## 6. William Ray, Sr.

The following information on William Ray, Sr. is primarily summarized from a 1997 book entitled, "The Families of Henry Nail and Mary Keller, and Thomas Ray and Elizabeth Pearce." This thoroughly researched and documented book is a publication of the Nail-Ray Association of Shelbyville, Indiana.

William Ray, Senior, was a Wake County farmer during Colonial and Revolutionary times. William Ray, Sr. owned a 500 acre plantation on the south side of Moccasin Creek, about 17 miles northeast of Raleigh in what was Craven County before 1746, Johnston County between 1746 and 1770, and Wake County thereafter. Moccasin Creek has been a boundary dividing Wake and Franklin Counties since 1779. The land owned by William Ray, Sr. in Wake County is east of the property owned by Luke, Joseph, John and Nathan Ray. This William Ray, Sr. is not thought to be related to Nathan Ray, unless a connection can be proven in an earlier generation.

William Ray, Sr. is the parent of at least six children (William, Jr., Baker, Thomas, Hudson, Charles and Chesty? - birth order unknown). William Ray, Senior was too old to fight in the Revolutionary War, but three of his sons were just the right age. Late in 1779, William's son, Thomas, about 17, left home to join the Continental Army for the first of seven 3-month campaigns. Twenty-one months later, Thomas returned from the war. Two of William's other sons, Hudson and Charles, also served and died in the conflict for American independence. Hudson Ray was a soldier in the North Carolina Continental Line and died of wounds in the Battle of Eutaw Springs in September 1781. Charles Ray was a soldier in the North Carolina Militia and died of smallpox while a prisoner of the British, probably during 1781 .

"The Johnstones are an ancient family, deriving their name from the baron of Johnstone in Annandale, Scotland. By successive creations from 1430 to 1701, the head of the race attained the dignity of Marques. Gabriel Johnston appointed by the King, Governor of North Carolina 1734. His brother, John, was appointed surveyor of the state in 1736. They came from Dunce, Scotland."

We are not descended from Governor Gabriel Johnston; his will names only one child, a daughter Penelope, but he does give land to his two nephews, Samuel (Gov. Samuel Johnston) and Henry (his brother John returned to Great Britain and died there). Some of the land is still in the Johnson family about whom these records are set down.
The Scotch expressions which they held on to, and by-words - such as, "Well, Jeemes' River!" indicated Scotch ancestry and some connection wish the James River in Virginia.

Father (Kemp B. Johnson) said "Pa Johnson!" (his father John Lewis Johnson) used to tell him his uncle (his only uncle was William Johnson, son of Tapley, Sr., and father of cousin Willis Johnson) always called him "Eon" as that was Scotch for John.

It has come down to us that the first Tapley Johnson's parents and grandparents were from Surrey County, Virginia.
"After 1729 . . . a second type of immigration was mostly of the highest type of manhood in Virginia. The law of Primogeniture then enforced
in Virginia, gave the eldest. son the sole hereditary right, and compolled the younger men of the family to cast their lots away from home or become clergymen, or turn to other professions.

For the next fifty or seventy-five years there was a great surge of young men coming from Virginia into North Carolina, obtaining grants and parchasing land on which to establish their homes."

If we follow this migration we find a surge of these families selling land in Virginia: Surrey, Sussex, Isle of Wight and Nansemond Counties, and moving into Halifax, Northampton, Edgecombe Counties, Johnston, Granville, and Chatham and Cumberland - following the courses of the Roanoke, Neuse and Cape Fear Fivers.
We learn from the land boundaries that his nearest neighbors and friends were: John Nail, Abraham Carter, Nark Robinson, James Hale, James Atkins, Nathan Prince, Matthew Jones, Jesse Jones, Samuel Northington, Major Thomas Armstrong, John Campbell, and some McLeods, and Mc Koys, and his several Johnson kin: Barnabas, Sill, William, James, and John, and his wife's family, the Matthews: David and Joseph. (Jesse Jones was the brother of Etheldred Jones).

According to my Aunt Cora (BAILEY), Great-Grandma Fannie took in a couple of Spanish/Mexican children named Bustamentos (spelling is not correct). The family was fluent in Spanish. Also, according to Aunt Cora, my Grandmother, Rena Luella BAILEY, was given to running off and staying lost for a spell, without telling anyone where she went or whom she was with. Apparently during one of these escapades, she met my Grandfather, James NAVARRETTE $\begin{aligned} & \text { and they }\end{aligned}$ married. Where they married, is a mystery, and one I would like to uncover. Where they divorced is another mystery, but I suspect that they may have -- or Grandpa may have -- divorced in Tucson. My step-Grandmother, Luisa Valdez NAVARRETTE, says that James and Rena were never married. However, James and Rena had four children together: Cora June, George James, Benjamin Martin and Rose Mary. The last, Rose Mary, died 9 days after her birth and is buried in Bowie, Arizona at the Desert Rest Cemetery. I do not know what the legal aspect of common law marriages was in Arizona in the 1920's, but I suspect that they were truly married. Grandpaiwas a Catholic, Grandma was not, so maybe they were married by a JP somewhere. I know that my father, George James, was born in Dos Cavasas (spelling is approximate). Perhaps they were married down there, or in one of the other nearby small mining towns. Then again, perhaps they were married by a circuit court judge and the record of that could be anywhere! Grandpa NAVARRETTE/married Luisa Valdez in the Catholic Church after the desertion by Rena of the family. This is a long and involved story, but apparently Grandma was able to find love a second time, because she married a Julio MONTANO in Albuquerque and had 4 more children ( 3 boys and a girl). Interestingly enough, Julio looks remarkably like my own Grandfather!

So, there you have it. I believe that Aunt Cora said that William Booker died in San Jose, so he may be buried there - somewhere. Fannie Luella ROGERS BAILEY, Mary Jane YORK ROGERS and Ruben Capers ROGERS are all buried in Phoenix, Arizona. In summary, here are the items for which I am looking:

## Wake County Civil action Papers Concerning Land - Part 1 <br> Abstracted by Diane L. Richard $\quad p \in 8$

Few early deed records survive for Wake County. When combined with the cessation of land grants from 1763-1778, we find a dearth of early Wake County land records. One interesting set of records that do survive (though not in their entirety) are Civil Action Papers (CAPs) Concerning Land. These are a subset of the CAPs series at the North Carolina State Archives in Raleigh. These are extant court papers where there was an issue concerning land. The originals can be found in C.R.099.325.93 (1773-1793). The surviving paperwork up to the year 1800 will eventually be abstracted and included in Wake Treasures.

You will note that the timing of many of these is in 1778. This would have been the first time that one could file for a land grant in about fifteen years. During those years, many moved to Wake County, made improvements on land, bought and sold land, and yet no land grants were issued. So, as soon as the land grant process was re-instituted by the State of NC, there were a lot of land grant entries made, and this caused a lot of caveats ${ }^{2}$ to also be filed.
