Born Verna Spivey to Anderson Laffette and Margaret Artelia Rambeaut Spivey on June 1, 1902, Verna was the youngest of 12 children: Mary Eleanor, Margaret Melinda, Ava Elizabeth, Leonard Aarron, George Clinton, Needham Henry, Joseph Monroe, William Preston, Mattie McElroy, Floyd Pervis, Hattie Bell, Erna Mae, and Verna, the only survivor.

Verna's father, Anderson, was born January 15, 1860 in Wake County to George W. Spivey and Margaret Melinda Nordan Spivey.

George was born August 4, 1826 and Margaret Melinda was born January 16, 1835.

Anderson had an older sister, E.J. Spivey, born October 1, 1855, a brother, G.W. Spivey (second son) born May 11, 1870, and his youngest brother, J.B. Spivey, born November 10, 1873.

Verna's grandfather, George, served in the Civil War stationed in a Virginia Camp. After the war, he returned home and told his family that he became so hungry during the war that "If sausage had reached from Virginia to North Carolina, I could have eaten my way home."

Once while the Yankees were coming through, Verna's father, Anderson scared their chickens into the woods to keep them from being eaten by the Yankees. Food was so scarce during those times, and even a small boy had to help his family.

Verna's great-granddaddy and grandma Henry and Polly Nordan had three girls: Margaret Melinda, Mary, Ann and three sons: Needham, Clinton, and William. They all loaded a covered wagon and headed toward Illinois, but something changed their minds, so they turned around and headed home. They reached the N.C. mountains and ran out of food. Fearing they would starve, Henry sold some of their cooking utensils in order to get enough food for the trip home. Polly and the eldest daughter, Margaret (Verna's grandmother), walked beside the wagon through the snow during their trip home, and at night their dresses would be frozen around their ankles.

Verna's mother, Margaret Artelia Rambeaut Spivey's ancestor originated from France. Through an old family Bible, we traced the Rambeaus back to Nancy Rambeaut born May 9, 1793 and William Rambeaut born May 11, 1785. They were married April 8, 1810.

Their children were: Gilbert born Dec. 13, 1810; John Richard born Oct. 3, 1811; Margaret born Sept. 21, 1813; William James born Sept. 5, 1815; Elizabeth Elenor born Dec. 29, 1817; Mary Jane born Nov. 25, 1819; Robert P. born Oct. 14, 1821; Francis Marion born Jan. 10, 1823; and Henry Laffette born Nov. 25, 1825. Below are the children of Henry and Polly Harvell Rambeaut (Verna's Grandparents on her mothers side.) Born Verna Spivey to Anderson Laffette and Margaret Artelia Rambeaut Spivey on June 1, 1902, Verna was the youngest of 12 children: Mary Eleanor, Margaret Melinda, Ava Elizabeth, Leonard Aarron, George Clinton, Needham Henry, Joseph Monroe, William Preston, Mattie McElroy, Floyd Pervis, Hattie Bell, Erna Mae, and Verna, the only survivor.

Verna's father, Anderson, was born January 15, 1860 in Wake County to George W. Spivey and Margaret Melinda Nordan Spivey.

- DD Jackie has details of the marriage license for Albert U and SUDIE COATS which took place on 5 JUL 1909 at 503 Benemerant St, Raleigh, NC and cited his Nathan U, III and his wife nee Martha A. Pope. It shows Sudie as 30 but she was actually 36. Further, Jackie
△ has personal knowledge that the Albert U had a md
△ brother James G. U who lived in Raleigh and was called
DD "Uncle Jim" by the Nordan Family. Albert U was born 15 JUL 1864 (Wake Co, NC) & 23 SEP 1936 (Raleigh, NC) and was buried in the City Cemetery in Raleigh, NC.
Jackie was 4 years old and remembers attending the service in the Cemetery. She & others stood back from the proceedings. She remembers seeing his monument but years later went back and could not find it. Jackie says Albert U could not write or he used a for a signature.

Jackie related 2 incidents about Albert U. His Nordan step grandchildren recall the family living at 108 Summit Ave which is in Caryaleigh and near the old Wal-Martworks. They recall him being an overall loving mentor and that he took them fishing, swimming, etc. Jackie tells a story wherein Albert U had a bet (political in nature?) Apparently he lost and paid off by riding a bull down Fayetteville street in Raleigh, NC. At the end of the street he got in a Boxcar on the railroad and was gone for 2 years. She does not know when this took place.

- △ The story of Mamie Belle U unfolds as follows:
- △ Mamie was born (to an early marriage of) SUDIE COATS about 1899. Subsequently Sudie Coats md 31 MAR 1903 (?) John Russell.
- △ This marriage did not last and Sudie took back her Coats maiden name. Then in 1909 when Mamie was about 10 Sudie married Albert U. and Mamie took her stepfathers name becoming Mamie Belle U.
- △ Sudie d 8 APR 1918 (Newport News, VA) when the family worked in the ship yard and Sudie is buried there. The Nordan's lost their Summit Ave place in the Depression and then for 6-7 years lived on the Seminole Road. Albert was not living with the Nordan Family when he died.
