was a prominent citizen of the Travisville Community. He ran a grist mill and was a Justice of the Peace in 1891. William also worked for the establishment of Pickett County.

William married Mary Adeline Allen about 1848 as their oldest child Martha is listed as 1 year old in the Fentress County Census Records in 1850. This is the first year William and Mary appear in the Fentress County Census, along with her parents Augusta and Elina Allen, and shows both the Gilreaths and Allens were born in North Carolina and their daughter Martha born in Tennessee. Mary's only known brother was Lafayette Allen, born in NC about 1843 and living in Tennessee in 1850, who was killed at the Dr. Hale place at Wolf River, TN, while on leave from the army during the Civil War.

William was married three times; (1) Mary Allen, (2) Rhoda Moody Crouch, (3) Necie Upchurch. Some sources indicate a marriage to Margaret Beason. But this writer can find no record of such a marriage.

William and Mary Allen were the parents of four children; Martha E., Elvina Alice, Malissa Adeline, and James.

Martha E., born December 1848, married Joe Crouch. They had two children Belle and Mary, both of whom died while young.

Elvina Alice, born 1852, married Sampson Fowler. Their children were; William Lafayette, Martha, John, James and Minna.

Malissa, born December 7, 1855, married John Wesley Crouch (son of George Washington Crouch and Lucinda Jennings). Their children were: Zona, who married Melvin Davidson; Martha, who married John Marion Rains; James Gordon, who married Ellen Storie and Delta Winningham; Dave, who

married Eva Baker; William Lee, who married Ollie Storie; Fannie, who married Fred Lesh; Nellie, who married Lewis Craig; Tom, who married Alta Greer, Necie, who married Otto Garrett; and Ruby, who married John Rushing. Melissa died January 4, 1903. Her husband John died September 4, 1935. They are buried in the Davidson Cemetery at Forbus, TN. Their history can be found elsewhere in this book.

James, born 1861, married Corda Beason. Nor further information available at this time.

Mary Allen Gilreath died September 1866 and her funeral was conducted by Rev. A.B. Wright, at the "Head of the Cane".

Rhoda Moody Crouch became William's second wife sometime before 1880. She was the widow of William Crouch and had several children. William and Rhoda's children were; John, Nancy, Ebadell, and Leander.

John, born 1865, married Fetna Davidson and had Charles, Milton, Lee, Frona, Nona, Abbie, and Ben.

Nancy, born 1868, married John Evans.

Ebadell, born 1871, married John Upchurch.

Lee, born 1874, married Dovie Smallwood and had no children.

The 1900 Fentress County Census shows William and his third wife Necie Upchurch married 10 years. Their two children were Luther C. and Vannah E.

Luther, born in August, 1892, married Pearl Chism (daughter of L.B. Chism and Mary Wood). Their children were Willie, Christina and Hazel. Luther was killed in December, 1915.

Vannie, born December, 1894, married Bill Paris.

William died December 16, 1901 and is buried in the Gilreath Cemetery on his old homeplace.
