## **Bunn dies**

Mrs. Annabel Newton Bunn, 99, who taught seventh grade at Wakelon School in Zebulon for 43 years, died Tuesday, Feb. 23. She was a resident of Brian Center Nursing Home in Raleigh.

A native of Aulander in Bertie County, Mrs. Bunn was the oldest member of the Zebulon Baptist Church before passing away.

The daughter of the Rev. James B. Newton and Margaret Ella Watson, Mrs. Bunn married Falc E. Bunn on June 19, 1916. That same year, she began her career at Wakelon School. She taught there until she retired in 1959. She was named teacher of the year in 1958 and was a lifetime member of the National Education Association of Wake County.

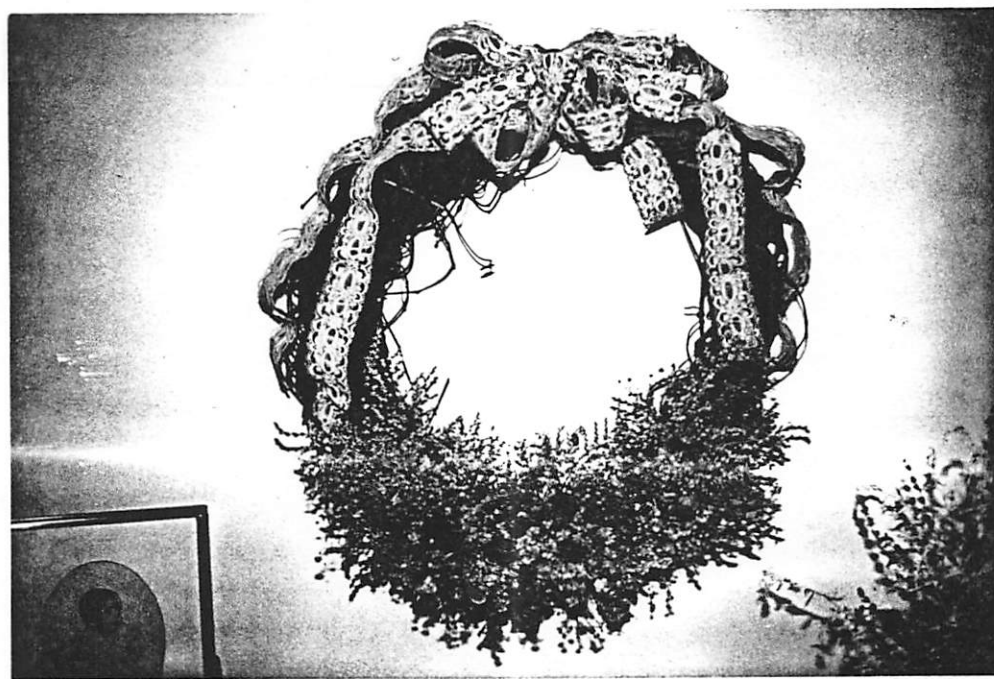

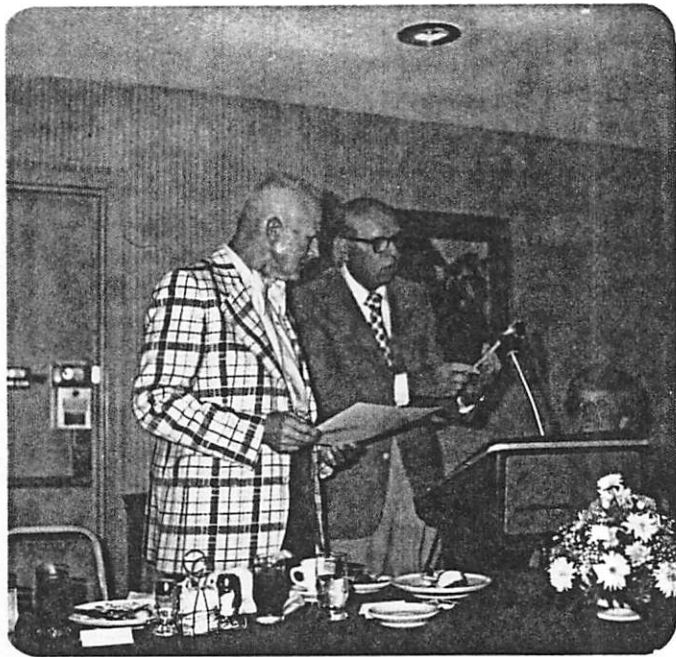

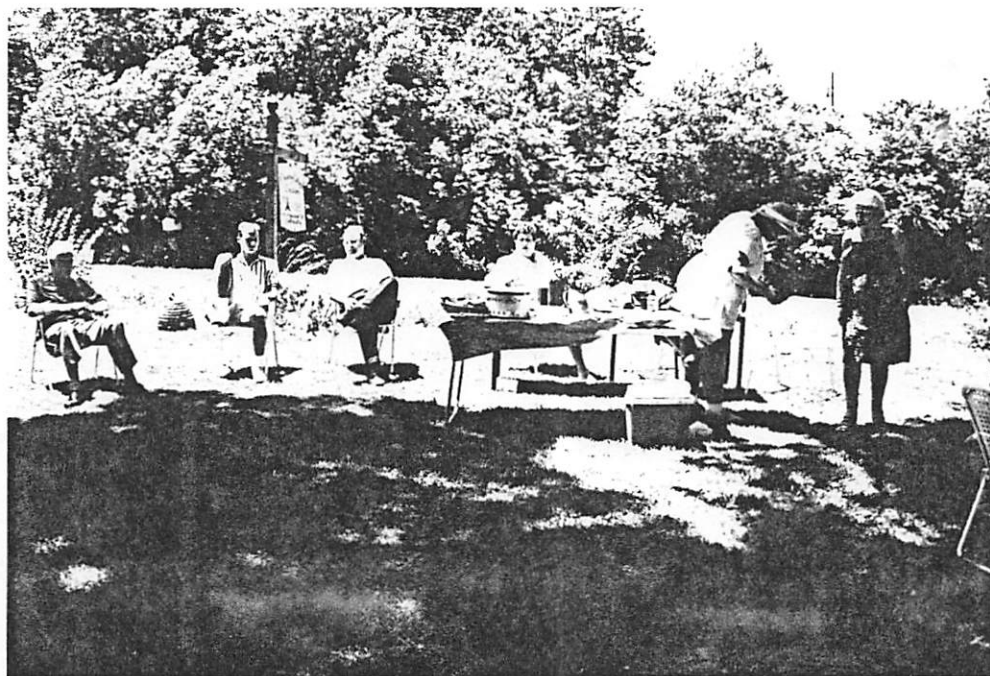
