6. William Ray, Sr.

The following information on William Ray, Sr. is primarily summarized from a 1997 book entitled, "The Families of Henry Nail and Mary Keller, and Thomas Ray and Elizabeth Pearce." This thoroughly researched and documented book is a publication of the Nail-Ray Association of Shelbyville, Indiana.

William Ray, Senior, was a Wake County farmer during Colonial and Revolutionary times. William Ray, Sr. owned a 500 acre plantation on the south side of Moccasin Creek, about 17 miles northeast of Raleigh in what was Craven County before 1746, Johnston County between 1746 and 1770, and Wake County thereafter. Moccasin Creek has been a boundary dividing Wake and Franklin Counties since 1779. The land owned by William Ray, Sr. in Wake County is east of the property owned by Luke, Joseph, John and Nathan Ray. This William Ray, Sr. is not thought to be related to Nathan Ray, unless a connection can be proven in an earlier generation.

William Ray, Sr. is the parent of at least six children (William, Jr., Baker, Thomas, Hudson, Charles and Chesly? — birth order unknown). William Ray, Senior was too old to fight in the Revolutionary War, but three of his sons were just the right age. Late in 1779, William's son, Thomas, about 17, left home to join the Continental Army for the first of seven 3-month campaigns. Twenty-one months later, Thomas returned from the war. Two of William's other sons, Hudson and Charles, also served and died in the conflict for American independence. Hudson Ray was a soldier in the North Carolina Continental Line and died of wounds in the Battle of Eutaw Springs in September 1781. Charles Ray was a soldier in the North Carolina Militia and died of smallpox while a prisoner of the British, probably during 1781.

"The Johnstones are an ancient family, deriving their name from the barony of Johnstone in Annandale, Scotland. By successive creations from 1430 to 1701, the head of the race attained the dignity of Marques. Gabriel Johnstone appointed by the King, Governor of North Carolina 1734. His brother, John, was appointed surveyor of the state in 1736. They came from Dunee, Scotland."

We are not descended from Governor Gabriel Johnston; his will names only one child, a daughter Penelope, but he does give land to his two nephews, Samuel (Gov. Samuel Johnston) and Henry (his brother John returned to Great Britain and died there). Some of the land is still in the Johnson family about whom these records are set down.

The Scotch expressions which they held on to, and by-words - such as, "Well, <u>Jeemes</u>' River!" indicated Scotch ancestry and some connection with the James River in Virginia.

Father (Kemp B. Johnson) said "Pa Johnson!" (his father John Lewis Johnson) used to tell him his uncle (his only uncle was William Johnson, son of Tapley, Sr., and father of cousin Willis Johnson) always called him "Eon" as that was Scotch for John.

It has come down to us that the first Tapley Johnson's parents and grandparents were from Surry County, Virginia.

"After 1729 . . . a second type of immigration was mostly of the highest type of manhood in Virginia. The law of Primogeniture then enforced

in Virginia, gave the eldest son the sole hereditary right, and compelled the younger men of the family to cast their lots away from home or become clergymen, or turn to other professions.

For the next fifty or seventy-five years there was a great surge of young men coming from Virginia into North Carolina, obtaining grants and purchasing land on which to establish their homes."

If we follow this migration we find a surge of these families selling land in Virginia: Surry, Sussex, Isle of Wight and Nansemond Counties, and moving into Halifax, Northampton, Edgecombe Counties, Johnston, Granville, and Chatham and Cumberland - following the courses of the Roanoke, Neuse and Cape Fear Rivers.

We learn from the land boundaries that his nearest neighbors and friends were: John Nall, Abraham Carter, Mark Robinson, James Haile, James Atkins, Nathan Prince, Matthew Jones, Jesse Jones, Samuel Northington, Major Thomas Armstrong, John Campbell, and some McLeods, and McKoys, and his several Johnson kin: Barnabas, Sill, William, James, and John, and his wife's family, the Matthews: David and Joseph. (Jesse Jones was the brother of Etheldred Jones).

He first appears on the road orders of Brunswick County, va in 1736. He is in minor court cases in the court order books with John Vinson as his security. He is in in the Parish Book of St Andrews, Va where he is paid for keeping his mother who is unnamed, 1745 to 1752. (It's possible that she was Frances, widow of Thomas Carter who died about 1748 or before). He receives two patents, one in 1746 and one in 1756. He and Elendor sell these two patent in 1761 to Willian Renn and they moves to North Carolina. He has land in Granville County which probably became Bute County. (Some notes I have I am including). On Ratcliff's tax list 2 in 1766 in Bute County is Nathaniel Carter and Abraham Carter.

Nathaniel and Nelly Carter buy 120 acres of land from John Nall in Cunberland Count in 1767 which they sell to Drury Smith in 1779 and move on to Chatham County. Samuel Northington, a relative of mine, is a witness to this deed. Nathaniel dies in Chatham County in 1782. He leaves a wife unnamed, a son Vinson and two daughters Molly and Lusey. I would like to think he is father to Abraham Carter of Cumberland County but I can't prove that



I saw your query in Family Puzzlers lately. I have a Nancy Upchurch Painter in my family tree. Do the children here ring any bells with you? I have not looked for this family on the census. So do not know if Michael lived through the years that you listed Nancy without a husband. I may have some more help if this is good. My Upchurch family was in Rutherford Co, NC from 1790, when Nancy's parents were married in Rutherford Co.

4. You list Nancy's date of birth as 1799 - the data sent to me by James Panter lists her as being born in 1795 in Rutherford Co., North Carolina. This birth date of 1795 agrees

with Karen Patterson on your profile "Y" item C.

