1. Sidney Gill Ray born in December 1881. Sidney (age 30) married Oma Arnold (age 24) on June 15, 1911 and they had two daughters, Aileen and Virginia, and two sons, Garland and Calvin. Sidney was a "U.S. Mail Carrier." He first delivered mail in a horse drawn carriage.
2. Alice Elizabeth Ray was born on April 7, 1886. Alice was a school teacher. She married Dr. Roger G. Rogers on February 16, 1911. Alice was 27 and Roger was 28. They had two children, Gray and Paul. Alice died at age 57 on January 11, 1944.
3. Mattie F. Ray (a daughter)-was born on March 23, 1888 and she died at age 82 on September 2, 1970. Mattie is buried with her father, uncles and other Ray family members in the cemetery of the New Bethel Church near the intersection of Creedmoor Road and Old Creedmoor Road in Wake County approximately half way between Wake Forest and Durham. Mattie never married.
4. Thomas Ray (1889-1892) burned to death. The Raleigh State Chronicle printed the following notice of Tommie's death:

"Ray, Tommie, aged 3, child of Vaughan Ray, burned to death May 25, 1892, near Roger's Store in Durham County. The father left the child unattended and when he returned found him in great agony. Apparently the child was playing in the fire, when the clothing became ignited."

This article contains two errors. Mr. A.C. Ray's nickname was Von, not Vaughan and, although the property was near the Durham/Wake County line, the property was actually in Wake County.

5. Alfonso Carroll Ray (known as Acie) was born on August 21, 1891 and at age 24 he married Berdie Nicholson (age 23) on October 23, 1915 in Raleigh where Berdie was attending nursing school. They moved to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania where Acie worked as a train conductor on the Philadelphia and Norfolk Railroad. Acie and Berdie moved to Washington, D.C. prior to 1917 and had three children, Elmer Carroll Ray (1917), Florence Nicholson Ray Lewis (1919) and Mary Alice Ray O'Keefe (1920). Acie drove a street car and later a taxicab in Washington, D.C. Acie retired around 1960. He died suddenly of a heart attack in his home in McLean, Virginia on February 14, 1969 at age 77 without a will. Acie was six feet tall and had blue eyes and black hair. Berdie died at age 77 on October 28, 1969 after a series of strokes. Acie and Berdie are buried near a large magnolia tree in the Sunset Hill Cemetery outside of Littleton, North Carolina where Berdie was born and raised.
6. Percie E. Ray was born on December 9, 1893 and he died at age 55 on December 15, 1948. Percie served in World War I as a Corporal in the 51st Mechanized Battalion of the 17th. Army Division. He is buried at Arlington National Cemetery (Section 12, Gravesite 978). After his military service, Percie worked as a bus driver in Washington, D.C. Percie married Elsie Davis (1902-1974) in March of 1921 and they had two sons, Elmer (1921-1988) and Albert (1923-1992). Albert served in the Navy and retired after twenty years as a Petty Officer First Class (Boson Mate First Class in charge of rigging, anchors, cables, lifeboats and general deck supervision). Albert was on active duty during World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War. Albert died at age 68 on March 21, 1992 and he is buried at Arlington National Cemetery (Section 12, Gravesite 992). Albert's wife, Josephine Simone Ray, lives in a new home built on a portion of the property where Percie and Elsie lived in Lorton, Virginia. Elsie died on October 9, 1974 at age 72 and is buried next to her husband in Arlington National Cemetery.