- 5. While the Panter name has been both spelled and pronounced in many various ways, by their descendants, the data James Panter provided me shows the exclusive usage of PANTER for Michael Panter, his father Johann George Panter, Sr. and his grandfather Johann Panter/Bender. Jim can undoubtedly further explain the change from "Bender" to Panter.
- 6. The children of Michael and Nancy (Upchurch) Panter are exactly as given to me by James F. Panter. This more or less checks out with Karen Pattersons information in your profile "Y", item C, in that Nancy had her first child about 1814 or 1815. So once again I'm afraid you will do better to go back to them as "the source" in order to work out any differences.
- 7. Let me just finish up commenting on profile sheet "Y" item C, while I'm at it: (a) I have had prior contact with Karen Patterson. (b) somebody was sure home at least parttime between 1814 and 1828 in order for Nancy to have the five children I previously listed. (c) What circumstances kept Michael away from home between the 1820 and 1830 census I do not know - but he supposedly died sometime between 1837 and 1840 which would account for his absence on the 1840 census and thereafter (d) Karen probably missed the Rutherford County NC marriage bond for males, showing the marriage of Michael Panter and Nancy Upchurch. I'll send Karen a letter with this same information.

Item A. - I do not show either a George PANTHER or an Mary (Polly Ann) NANNEY anywhere in my computerized files. No help here.

Item B. - First, this looks suspiciously like an LDS PAF Decendancy Chart, which need to be more fully documented before you can take anything for granted.

Second, about the only thing I find correct in Item B is Michaels b. day, their marriage date and place of marriage. My frank opinion is that somebody took liberties with the spelling of Michael PANTERs name, changing it to PAINTER to make it fit and then shoved the other PAINTER names under it as they seemed to work with the first childs 1814 birth date. Could be wrong but I find absolutely no PAINTERS in my files, no George or Elizabeth PANTERS, and no BRADLEY family names appended to any PANTERS. Likewise I show no Eva, Barbara, Sherod, or Nancy PANTERS of either the same or different birth dates as shown in item B. Unless you have absolutely positive documentation to the contrary, I would say this line is quite possibly in error. Especially so if it is an unproven LDS Decendancy Chart.

Third, the worst part of Item B is that if what you show therein is correct, then nothing either Jim Panter or I might add will make any difference as it automatically takes us out of the Michael Panter-Nancy Upchurch loop, in that we believe firmly we are descended from William M. PANTER whom I absolutely know to be married to Angeline Clementine GEE, my g g grandmother. A great aunt of mine, Josephine Panter, a sister of Jim Panters father, personally vouched for the GEE family connection to the Panters before she passed away. So I'm sticking with what I have for children of Michael and Nancy until documented otherwise beyond a shadow of a doubt.

Item E. - Again I show no PAINTERS in my files, nor do I have a Rose Ann Shope or a Jane Ratcliff. No idea if items "C" and "E" belong to gether. No help here.

- I noted on your 11x17" master chart that Nancy's father, Sherwood Upchurch, has a second wife named Mary "Polly" (Smith) PELL. It may be coincidence, but Michael PANTER's brother George PANTER Jr., married a Sarah PELL. I don't have any other data





According to my Aunt Cora (BAILEY), Great-Grandma Fannie took in a couple of Spanish/Mexican children named Bustamentos (spelling is not correct). The family was fluent in Spanish. Also, according to Aunt Cora, my Grandmother, Rena Luella BAILEY, was given to running off and staying lost for a spell, without telling anyone where she went or whom she was with. Apparently during one of these escapades, she met my Grandfather, James NAVARRETTE and they married. Where they married, is a mystery, and one I would like to Where they divorced is another mystery, but I suspect uncover. that they may have -- or Grandpa may have -- divorced in Tucson. My step-Grandmother, Luisa Valdez NAVARRETTE, says that James and Rena were never married. However, James and Rena had four children together: Cora June, George James, Benjamin Martin and Rose Mary. The last, Rose Mary, died 9 days after her birth and is buried in Bowie, Arizona at the Desert Rest Cemetery. I do not know what the legal aspect of common law marriages was in Arizona in the 1920's, but I suspect that they were truly married. Grandpa was a Catholic, Grandma was not, so maybe they were married by a JP somewhere. I know that my father, George James, was born in Dos Cavasas (spelling is approximate). Perhaps they were married down there, or in one of the other nearby small mining towns. Then again, perhaps they were married by a circuit court judge and the record of that could be anywhere! Grandpa NAVARRETTE married Luisa Valdez in the Catholic Church after the desertion by Rena of the family. This is a long and involved story, but apparently Grandma was able to find love a second time, because she married a Julio MONTANO in Albuquerque and had 4 more children (3 boys and a girl). enough, Julio looks remarkably like my own Interestingly Grandfather!

So, there you have it. I believe that Aunt Cora said that William Booker died in San Jose, so he may be buried there - somewhere. Fannie Luella ROGERS BAILEY, Mary Jane YORK ROGERS and Ruben Capers ROGERS are all buried in Phoenix, Arizona. In summary, here are the items for which I am looking:

Few early deed records survive for Wake County. When combined with the cessation of land grants from 1763-1778, we find a dearth of early Wake County land records. One interesting set of records that do survive (though not in their entirety) are Civil Action Papers (CAPs) Concerning Land. These are a subset of the CAPs series at the North Carolina State Archives in Raleigh. These are extant court papers where there was an issue concerning land. The originals can be found in C.R.099.325.93 (1773-1793). The surviving paperwork up to the year 1800 will eventually be abstracted and included in Wake Treasures

You will note that the timing of many of these is in 1778. This would have been the first time that one could file for a land grant in about fifteen years. During those years, many moved to Wake County, made improvements on land, bought and sold land, and yet no land grants were issued. So, as soon as the land grant process was re-instituted by the State of NC, there were a lot of land grant entries made, and this caused a lot of caveats2 to also be filed.
